Hi Dr. Enseleit,

The new CDC guidelines about masks indicate that in areas with substantial community spread, including Montgomery County, people are advised to mask up indoors. Since the library serves many people who cannot be vaccinated yet as well as those with underlying conditions, we are once again requesting that patrons mask when visiting the library. We may take some heat about this decision, so I'd like to gather a little more info. I was hoping you might be able to answer some of the following questions:

- Is there any data about COVID-19 spread in Oakwood and our neighboring communities? The public health dept of Montgomery county used to post covid-19 rates by zip code, but it doesn't look like they have updated that since last fall.
- Is it accurate that people who have been vaccinated can still be spreaders? Last week, I read the opposite.
- Do you have any recommendations regarding masks for businesses that serve many elderly and young children?
