### Summary of Complaint Investigated:

At issue is the response of Officer Kadien to an emergency call where risk of 'loss of life' was possible. On August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 1855hrs, Officer Nicole Kadien was dispatched to **Construction** apartment **Construction** for the report of a suicidal female threatening to slit her wrists. Her response time is in question as after receiving the complaint, at least eleven minutes had elapsed and she still had not made contact with the subject. She further acknowledged the complaint only by "keying" the radio microphone and did not verbally state such.

### Investigation results:

### August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012

I received an email from Sgt. Scott Kadien advising that on 08/25/12 a complaint of a suicidal subject came in which Officer Kadien and Det. Lawrence handled. Officer Lawrence "voiced concern" to Sgt. Scott Kadien that Officer Nicole Kadien took an excessive amount of time to initially respond. Sgt. Scott Kadien also looked for guidance on how to handle the issue as he and Officer Nicole Kadien are separated from marriage. He was advised to take initial steps in looking into the matter and then to turn any findings over to me.

### September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012

I received a memorandum from Sgt. Scott Kadien. A summation of the memo is as follows:

- Detective Lawrence was working in the patrol division expressed concern to Sgt. Scott Kadien regarding the response time of Nicole to a suicidal person report. She had been dispatched at 1855hrs. and did not arrive on scene until 1904hrs.
- Sgt. Kadien was assisting the Sheriff's office at the Super 8 hotel and did not hear the original dispatch due to being on portable radio. Upon returning to patrol vehicle,

he heard that an ambulance was on standby and inquired as to why. He was advised by dispatch of a suicidal subject that may have or was going to "slit her wrists." He acknowledged the call and responded, arriving in less than three and a half minutes, (enroute - 19:02:48, arrived - 19:06:00).

- When he arrived to the apartment complex, P.O. Nicole Kadien was in the lobby of the complex and they arrived at the subjects apartment at the same time.
- He had Officer Nicole Kadien respond to him in writing as to the delay in response in which she replied to him with two separate memos witch conflict one another.
- He obtained the 911 Centers dispatch recordings. Notes that P.O. Kadien was the only officer originally dispatched as He and Det. Lawrence were tied up with other complaints. *Det Lawrence had cleared a complaint and responded to the suicidal call, arriving before P.O. Kadien.* Notes that in the dispatch audio, P.O. Kadien does not verbally acknowledge the dispatcher but does so by "keying" the microphone.
- Observed the subject of the suicidal call to be "Extremely volatile" and potentially violent towards herself and/or officers.
- Believes P.O. Kadien's actions to be negligent.

I reviewed both memos directed to Sgt. Kadien from P.O. Kadien. They are vastly different in explanation.

I retrieved the 911 centers dispatch information to put the events/time in chronological order:

P.O. Kadien - 18:43:14 Dispatched to 129 Saltonstall St lot for a check the welfare Complaint 18:48:27 Arrived on scene

18:50:32 Cleared with a code 32, available

18:50:39 Dispatched to Wegmans for a lockout (*Does not show 10-97*)

18:55:18 Re-routed to Apt Apt for a suicidal person, dispatch notes on MDT lists "...said she is going to kill herself by slitting her wrists-UNK if done so already - has threatened suicide before..." 19:04:01 Arrives on scene

Det. Lawrence - 18:48:34 Arrives at Buffalo St for a criminal mischief report 18:58:55 clears from the criminal mischief complaint 19:00:47 Arrives at the suicidal person complaint, Apt.

Sgt. Kadien - 18:42:24 Arrives at Super 8 Motel to assist the Sheriff's Office with a disturbance call 18:47:32 Clears from the assist

19:02:48 Calls enroute to the suicidal call 19:06:00 Arrives at **Constant State Where he finds** P.O. Kadien still in the lobby area

I reviewed the memos signed by P.O. Kadien which do substantially conflict one another.

I reviewed the 911 dispatch audio and confirm what was reported by Sgt. Kadien. I noted that the dispatcher did give basic information as to the nature of the call and location. Detailed information was provided on MDT. One of the memos written by P.O. Kadien (*later labeled as #1*) to Sgt. Kadien is proved to be completely erroneous.

### September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012

I sent email correspondence to P.O. Kadien notifying her to meet with me on 09/24/12 regarding an internal investigation as well as her right to union representation.

### September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012

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At 1357 I met with P.O. Kadien with P.O. Bells as her representative from the P.B.A. I read to her the Administrative Warnings and she signed the G.O. #335 form with P.O. Bells signing as witness.

I explained the nature of the investigation and asked her questions regarding it. A summation of the conversation is as follows:

- When clearing from the Saltonstall St. complaint, she received the lock out complaint at Wegmans and traveled west on Saltonstall St. to Phelps St. to Main St.
- When she was almost to the entrance of Wegmans she received the dispatch to the suicidal person call.
- She did not use her lights and siren did not respond in emergency mode when she should have. *This is in contrast to memos written to Sgt. Kadien where she stated that "I don't recall if I used lights and sirens while enroute."*
- Admitted to being negligent stating, "I was complacent" and "I screwed up."
- She did remember the training in which I told about the "silent dispatching" where dispatchers would give limited information over the air and it would be incumbent of the officer to check the MDT for further information.
- She stated that she was not using her cell phone or other personal electronic device.

Soon after the meeting was concluded I met with P.O. Kadien and P.O. Bells in the patrol office to ask a further question. I wanted to know which memo she turned in to Sgt. Kadien first. She indicated which one and I wrote a "1" on the upper right portion of the page. I wrote a "2" on the upper right portion of the other memo. I asked Nicole why there were vast discrepancies between the two. She stated that the first memo was written "going off memory," she later checked the time line with dispatch and turned in the second memo to Sgt. Kadien.

### September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2012

I printed a "screen shot" of the dispatch notes that P.O. Kadien was sent regarding the suicidal person.

### September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012

I met with Det. Nate Lawrence regarding the incident. A summation of the meeting is as follows:

- He mentioned to Sgt. Kadien the comment, "That's a hell of a response time" referring to how long it took P.O. Kadien to show up. That's what started the inquiry. Det. Lawrence did not specifically state that he felt P.O. Kadien's response time put him or the suicidal subject in danger though due to the totality it could have been inferred.
- He does say that P.O. Kadien's response time was not fast enough
- The subject that they were dealing with was uncooperative and belligerent and did make the statement, "I hate the police."
- He was able to enter the complex as a tenant saw him in the foyer and let him in.

While speaking to Det. Lawrence it appeared that he knew that P.O. Kadien was in the wrong though he did not want to be responsible for any disciplinary action that may occur.

### Summary of Investigation

P.O. Kadien clearly did not respond to this call in an appropriate manor. The nature of the call indicated that there was a potential for serious physical injury or death and that a response in emergency mode utilizing lights and siren was necessary. It is also clear that P.O. Kadien fabricated an excuse of her actions which she recorded in the first memo that she wrote to Sgt. Kadien.

This memorandum is a follow-up to the e-mail I sent you on August 25, 2012, regarding the response time of Officer Nicole Kadien to a report of a suicidal subject.

Detective Lawrence, who was working patrol at the time, expressed concern about Officer Kadien's response and felt it potentially put him and the suicidal subject in danger.

I checked with dispatch and learned that Officer Kadien was dispatched at 1855 hours and arrived on scene at 1904 hours.

At the time the complaint was dispatched I was assisting the Sheriff's Office at the Super 8 and did not hear the initial radio transmissions. Upon returning to my patrol vehicle I heard dispatch advising Detective Lawrence that an ambulance was on standby.

I inquired about the natural of call, at which time I was advised it was a suicidal subject that may have or was going to "slit her wrists." I then responded to the scene from the Super 8.

I responded in an emergency mode starting at 1902:38 hours and arrived on scene at 1906:00 hours. At the time of my arrival Officer Kadien was still in the lobby of the apartment building and we arrived at the subject's apartment at the same time.

At your direction I asked Officer Kadien to write me a memorandum detailing her response to the incident including where she responded from and the manner in which she responded. Officer Kadien provided me with two memorandums. The first said she was on another complaint when the call was dispatched and after she cleared she responded from Saltonstall Street.

The second memorandum said she was heading to Wegmans for a report of a lock out and was rerouted. In both memorandums Officer Kadien said she did not recall whether she used her lights and/or siren.

When I asked why she submitted conflicting memorandums, Officer Kadien said she had checked with dispatch and that refreshed her memory.

I obtained the recording of the radio transmissions and dispatch notes related to this incident.

They confirm Officer Kadien was rerouted as well as her dispatch and arrival time.

I have attached the CD of the recordings, Officer Kadien's memorandums and the dispatch notes to this communication.


It should be noted that Officer Kadien was the only officer originally dispatched to this incident as Detective Lawrence and I were on other complaints.

It should also be noted that Officer Kadien acknowledges dispatch in relation to this complaint by "clicking" the microphone and not verbally doing so. This is something I know she has been counseled on several times by supervisors in the past.

Furthermore, the subject involved in this complaint was extremely volatile and for several minutes it was uncertain whether she was going to be violent towards herself and/or officers.

Based on the investigation conducted thus far, it appears there is no reasonable explanation for Officer Kadien's slow response time to an emergency report other than negligence and/or malfeasance.

She said if I didn't get them that she would kill herself. I told her no and we eventually hung up. A couple of minutes later the called back and said again that she wanted to kill herself. The said that she was going to slit her wrist and throat and that she was on a lot of medications so don't bother calling anyone because the time that got there she would have already bled out. She hung up and called me again stating that I already cut myself and the blood's about to drip.

In the past two weeks **states** has been talking about suicide a lot. She said she was waiting till after a wedding and then she was going to do it. **States** has been talking so much about it lately and sounded more convincing then in the past that I called 911 and immediately drove to her apartment. I'm worried about her safety and I am afraid she may follow through one of these times.
