Dear Norb,

Last night at our Lonsdale block party, I talked with Chelse Prather, who told me she had considered applying for the AE Academy but thought she had missed the deadline. Do you know if they are still looking for applicants?

Chelse earned her Ph.D. from the University of Notre Dame in 2011. She teaches full-time at U.D., and she describes herself as an ecologist interested in questions at the interface of community and ecosystem ecology. She directs the Insect Ecology Lab in the Biology Department. This background explains why she brought homemade cicada chocolates to the block party. (A delicious edible I'll need another 17 years to experience.) Her potluck choice reflects a personality that enjoys enlivening a group gathering with good humor and charm.

Chelse's description of the Lab's mission tells a lot about her:

*The Insect Ecology lab is committed to creating an environment that is supportive of all aspiring scientists, values the perspectives of traditional and nontraditional backgrounds, and hears the perspectives of underrepresented groups in STEM. We believe the diversity brought by students from different racial identities, gender identities, sexualities, visible and invisible disabilities, ages, socioeconomic status, ethnicities, nationalities, religions, and cultures makes our science stronger, just as a diverse array of organisms in an ecosystem strengthens its resilience. We strive to create an atmosphere that promotes the safety, well-being, and success of those that work in the lab. We seek to do science to understand basic biological processes that also will have meaningful connections to society.*

Chelse now knows the deadline is Monday midnight. She believes she can secure her letters of recommendation and complete the application. She is aware of the time commitment. I can strongly recommend that the City consider Chelse as a second candidate to represent Oakwood. She's been an Oakwood resident for three years and has actively participated in OIC meeting(s). She would be an asset to the process, I am sure.

Chelse told me that she already has the application materials and she is aware that I am contacting you.
