NARRATIVE

X-REFERENCE CD #18-3080345 CMP WANTS TO REPORT THAT SHE HAS FOUND BRUISES ON THE BACK OF THE SECOND CHILD, SUB 3, WHICH SHE HAS A REPORT FILED IN BUFFALO, X-REFERENCE, AND THE FIRST CHILD, SUB 2, HAS HAD TWO SEVERE DIAPER RASHES AND APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN DRUGGED. CMP BELIEVES THAT SUB 2 IS LEFT IN THE CAR SEAT FOR LONG DURATIONS OF TIME WHILE HE IS IN THE FATHER'S CARE. THE CMP HAS FOUND MARBLING ON THE CHILD'S BUTTOCKS AREA. THE CMP ALSO REPORTS THAT SUB 3 HAS HAD A WRIST INJURY ON 11/4/18 WHICH SHE SOUGHT TREATMENT AT THE URGENT CARE BUT NO DEFINITIVE DIAGNOSIS WAS FOUND AT THAT TIME - JUST TOLD TO GIVE PAIN MEDS. 10/21/18 SUB 2 APPEARED TO BE DRUGGED AND THE CMP TOOK THE CHILD TO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF BUFFALO (NO BLOOD WORK WAS DRAWN)

11/3/18 SUB 3 HAD BRUISES ON HER BACK - REPORT WAS FILED WITH BUFFALO POLICE DEPARTMENT, X-REFERENCE

11/4/18 SUB 2 WAS AGAIN BROUGHT TO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF BUFFALO BECAUSE SHE BELIEVED THE CHILD HAD AN ALTERED LEVEL OF CONSCIOUSNESS (NO BLOOD DRAWN) 11/4/18 SUB 3 COMPLAINED OF WRIST PAIN. NO OBVIOUS INJURY

IN BOTH INSTANCES WITH SUB 3, THE CMP WAS REFERRED TO FOLLOW UP WITH HER PEDIATRICIAN.

VICTIM'S STATEMENT OF ALLEGATIONS

I CAME TO THE CHEEKTOWAGA POLICE DEPARTMENT TODAY TO DOCUMENT THE ABUSE AND NEGLECT THAT HAS HAPPENED ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS TO BOTH OF MY CHILDREN (OLIVIA RIFORD-DIARBAKERLY AND MASON RIFORD) DURING VISITATIONS WITH THEIR FATHER, PETER DIARBAKERLY. I HAVE NUMEROUS MEDICAL DOCUMENTATIONS FROM INCIDENTS. THE CHILDREN HAVE BEEN LABELED "HIGH RISK FOR NEGLECT" BY MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS DURING EMERGENCY ROOM/URGENT CARE VISITS. THEY HAVE SUFFERED FROM BRUISES/WELTS, HAIR FORCEFULLY PULLED, WRISTS FORCEFULLY PULLED, HEAT EXHAUSTION/DEHYDRATION, SEVERE DIAPER RASHES, AND THE BABY WAS DRUGGED ON TWO SEPERATE OCCASIONS. THE BABY HAS ALSO BEEN LEFT IN A SMALL INFANT CARRIER FOR HOURS CAUSING HIS SKIN TO MARBLE ON HIS BUTTOCKS. BOTH OF THESE CHILDREN ARE IN SERIOUS DISTRESS WHEN THE GO ON VISITATIONS WITH THEIR FATHER. FAMILY COURT WOULD NOT ISSUE AND ORDER OF PROTECTION DESPITE ALL OF MY EVIDENCE AND DESPITE MY DAUGHTER BEING IN AN EXTREMELY FRAGILE EMOTIONAL/MENTAL STATE (MEDICALLY DOCUMENTED). I AM DESPERATE TO KEEP THE CHILDREN SAFE AND AWAY FROM ABUSE/
