My name is Vincent Megason and I am a commissioned Peace Officer by the State of Texas, and presently

employed as the Investigator for the Clifton Police Department.

On 12/08/2020 at approximately 3:10 P.M, I met with a man who walked into the Clifton Police Department and was identified as Jeffrey Reese ([REDACTED]). Jeff stated he was with the military and had been for the last 16 years. Jeff stated he was with a special ops team at this time and his ID could be looked at however it could not be touched by me due to the law preventing this.

Upon speaking with Jeff, he stated this all began years ago and provided me with a long story about his past and his investigation with the Sheriff's office and police departments around the areas.

Jeff stated he had met Jim Parks who was identified as James Parks ([REDACTED]) a few years back and made friends with him. Jeff stated he had done several jobs for Jim and had been paid a little however not all of the money which he was due.

Jeff stated Jim had hired him this last time to rebuild a part of his motor cycle and this was a long and expensive job which he stated he had been working on the bike for two weeks and had not been paid since he started. Jeff stated at the end of the job he was about done and explained to Jim he was ready to be paid and he would be wrapping things up and ready to head out.

Jeff stated Jim walked inside for the residence and walked back out with a short barrel pistol grip shotgun and explained to Jeff he was done and he wanted him off of his property and to not return.

Jim Parks has been known in the past to be aggressive and loud with people outside of his residence however we have never been called to his residence for any reason.

Jeff stated Jim did not point the gun at him nor did Jim threaten him with the gun he only was holding the gun in his hands.

Jeff stated the neighbor to Jim was outside at the time and possibly witnessed this occurred.

The interview was recorded and Jeff wrote a written statement both have been attached to this report for review.

I then days later met with the neighbor who stated she did not wish to be a part of the report and will remain unidentified at this time. She stated she does not care for Jim parks and he does scare her. She stated she does not remember a man in a van doing any kind of work or even a van being parked in the drive way of Jim Parks residence.

I found this odd due to the fact Jeff stated he was parked in the drive way and he does drive an older van which would stick out in this area.

Jim Parks refused to speak with me in reference to this case. I then spoke with our county attorney and updated her of the case, and she stated she would not be taking the case due to the information listed above.

Due to all the information this case will be filed with the Clifton Police Department and closed at this time.
