I write in response to your request dated May 10, 2022 (copy attached for reference) pursuant to the New York Freedom of Information Law (Public Officers Law §§ 84-90), as follows:

REQUEST: “Email communications to or from hywang@med.cuny.edu and <anyone>@cassavasciences.com (if it would be easier to search for communications from or to Wang containing the text ‘@cassavasciences.com’ that is acceptable) over the time period from 4/1/2020 to 10/1/2020.”

Response: Your request is hereby granted in part and denied in part. Attached please find a PDF of 532 pages containing all responsive emails located by The City College of New York, except please note we have redacted personal email addresses pursuant to Public Officers Law §§ 89(2)(a) and 89(2)(c)(i). Please note that no notation has been marked in the margins of the PDF based on these provisions.

Your request is hereby denied, and we have consequently redacted the records, pursuant to Public Officers Law § 87(2)(d), to the extent that such material constitutes information obtained from a commercial enterprise, which if disclosed would cause substantial injury to the competitive position of the subject enterprise; these redactions are marked in the margins of the PDF as “POL 87(2)(d).”

In accordance with Public Officers Law § 89(4)(a), any appeal from this response to your Freedom of Information Law request must be made in writing within 30 calendar days of the date of this letter to:
