Facts:

- On May 4, 2011 you placed a plastic wrap note on victim's vehicle that stated


Hi [REDACTED]

I promise you a new GPS or dinner.  
PS I am working midnights you can call anytime

- During interview process with Sergeant Meier you advised that you were looking to get a job for a friend but if you got a date it wouldn't be a bad thing.

Remedy:

- On May 18, 2011, a counseling session was held between yourself and the administrative staff.
- It was expressed to you that this action is inappropriate and will not be tolerated.
- In accordance with the CBA section 12.1(1) you will lose 3 scheduled shifts and this written reprimand will stay in your file until November 19, 2011.

## VOLUNTARY STATEMENT

Date May 12, 2011,

I, [REDACTED] 29 years of age, my date of birth being the 28th<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1981. My present address is: [REDACTED]

On April 21, 2011, Officer Rodriguez knocked on the door of the home I reside in at approx. 6:45 a.m. He told me some damage had been done to the fence in the backyard. He then asked if he could come in because he was freezing. I was alone in the house at the time and let him in even though I was uncomfortable doing so. We looked through a window at the damage to the fence and then Officer Rodriguez asked if we could sit down. We sat down and he took my name, dob, and phone number. He asked where I was originally from, where I worked and if I was single. I walked him out the door and was surprised/creeped out that he asked about my marital status!

On May 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> I went to get in my car to leave for work and found a note wrapped in saran wrap on the windshield of my car. The note was from Officer Rodriguez and was completely inappropriate. I called Sgt. Eric Meier and he came to my home and picked up the note. Eric called me 45 minutes later to tell me Officer Rodriguez would not have any further contact with me.
