

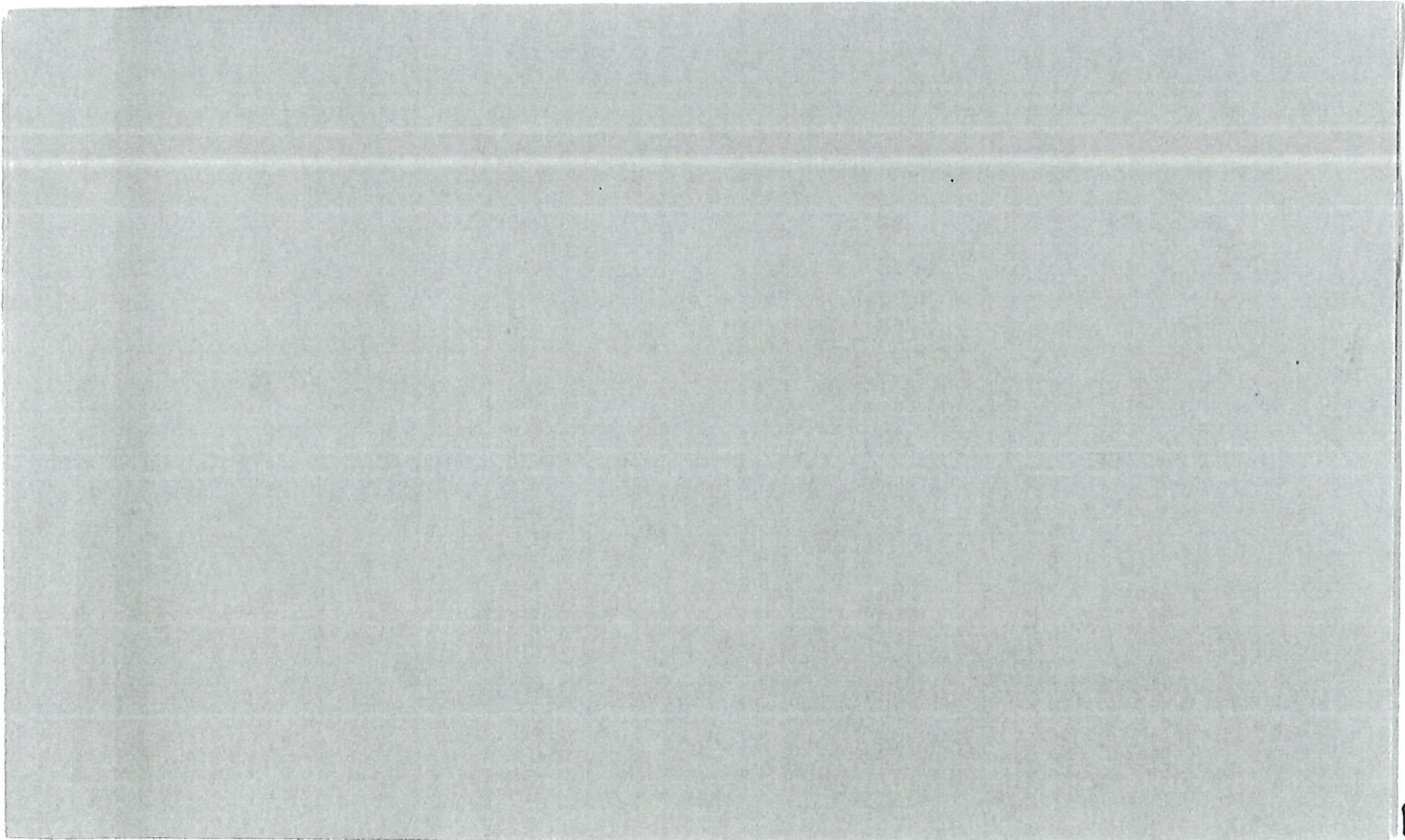

Last year, we participated with the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government (SWOP4G) consortium to receive bids for road salt. The solicitation had an option to provide a bid for two winter seasons (2020/2021 and 2021/2022). The bids were favorable for both years and our vendor, Cargill, recently provided us with an intent to contract with them for the second year. Attached is a copy of the response that Dave Shuey provided to Cargill with our intent to contract with them for the upcoming 2021/2022 winter season at a price of \$54.98 per ton (previous price for the 2020/2021 season was \$44.98).

Shafor Park Tennis Courts: Weather permitting, the acrylic court surface will be applied next week. The courts are scheduled to be reopened on or about July 29.

Pavement Marking: Our annual pavement marking (roadway striping) program started this week. It typically takes a couple weeks to complete... depending on weather.

Asphalt Resurfacing: The annual resurfacing program is set to begin next week. It will start with roadway base repairs on Patterson Road. These repairs are done in advance of the curb to curb mill and overlay operation. Enclosed is a Construction Alert postcard mailed to impacted property owners. 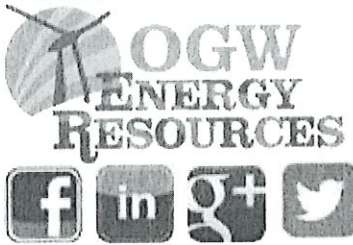

Ray,

I explained to Scoop my frustration with the limited selection of LED street light fixtures offered by Miami Valley Lighting (MVL). Like pretty much all local communities, we contract with MVL for street lighting services.

In the middle 1990s, we worked with MVL on a city-wide project to replace all of the old incandescent street lights, and a few Mercury Vapor lights... standardizing on High Pressure Sodium (HPS) fixtures. Our most commonly used street light is the 9,500 lumen HPS cobra head. The HPS fixtures provide a nice, soft light that works very well in our residential

community. The attached map clearly shows what Oakwood is... one big residential neighborhood... 2.2 square miles of residential streets bisected by State Route 48.

A year or two ago, MVL informed us that they will begin replacing our HPS fixtures with LEDs, one by one as the lights fail. To date, we have maybe 6-8 LEDs in Oakwood. They stand out like a sore thumb, compared to the HPS fixtures, and are not well received by our citizens.

I am hoping to find an LED street light that has the soft appearance of the HPS fixture... and then get MVL to offer it through their full service lighting contract.

Is this something you can help us with?

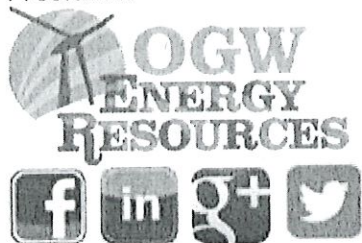
