On January 5, 2023 at approximately 11:33 a.m., Columbus Police Patrol Officers were dispatched to Beechcroft High School on reports of the building being struck by gunfire. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the principal, **SAMUEL JOHNSON JR.** Mr. Johnson stated that the school was in session when an unknown individual, later identified as **NOAH NATHANIEL BENJAMIN BENNETT**, aboard a black colored SUV, fired multiple gunshots striking the north side of the school building but not penetrating the structure. **TYRON BEARD** was a lone student walking in the parking lot at this time, but left prior to police arrival. There were no injuries reported.

At approximately 12:49 p.m., I, day mid-watch Felony Assault Detective Adam Federer #1432, arrived at scene after being notified of the incident by patrol officers. Upon arrival, I observed multiple spent shell casings in the parking lot area of the north side of the school building. Also observed were multiple bullet strikes (which did not penetrate) to the north side of the school building. I took a series of twenty-three (23) standard digital photographs and collected four (4) items of evidence (3 spent 9mm shell casings, 1 spent projectile), which were later submitted to the police Property Room, *Property* #23P000298.

At approximately 1:10 p.m., day mid-watch Felony Assault Detectives James France #2227 and David Younker #1516 arrived at scene and were met by Felony Assault Lieutenant Julie Williams #5045. At this time, I viewed the exterior surveillance video played for him by security staff. The video showed a black SUV, similar to a Honda CRV, with silver trim around the windows and a figure hanging over the top of the vehicle from the passenger side. There was no license plate identified and no sex or race identified. Detectives were informed they needed a subpoena to retrieve the video.

At approximately 5:38 p.m., I accompanied second shift Robbery Detective Michael Longworth #1737 to the area of 1723 Shanley Drive, after being advised that patrol officers recovered an entered stolen vehicle out of an earlier robbery, possibly matching the description of the vehicle in this incident at the school. Several apprehensions were made in association with the stolen vehicle to include Noah Bennett, who was in possession of a bag of live handgun ammunition concealed in his sweatshirt pocket. During the arrest process, officers retrieved a loaded Taurus G25 9mm, Serial #TLR76289, from behind Mr. Bennett's right knee inside his pants. Officers observed a round inside the chamber of said gun and a single round in the magazine. This handgun and ammunition was later submitted to the police Property Room, Property #23P000322.

This vehicle was a 2013 black Honda CRV, bearing Ohio license *JNY 2483*, in the rear window. The vehicle was impounded and transported to the police Impound Lot for future processing.

At approximately 8:33 p.m., Detective Longworth and I conducted an interview with Noah Bennett at Police Headquarters 5th floor #556. Mr. Bennett admitted his nickname was "**Drako**", after the firearm, and was read his *Constitutional Rights* and decided to make a statement. He stated he did fire gunshots that struck the school from a black Honda CRV. He explained he fired those gunshots in the area of where Tyrun was walking because he felt threatened by Tyrun.




On January 10, 2023 at approximately 5:25 p.m., I conducted a telephone interview with Mr. Beard in the presence of his mother, <u>JAMIE BEARD</u>. He stated he was walking alone in the rear parking lot of the school, waiting on his brother to come pick him up when the shooting occurred. He went on to say he observed a black SUV with unknown masked individuals pull into the parking lot and stare at him. He stated no words were exchanged, so he started to walk back towards the school when he heard four (4) gunshots. He reported that he turned around and saw the vehicle leaving, but never saw anyone with a gun or shooting a gun. Mr. Beard also stated he never had a gun and never acted like he had a gun. He stated he was not injured during the incident and had no idea why this occurred.

Based on the above facts, it is respectfully requested that the Franklin County Court of Domestic Relations continue the prosecution of **NOAH NATHANIEL BENJAMIN BENNETT**, on one (1) count of Improperly Discharging a Firearm Into a Habitation, under §2923.161(A-1) of the Ohio Revised Code, a felony of the 2nd degree; and one (1) count of Carrying Concealed Weapons, under §2923.12(A-2) of the Ohio Revised Code, a felony of the fourth degree; any other applicable charges, for possessing and firing a firearm into the temporary habitation of Beechcroft High School, located at 6100 Beechcroft Drive in Columbus, Ohio.

At approximately 12:49 p.m., I arrived on scene after being notified of the incident by patrol officers. Upon arrival, I observed multiple spent shell casings in the parking lot area on the north side of the school building. Also observed were multiple bullet strikes (which did not penetrate) to the north side of the school building. I took a series of twenty-three (23) standard digital photographs and collected four (4) items of evidence (3-spent 9mm shell casings, 1- spent projectile) which were later submitted to the police Property Room, *Property* #23P000298.

At approximately 1:10 p.m., day mid-watch Felony Assault Detectives James France #2227 and David Younker #1516 arrived at scene and were met by Felony Assault Lieutenant Julie Williams #5045. At this time I viewed the exterior surveillance video played for him by security staff. The video showed a black SUV similar to that of a Honda CRV with silver trim around the windows and a figure hanging over the top of the vehicle from the passenger side. There was no license plate identified and no sex or race identified. I was informed I needed a subpoena to retrieve the video.

At approximately 1:17 p.m., I conducted an interview with <u>MAI'ARAH SULLIVAN</u> in the presence of Mr. Johnson Jr., inside Mr. Johnson's office. Mr. Johnson stated he was inside of his office when the shooting occurred and he did not witness the incident. He stated he received notification after the shooting from teacher, <u>AMANDA COX</u>, that she received an Instagram post meant for Mai'arah, citing that the author was at the school wanting Mai'arah to come outside and fight.

Miss Sullivan stated she had been having an issue with a girl on Instagram that has an Instagram name of <u>ISLAND</u>. She stated Island sent a message notifying Mai'arah that she would be up at the school soon, which Miss Sullivan believed was to fight. The message cited, "Tell dat bitch come out da schoo, one I'm salty asf tell @taylor2federal come out cuz! They put dat bitch on lockdown," with a reported location of Beechcroft High School. For complete details of the interview with Mai'arah Sullivan see *Informational Summary* #2.

At approximately 1:19 p.m., Detectives Younker and France conducted an interview with teacher, **KATIE ROSS** in a teacher room inside the school. Ms. Ross stated she was in classroom #216 when she heard a loud "**popping**" sound and then something struck the building three (3) separate times. She looked out the classroom window and observed a black Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV), with someone wearing a black hoodie standing in the open sunroof. Ms. Ross stated she never saw face of the individual wearing the black hoodie as they were facing away from her. For complete details of the interview with Ms. Ross, see *Informational Summary* #3.

At approximately 1:42 p.m., Detectives Younker and France conducted an interview with <u>DESARAY</u> <u>DORELIEN</u> in a teacher room inside the school. Miss Dorelien stated she heard one (1) gunshot and then two (2) more, so she looked outside. She observed an individual "hanging out" of the rear passenger side window of a black SUV. When asked if she saw anyone firing a weapon, she replied, "No." For complete details of the interview with Desaray Dorelien, see *Informational Summary* #4.

At approximately 5:38 p.m., I accompanied second shift Robbery Detective Michael Longworth #1737 to the area of 1723 Shanley Drive, after being advised that patrol officers recovered an entered stolen vehicle out of an earlier robbery, possibly matching the description of the vehicle in the earlier gunfire striking the school.

Several apprehensions were made in association with the stolen vehicle to include **NOAH BENNETT**, who was in possession of a bag of live handgun ammunition concealed in his sweatshirt pocket. During the arrest process, Officer Steve Rowlands #2342 retrieved a loaded Taurus G25 9mm, *Serial #TLR76289*, from behind Mr. Bennett's right knee inside his pants. Officer Rowlands observed a round inside the chamber of said gun and a single round in the magazine. This handgun and ammunition was later submitted to the police Property Room, *Property No.:23P000322*.

This vehicle was a 2013 black Honda CRV, bearing Ohio license *JNY 2483* in the rear window. The vehicle was impounded and transported to the police Impound Lot for future processing. I advised first responding Officers Rowlands, Ryan Evans #2624, and Mark Heinl #3171 to complete *Letters of Information*, noting their actions and observations. These letters were completed as *Informational Summaries #5*, #6, and #7.

At approximately 7:41 p.m., Detective Longworth and I conducted an interview with <u>JELON</u> <u>MCDOWELL</u> at Police Headquarters 5th floor #558. Mr. McDowell was read his *Constitutional Rights* and decided to make a statement. Mr. McDowell stated he was in the Honda CRV when Noah fired the gunshots. He explained he saw Noah fire multiple gunshots in the direction that "Teshawn" was walking. For complete details of the interview with Mr. McDowell, see *Informational Summary* #8.

At approximately 8:21 p.m., Detectives Longworth and I conducted an interview with **KEEMONTE HERRING** at Police Headquarters 5th floor #558. Mr. Herring was read his *Constitutional Rights* and decided not to make a statement. For complete details of the interview with Keemonte Herring, see *Informational Summary* #9.

At approximately 8:33 p.m., Detectives Longworth and I conducted an interview with Noah Bennett at Police Headquarters 5th floor #556. Mr. Bennett admitted his nickname was "**Drako**", after the firearm, and was read his *Constitutional Rights* and decided to make a statement. Mr. Bennett stated he did fire gunshots that struck the school, from a black Honda CRV. He explained he fired those gunshots in the area of where Teshawn was walking, because he felt threatened by "Teshawn". For complete details of the interview with Mr. Bennett, see *Informational Summary* #10.

On January 6, 2023 at approximately 10:22 a.m., I contacted Mr. Johnson and advised him of the arrest.

At approximately 10:36 a.m., I created a subpoena for the retrieval of the surveillance video at the school, which was electronically submitted to the Franklin County Municipal Courts. Franklin County Municipal Court Judge Jodi Thomas reviewed the subpoena electronically and gave her judicial consent for its execution.

At approximately 3:27 p.m., I emailed the signed subpoena to Columbus City Schools Paralegal Jeenah Trout for compliance.

On January 8, 2023, first shift Robbery Detective John Herman #681 accompanied by first shift Crime Scene Search Unit Detective Nicole Prysock #228, processed the Honda CRV at the police Impound Lot. Detective Prysock retrieved three (3) latent lifts from the rear driver door. Detective Herman then released the vehicle to the owner.

On January 10, 2023 at approximately 5:25 p.m., I conducted a telephone interview with **TYRUN BEARD**, in the presence of his mother, **JAMIE BEARD**. Mr. Beard stated he was walking alone in the rear parking lot of the school waiting on his brother to come pick him up when the shooting occurred. He went on to say he observed a black SUV with unknown masked individuals pull into the parking lot and stare at him. He stated no words were exchanged so he started to walk back towards the school, when he heard four (4) gunshots. He stated he turned around and saw the vehicle leaving, but never saw anyone with a gun or shoot a gun. Mr. Beard also stated he never had a gun and never acted like he had a gun. He stated he was not injured during the incident and had no idea why this occurred. For complete details of the interview with Tyrun Beard, see *Informational Summary #11*.

At approximately 5:48 p.m., I spoke to <u>EVETTE LANGSTON</u>, who is the mother of Mai'arah Sullivan. She was with her daughter and they concluded that the ongoing dispute Mai'arah was having on Instagram was not related to the shooting that occurred at Beechcroft. They were encouraged to call back if new information became available.

When me and my partner, Officer Greg Hudson #2253, arrived at scene, we went into the school first to make contact with anybody who could tell us where the shots were fired. The Assistant Principal Dion Drakeford showed us to the north lot, where he pointed to the area of the parking lot. Officers did find three (3) shell casings just north of the 2nd story classroom where the witnesses were during the shooting. My partner used crime scene tape to section off the area and I went back inside where I remained in the Principal's office with the listed others.

I listened to the principal ask <u>MAI'ARAH SULLIVAN</u> questions about her involvement. Based on what I heard, Mai'arah got into a verbal fight with <u>K'SHAWN RICHARDSON</u> and some other boys back in December. She admitted to making some comment to K'Shawn about his dead family member and this made K'Shawn very upset. I could not really understand what connection K'Shawn may have with <u>ISLAND</u>, but it was shortly after this incident that Island began to threaten Mai'arah. Mai'arah said she tried to apologize, but the damage was already done and several students were upset with her. The principal showed me and Sergeant Michael Bruce #5338 an Instagram post from Island asking a girl named <u>REMIAH THOMAS</u> to "send that bitch out" (possibly referring to Mai'arah).

On January 5, 2023, at approximately 1:17 p.m., I, day midwatch Felony Assault Detective Adam Federer #1432, conducted an interview with <u>MAI'ARAH SULLIVAN</u> in the presence of Beechcroft High School Principal <u>SAMUEL JOHNSON</u>, <u>JR</u>. inside his office. Mai'arah was identified as a witness to this incident by Patrol officers. The following is a summation of that interview:

At the onset of the interview, Mr. Johnson explained he was inside his office when the shooting occurred and did not witness the incident. After the shooting, teacher <u>AMANDA COX</u> informed him she received an Instagram post meant for Mai'arah. She stated the author was at the school and wanted Mai'arah to come outside and fight.

Mai'arah stated she was inside Beechcroft High School when the shooting occurred and did not witness the incident. She believed the incident may be related to a dispute she has been having with a female on Instagram who has an Instagram name of "ISLAND". She stated Island sent a message notifying Mai'arah she (Island) would be at the school soon and Mai'arah believed it was to fight. The message cited "tell dat bitch come out da schoo, onc I'm salty asf tell @taylor2federal come out cuz! They put dat bitch on lockdown", with a reported location of Beechcroft High School. Mai'arah explained "taylor2federal" is her Instagram name.

Mai'arah stated Island has never directly threatened to shoot her and has not claimed responsibility for the shooting that just occurred at the school. Mai'arah does not know the legal identity of Island and has never seen her in person. She disclosed that Island has referenced criminal street gangs in the past and may be affiliated with a Crip set. She also stated Island has digital photographs of herself on Instagram holding handguns with green lasers affixed to them.

On January 5, 2023, at approximately 3:15 p.m., officers on Columbus Police Community Response Team (CRT) 1 were in the area of Dresden Street and Fenton Street on an unrelated investigation when Officer Steve Rowlands #2342, in Cruiser #7110, observed a black Honda CRV driving at high rate of speed and in a reckless manner westbound on Fenton Street towards Shanley Drive. Officers on Zone 1 were aware that a black Honda CRV was involved in a shots fired incident at Beechcroft High School. Officers were also aware that a black Honda CRV was stolen in an armed robbery from the Linden area earlier in the day.

Officers Rowlands aired the information on the radio and officers circulated the Shanley Drive area looking for the CRV. Officer Kyle Cull #2588 was in an unmarked vehicle and observed a black Honda CRV with no visible license plate turn into the apartments at 1703 Shanley Drive. Officer Ryan Evans #2624, in Cruiser #7115, was driving westbound on Shanley Avenue, passing Dresden Street when he observed the same Honda CRV with dark tinted windows, turn southbound into the apartment complex at 1703 Shanley Avenue from eastbound Shanley Avenue.

Officer Evans turned into the complex at the same time as Officer Cull. Officer Cull witnessed the CRV pull into a parking spot in front of 1723. The vehicle was left running while three (3) people exited and quickly turned the corner and walked southbound into the complex. The officer observed the occupants exit the driver front, passenger front, and passenger rear doors. Officer Cull was only able to see the rear of the group and was unable to identify anyone from the CRV. The officer observed a distinct hair color and style of the passenger rear occupant to be a yellow afro, but was unable to observe any additional clothing or physical features.

Officer Evans pulled his cruiser directly behind the Honda and observed it was running, but was not able to see if it was occupied or not. Officer Evans looked to the left quickly as he was clearing the cabin of the vehicle and observed a male, later identified as Mr. **NOAH NATHANIEL-BENJAMIN BENNETT**, shuffling slightly and frantically looking around as if he was looking for a place to run from officers. Officer Evans cleared the passenger compartment of the Honda and looked again to where he saw Mr. Bennett standing and noticed he was gone.

Officer Evans looked to the upper, southern most apartment terrace of building 1731 where he observed the listed witnesses, Mr. <u>EDUARDO HERCULES</u> and Mr. <u>RODRIGO MIRAMONTES</u>, JR., standing. Mr. Hercules motioned with his hands to the south and east. Officer Evans asked them if he was indicating the direction of travel for the occupants of the Honda and he again motioned with his hands in the same direction. Officer Evans aired the direction of travel and began to search the complex on foot as several additional cruisers arrived to assist.

As Officer Evans searched the complex, he saw Mr. Bennett standing in the same nervous manner near the corner of 1763 Shanley Drive, facing the second door in from the east side of the building, later observed to be Apartment 11. Officer Evans remained focused on the complex, searching for additional suspects running as he approached Mr. Bennet from the west. Mr. Bennet looked to his left and made eye contact with Officer Evans and immediately turned to his right where he quickly walked around the east side of the building, back out toward Shanley Drive.

Officer Evans aired the description of the male to the other responding officers as Columbus Police Department (CPD) Cruiser #188 pulled into the complex at 1763. Officer Evans quickly moved toward the corner of the building when he observed Mr. Bennett walked back quickly around the corner and was confronted by Officer Evans. Officers Evans, Mark Heinl #3171, and Kevin Stewart #2871 ordered Mr. Bennet to the ground. Mr. Bennet complied and was taken into custody by Officer Stewart. Officer Stewart quickly placed Mr. Bennett into handcuffs and sat him in the rear of CPD Cruiser #7113 in order to continue the search for the additional occupants.

Officer Evans returned to the building where the two (2) witnesses were and asked them if they would be able to identify the occupants of the Honda. Mr. Hercules stated he saw them leave the vehicle and that "the one you got was him." Officer Evans observed that Mr. Hercules spoke broken English and thus contacted Officer Jose James #2465 to translate, due to him being fluent in Spanish.

Officer Hatfield, in Cruiser #7110, observed a red Hyundai Sonata, Ohio tag *JVS-7529*, turn into the same complex and two (2) male blacks ran from the vehicle. The driver, later identified as **JELON MCDOWELL**, was apprehended after a brief foot chase in the apartment complex.

After the two (2) additional apprehensions, Officer Evans returned to Mr. Hercules who stated that another male, Mr. Miramontes, Jr., who was on the apartment terrace with him, also would be able to identify people from the Honda. Officer James translated over the phone and requested they view the two (2) additional apprehensions made by officers to confirm or deny if they were occupants of the Honda. Mr. Hercules and Mr. Miramontes both agreed to view the apprehensions if they could remain hidden from their view. Officers assured both of them that they would be hidden from view.

Officer Evans placed Mr. Hercules in the rear of CPD Cruiser #7115 over to Cruiser #183 where Officer Dickson removed Mr. **KEEMONTE HERRING** from the rear seat. Officer Evans asked Mr. Hercules if he believed Mr. Herring was one (1) of the occupants and he replied he could not be 100% sure and that he did not believe Mr. Herring got out of the Honda. Officer Evans relayed the information to Officer Dickson who then sat Mr. Herring back in the cruiser. Officer Evans then transported Mr. Hercules over to Cruiser #7110 where Officer Hatfield removed Mr. McDowell from the rear and faced his cruiser. Officer Evans asked Mr. Hercules if he believed Mr. McDowell was (1) one of the occupants from the Honda and he replied he was certain Mr. McDowell exited the Honda and walked away just prior to seeing the police cruiser behind it. Officer Evans relayed the information to Officer Hatfield, who then sat Mr. McDowell back in the cruiser. Officer Evans released Mr. Hercules.

Officer Evans spoke with Officer Krishna Sharma Subedi #3308, who stated he only transported Mr. Miramontes to identify Mr. Herring and not Mr. McDowell. Officer Evans then sat Mr. Miramontes in the rear of Cruiser #7115 and transported him to Cruiser #7110. Officer Hatfield removed Mr. McDowell from the rear of his cruiser and faced him toward Cruiser #7115. Mr. Miramontes confirmed that Mr. McDowell was one (1) of the occupants that exited the Honda, which Officer Evans relayed to Officer Hatfield. Officer Evans returned Mr. Miramontes to the apartment where he spoke again briefly with Mr. Hercules. Officer Evans asked Mr. Hercules to ask Mr. Miramontes which door Mr. McDowell exited. Mr. Hercules relayed that Mr. Miramontes viewed Mr. McDowell exit the driver's side front door of the Honda just prior to seeing the police cruiser pull in behind it.

Officer Evans obtained the identification information for both witnesses, which was provided on the report.

Officer Evans moved Mr. Herring from the rear of Cruiser #183 to the rear of Cruiser #7115. Officer Evans later contacted his grandmother and legal guardian, Ms. **SKYY F. WILLIAMS**, who responded to the scene and confirmed the identity of her grandson, Mr. Herring.

Officers Evans, Rowlands, and Hatfield respectively, transported all of the individuals to CPD Headquarters, where they were interviewed by detectives.

Officers later determined that the Honda CRV was the same one (1) taken in the robbery earlier in the day. The Hyundai Sonata had its column peeled and back driver side window broken out, but not reported stolen. Officers were unable to contact the registered owner. It was impounded at the CPD Impound Lot as suspected stolen.

On January 5, 2023, at 3:19 p.m., Officer Steve Rowlands #2342, Community Response Team (CRT) 1, was in Columbus Police Department (CPD) Cruiser #7113, at Dresden Street and Shanley Drive. Officer Rowlands observed a black Honda CRV traveling recklessly southbound on Dresden Street, west of Belcher Drive. Officer Rowlands observed two (2) male black juveniles in the front passenger compartment of said vehicle. Officer Rowlands observed the front windows to be down, but the rear windows to have dark tint and were powered up.

Officer Rowlands had recalled a suspect vehicle aired earlier in his shift regarding a shooting at Beechcroft High School involving a black Honda CRV as the suspect vehicle. Officer Rowlands aired said vehicle and its direction of travel. Minutes later, Officer Rowlands heard CRT1 plain clothes Officer Kyle Cull #2588 air said Honda CRV and suspects around the area of 1723 Shanley Drive. At the same time, Officer Ryan Evans #2624, in Cruiser #7115, aired that suspects were fleeing in the rear of 1723 Shanley Drive. Officer Rowlands responded and observed Officers Kevin Stewart #2871 and Mark Heinl #3171, in Prisoner Transport Vehicle (PTV) #188, getting an apprehension of a juvenile, later identified as **NOAH BENNETT**. Mr. Bennett was observed with his pants down from his waist.

Officer Rowlands allowed PTV #188 officers to place Mr. Bennett in the rear seat of Cruiser 7113. Mr. Bennett was already handcuffed by PTV #188 officers prior to being handed to Officer Rowlands. PTV #188 officers also handed Officer Rowlands a plastic bag containing bullets retrieved from the front hooded sweatshirt pocket of Mr. Bennett's person.

Just moments after Mr. Bennett was placed in the rear seat of Cruiser #7113, another chase occurred involving a suspected stolen red Hyundai Sonata in the very same parking lot of 1723 Shanley Drive. There were two (2) more apprehensions of an adult suspect and juvenile suspect. Officer Rowlands started to assist in the foot pursuit of one (1) of the suspects fleeing past his cruiser, but remembered the suspect that had been placed in his cruiser. Officer Rowlands returned to Cruiser #7113 and completed the arrest paperwork.

Mr. Bennett said, "Yes," and stared towards his pants that were down near his thighs. Officer Rowlands retrieved a loaded Taurus G25 9mm, Serial #TLR76289, from behind Mr. Bennett's right knee inside his pants. Officer Rowlands observed a round inside the chamber of said gun and a single round in the magazine.

Mr. Bennett was transported to CPD Headquarters 5th floor and ID Bureau. He was read his *Constitutional Rights* and decided to make a statement. During the interview, Mr. Bennett stated he was at Beechcroft High School where he encountered an unknown individual he believed was reaching for an unknown object. He stated he fired three (3) gunshots in this individual's direction from the recovered firearm, which subsequently struck the exterior of the school. He was slated at the Franklin County Court of Domestic Relations.

After gathering the biographical information, Detective Longworth read Mr. McDowell the top portion of the *Constitutional Rights* form as printed, and provided him a copy with which to follow along. Mr. McDowell stated he understood his rights and briefly explained those rights. He advised he understood the waiver portion.

Mr. McDowell stated he was with "<u>KEE KEE</u>," later identified as <u>KEEMONTE HERRING</u>; and <u>DRAKO</u>, later identified as <u>NOAH BENNETT</u>, when the shooting occurred. Mr. McDowell explained earlier that morning when he was with them, they attempted to steal a vehicle. The vehicle alarm activated and they ran. Detective Longworth asked Mr. McDowell where they got the black Honda CRV. He responded, "I don't know whose CRV it was. I just seen it and hopped in the car like, okay."

Mr. McDowell stated Keemonte was the driver and had keys to the CRV, so Mr. McDowell got in. Detective Longworth asked Mr. McDowell who in his group pointed a gun at the female and stole the black Honda CRV from her. Mr. McDowell advised, "You could say it was Drako, too. Yup. Drako did it." He later recanted and said, "No, that's not how it worked. Kee Kee than said, 'I'm fuckin getting tired of bein' out here in this cold ass ten (10) degree weather. Let me get that fucking gun.' He grabbed the fucking gun from Drako. He didn't cock it back. There was no bullet in it. He actually took the clip out to make sure she didn't get hurt. He was like, 'Hey miss, can I ask you a question?' And she was like, 'What?' 'Does that car have a push to start?' And then he upped on her." I asked Mr. McDowell if they retrieved the key from the female or peeled the column of the Honda. He explained, "We had the keys for that one, but you can't peel the columns for a Honda. Its only Hyundai's and Kias I guess."

Mr. McDowell stated they later went to Beechcroft High School in the stolen black Honda CRV to pick up a male named "<u>KILLER</u>," and another individual he referred to as "<u>LIGHT SKINNED PUSSY BOY</u>." When asked why they went to the school, Mr. McDowell advised, "Because some girl said, 'Somebody is talkin' shit about me and they said they was gonna shoot me." Mr. McDowell explained Keemonte was driving, Mr. McDowell was seated behind Keemonte, and Noah was in the front passenger seat.

Mr. McDowell initially stated when they arrived in the parking lot, an unknown individual, later identified as <u>TYRUN BEARD</u>, started shooting at them so they left. He stated, "When we pulled up, dude was already outside so he started shootin at us. You may hear on the news, cause like four (4) shots went off." Mr. McDowell later stated when they pulled up next to Tyrun, they all asked him, "What's up?" in a combative manner. He stated Tyrun put his hand in his pocket as if he was concealing something and started to walk away.

I asked Mr. McDowell if Keemonte fired gunshots at Beechcroft High School and he replied, "Keemonte didn't shoot that gun." I then asked if Noah fired the gunshots. Mr. McDowell motioned with his right arm across his chest and held his right hand as a gun, and stated, "He probably shot like this out the window, but he didn't hit nobody."

When asked what Noah was shooting at, Mr. McDowell responded, "That person walking that the girl was talkin shit," referring to Tyrun. I asked Mr. McDowell why Noah waited until the individual in the parking lot was walking away before he fired and Mr. McDowell answered, "I said that." When asked who was having a dispute with Tyrun, Mr. McDowell replied, "All three (3) of them boys in that car." After he admitted he had touched the gun Noah used, I asked Mr. McDowell to describe it. He responded, "It's a Taurus. It about this big and this wide and the clip is thin. 9 millimeter. It holds seven (7) bullets, eight (8) when one (1) is in the head."

Noah stated he understood his rights and briefly explained those rights. He advised he understood the waiver portion.

Noah admitted his nickname is "<u>DRAKO</u>" and stated he was with "<u>KEE KEE</u>," later identified as <u>KEEMONTE HERRING</u> and <u>JE'LON MCDOWELL</u>, when the shooting occurred. Noah explained prior to that, at approximately 7:00 in the morning, he was with a female, Keemonte, and Mr. McDowell when Keemonte robbed a female and stole her black Honda CRV. When asked which one (1) of them had the gun, Noah remarked, "It was Kee Kee. I don't know." Detective Longworth asked Noah what happened next and he stated, "All I heard was errrrr, 'Get in,' so I did." He stated Keemonte was driving the Honda CRV he just stolen and they left the area in the vehicle.

Noah stated sometime after they left, they traveled to Beechcroft High School. Keemonte drove, Mr. McDowell was in the front passenger seat, and an unknown individual sat behind Keemonte while he occupied the backseat behind Mr. McDowell. Noah stated a male friend of his called them to the school to deal with an ongoing dispute. He denied the dispute was between two (2) females as initial rumors suggested.

I asked Noah if he was attempting to kill someone when he fired the gunshots in the parking lot. He immediately responded, "No. Of course not. I was tryin to protect myself." When asked what he meant, he said, "Dude got to reachin, so I was like what you reachin for?" Noah clarified it was the individual on foot walking in the parking lot when they pulled in, later identified as TYRUN BEARD. I asked why he had a problem with Tyrun and he replied, "It's not me, well it my brother but. I guess they go to the same school. We know him from middle school." When asked why he waited until the vehicle and Tyrun had separated a good distance before he fired the gunshots, Noah remarked, "You want me to be one hundred honest? I'm hearin, bro got a gun, gun, he was reachin in his coat pocket, I don't know what the deal is. But of course I wasn't try to, you know." In an attempt at clarification, I asked Noah how he could feel threatened by Tyrun, who was walking the opposite direction almost one hundred (100) feet away and he replied, "I definitely felt threatened. I'm hanging out the window, I hear he got a gun. Cause that was never supposed to, who wants to shoot at the school, never!"

When asked how many gunshots he fired, Noah remarked, "I don't know." He later stated, "Like you said, three (3)." I asked Noah if he was shooting at Tyrun when he was attempting to protect himself. He said, "No." I asked Noah if anyone else inside the vehicle had a gun or fired a gun while at Beechcroft High School. He answered, "No, sir." When asked if the gun he discarded in the police cruiser was the same gun he fired at Beechcroft High School, he responded by nodding his head yes. I asked what type of gun it was and Noah answered, "Tarus G2, 9 millimeter." He alleged he found the gun at an unknown time in an unknown location.

Noah explained they left the school parking lot after the shooting. He admitted he exited the black Honda CRV when he encountered police and was apprehended. When asked how he felt about firing gunshots and striking the school, Noah remarked, "I definitely sorry, endangering all them lives."

On 1/5/2023, at 3:19 P.M, Officer Rowlands #2342/CRT1 was in marked CPD cruiser 7113 at Dresden Street and Shanley Drive. Officer Rowlands observed a black Honda CRV traveling recklessly South on Dresden St. W/O Belcher Drive. Officer Rowlands observed 2 male black juveniles in the front passenger compartment of said vehicle. Officer Rowlands observed the front windows to be down but the rear windows to have dark tint and powered up.

Firearm Present Y - Yes (If yes, provide a statement of fact surrounding the incident, including the presence of a firearm.)

Officer Rowlands had recalled a suspect vehicle aired earlier in his shift regarding a shooting at Beechcroft High School involving a black Honda CRV as the suspect vehicle. Officer Rowlands aired said vehicle and its direction of travel. Minutes later, Officer Rowlands heard CRT1 plain clothes Officer Kyle Cull air said Honda CRV and suspects around the area of 1723 Shanley Drive. At the same time, Officer Evans in cruiser 7115 aired that suspects were fleeing in the rear of 1723 Shanley Drive. Officer Rowlands responded and observed Officers Stewart and Heinl, (PTV 188), getting an apprehension of a juvenile later identified as Noah Bennett. Mr. Bennett was observed with his pants down from his waist. Officer Rowlands allowed PTV 188 officers to place Mr. Bennett in the rear seat of cruiser 7113. Mr. Bennett was already handcuffed by PTV 188 officers prior to being handed to Officer Rowlands. PTV 188 officers also handed Officer Rowlands a plastic bag containing bullets retrieved from the front hooded sweatshirt pocket of Mr. Bennett's person.

After Mr. Bennett was placed in the rear seat of cruiser 7113, another chase just moments later occurred involving a suspected stolen red Hyundai Sonata in the very same parking lot of 1723 Shanley Drive. There were 2 more apprehensions of an adult suspect and juvenile suspect. Officer Rowlands started to assist in the foot pursuit of one of the suspects fleeing past his cruiser but remembered the suspect that had been placed in his cruiser. Officer Rowlands returned to cruiser 7113 and completed arrest paperwork. Several hours had passed and Officer Rowlands asked Mr. Bennett if he was "holding anything" on his person. Mr. Bennett got quiet and appeared nervous. Mr. Bennett said, "yes," and stared towards his pants that were down near his thighs. Officer Rowlands retrieved a loaded Taurus G25, 9mm, Serial # TLR76289, handgun behind Mr. Bennett's right knee inside his pants. Officer Rowlands observed a round inside the chamber of said gun and a single round in the magazine.

Mr. Bennett was transported to CPD HQ 5th floor and ID Bureau. He was read his Constitutional Rights and decided to make a statement. During the interview Mr. Bennett stated he was at Beechcroft High school where he encountered an unknown individual he believed was reaching for an unknown object. He stated he fired three (3) gunshots in this individual's direction from the recovered firearm which subsequently struck the exterior of the school. He was slated a the Franklin County Court of Domestic Relations.

Summary Statement of Facts in Support of Probable Cause:
On January 5, 2022, at approximately 3:19pm, Officer Rowlands spotted a black Honda CRV driving wrecklessly on Dresden St near Belcher Dr. Officer Rwlands suspected this was the same vehicle that had been stolen at gunpoint at 7:30am and seen at a shots fired call at Beechcroft High School. Officers located the CRV parked unoccupied at 1723 Shanley Dr. A search for the occupants began and several other officers flooded the area.
Noah Bennett was detained during this search and placed in the backseat of CPD cruiser 7113 with Officer Rowlands.
At approximately 6:36pm, Officer Rowlands was going to transport Bennet to CPD HQ to be questioned about the robbery and shots fired call. Officer Rowland asked Bennett if he had anything on him he should know about. Bennett eventually advised Officer Rowlands that he was in possession of a loaded forearm. Officer Rowlands recovered and secured the weapon without incident.
Later, during an interview with Detective Mike Longworth and Detective Adam Federer, Bennett admitted to be in possession of the weapon and admitted he was the one that fired shots from said weapon that struck Beechcroft High School.
