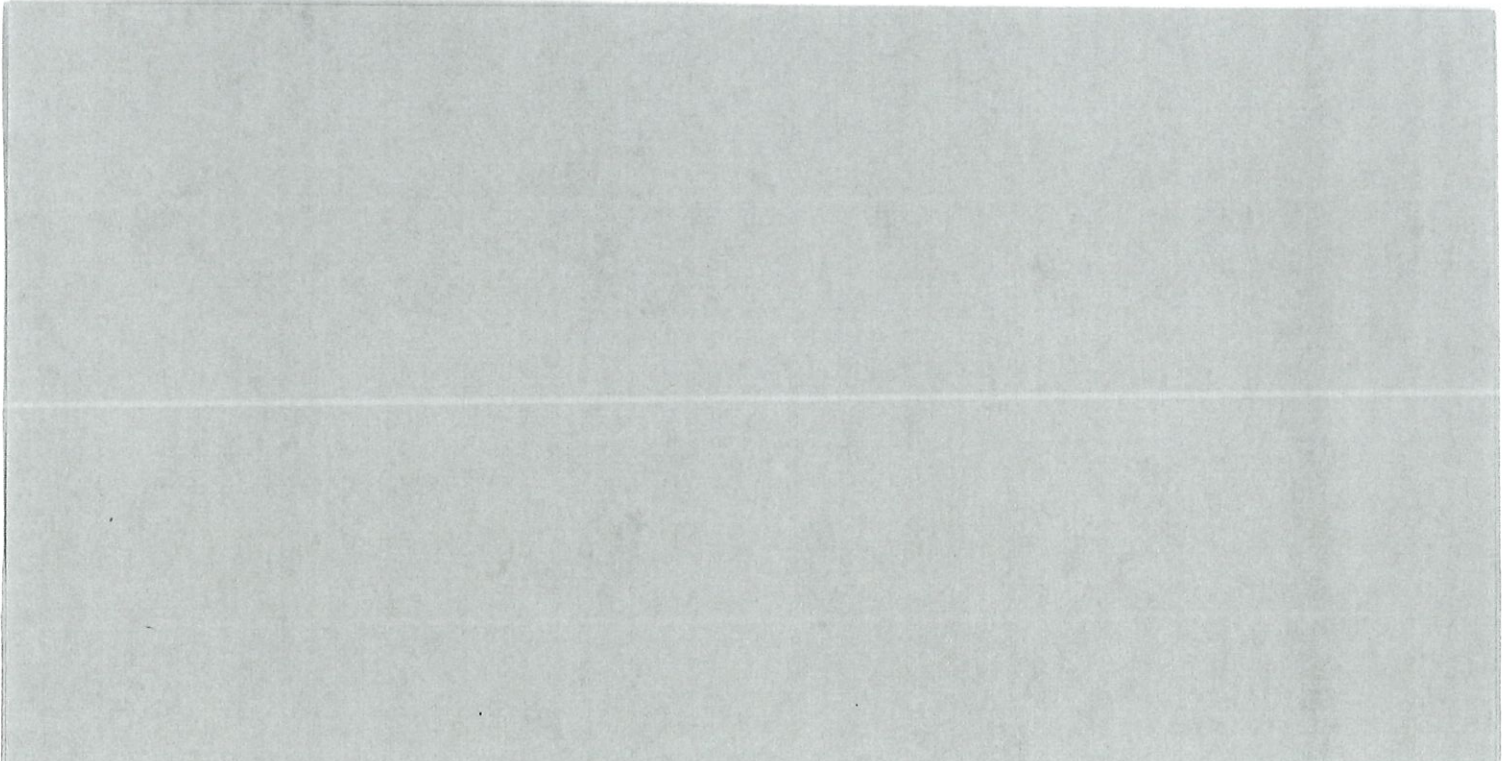

Nick:

All monies received from residential property tax levies are designated for the general fund. About 8% of the residential property tax paid by Oakwood homeowners goes to the city to help fund important city services such as police, fire and EMS; roadway maintenance; and parks, recreation & leisure services.

Within the General City Services category are a series of different funds, the three largest expenses being from the General Fund (where over half of the money is spent on police, fire and EMS services); Street Maintenance and Repair Fund; and Leisure Activity Fund (which includes all parks and recreation services.)

I was not sure how specific you were looking with regards to our property tax levies and actually monies spent since we do not designate a levy for a specific purpose. Our budget document gives more detail on specific amounts covered under general city services. The following are a few examples of how much is spent on average annually in general city services:

- \$450,000 on street repair and maintenance
- \$120,000 on sidewalk, curb and apron repair
- \$430,000 on leisure services
- \$5.4 million on public safety

Hopefully, this is answers your questions.
