Synopsis: On October 11th, 2003 at approximately 1735 hours, Officers Houck and Palacio conducted an investigation on a stolen vehicle in the parking lot of the Am/Pm, located at 6300 Slauson Ave. As the officers detained the suspect at gunpoint, later identified as [REDACTED] he placed the vehicle in reverse and backed up at a high rate of speed. As [REDACTED] backed the vehicle, the right rear portion of the vehicle struck Officer Palacio, causing her to fall back. The vehicle then continued backing until it collided with the front of the marked black and white police car. [REDACTED] then put the vehicle into drive and attempted to pull forward, directly towards where Officer Palacio had repositioned herself. Several shots were fired by the officers and [REDACTED] was struck five times. [REDACTED] later succumbed to his injuries. An Autopsy was later conducted by [REDACTED] of the Los Angeles County Coroner Office. [REDACTED] ruled that the cause of death was due to multiple gun shot wounds.

The following is a summarized report of my interviews with the witnesses. All interviews were recorded and will be transcribed at a later date.

On October 11th, 2003 at 1815 hours, Detective Sergeant G. Smith and I (Det. Vickrey) received a call from Lieutenant C. Reynosa. Lt. Reynosa advised us of an Officer Involved Shooting that just occurred in the parking lot of Am/Pm, located at 6300 Slauson Avenue. Lt. Reynosa advised that a suspect, later identified as [REDACTED] was transported by CCFD to U.C.L.A. Hospital. Upon arrival, [REDACTED] was pronounced dead at 1808 hours by [REDACTED] Lt. Reynosa advised me that the OIS resulted from an investigation on a reported stolen [REDACTED] California license plate number [REDACTED]

Sgt. C. Maddox advised me that a possible second suspect, identified as [REDACTED] was being transported to CCPD for further investigation to his involvement with the stolen vehicle. At the scene, Sgt. Maddox asked [REDACTED] if he was a passenger in the [REDACTED] and he stated that he was. Sgt. Maddox advised [REDACTED] that he was not under arrest and that he was only being detained to further investigate his involvement in the stolen vehicle. Sgt. Maddox directed Officer Krueger to transport [REDACTED] to CCPD where I could speak with him.

I contacted the reporting party of the stolen vehicle, [REDACTED]. The vehicle was reported stolen to Inglewood PD on [REDACTED] (For further see attached CHP 180 Stolen Vehicle Report, Inglewood PD. [REDACTED]). I called [REDACTED] and spoke with [REDACTED] told me that the vehicle was rented on [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] stated that the vehicle was supposed to be returned on [REDACTED] however, it was not returned.

At 1925 Sgt. Smith and I met with [REDACTED] in the report writing interview room. I retrieved a California Driver's License photograph of [REDACTED] and showed it to [REDACTED] identified [REDACTED] as the driver of the [REDACTED] I also conducted a warrant and criminal history check on [REDACTED] and discovered that he had a No Bail warrant for H&S 11377 and an additional warrant for thirty thousand dollars for H&S 11377. [REDACTED] also had an extensive arrest history for offenses ranging from narcotics to thefts. I advised [REDACTED] of his Miranda rights and he agreed to talk with me. I then asked [REDACTED] to tell me what transpired in the Am/Pm parking lot this evening. [REDACTED] told me that he had just met up with [REDACTED] in the Fox Hills Mall parking lot and [REDACTED] gave

him a ride to Am/Pm so that he [REDACTED] could go to the rest room. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] parked his vehicle on the North side of the business in the first parking stall. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] pulled all the way forward and was legally parked. [REDACTED] said that while he was going to go into the rest room, [REDACTED] was going to retrieve a magazine from his trunk.

[REDACTED] then entered the rest room. While [REDACTED] was in the rest room, he heard what appeared to [REDACTED] as some one pounding on the door. When [REDACTED] opened the door, he saw that [REDACTED] vehicle was now moved across two parking spaces. [REDACTED] then saw police officers with their guns out. [REDACTED] said that he immediately put his hands in the air and followed the officers orders in walking to them. [REDACTED] then said that he noticed that there was fresh collision damage to the right rear bumper, which was not there prior to going into the rest room.

Sgt. G. Smith asked [REDACTED] if he had ever seen [REDACTED] in the vehicle before. [REDACTED] said that he has seen him several times before in the vehicle. I asked [REDACTED] if he knew the vehicle was stolen and he said that he did not know that the vehicle was stolen. Based on the fact that [REDACTED] had no knowledge of the vehicle being stolen he was released. Prior to [REDACTED] release, I asked him if we could take his photograph and fingerprint him just so that we could verify his true identity. He voluntarily submitted to the fingerprints and photograph.

At 2055 hours, Sgt. G. Smith and I went to the scene. Am/Pm located at 6300 Slauson Ave., is on the South/West corner of Sepulveda and Slauson Blvd. The front doors of the business face East onto Sepulveda Blvd., and there are approximately three spaces on the North side of the business. There are two gas islands directly in front of the business. There is one entry/exit driveway onto Slauson Blvd., and there are two entry/exits that lead to Sepulveda Blvd. There is an air machine located on the property between the last parking space on the North, and the South sidewalk of Slauson Blvd.

Upon arrival I saw that the [REDACTED] was positioned across two spaces as [REDACTED] indicated. I saw [REDACTED] that there was in fact a dent in the right rear bumper of the [REDACTED] and fresh t/c damage to the right rear passenger's door. I also saw two bullet holes in the passenger's door and one in the windshield on the passenger's side. The bullet hole in the windshield was obvious to me that the officer firing that round was directly in the path of the vehicle. The driver's door, rear driver's side door and passenger's door windows were shattered. I saw that police unit #1732 was parked to the rear of the [REDACTED] facing in a Westerly direction. There was paint transfer on the front left bumper of unit 1732 and also to the unit's left push bumper. The bumper was also bowed out on the left front, indicating to me that the vehicle was struck from the front. I looked at the [REDACTED] and saw that there was also black paint transfer to the rear of the [REDACTED]. The Intrepid collided with a [REDACTED]. The Jetta was parked on the North side of the business in the last parking stall. For further, refer to crime scene photographs.

Sgt. Smith and I received information about two witnesses, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] live at [REDACTED]. Sgt. G. Smith and I then went to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] residence to interview them. I first spoke with [REDACTED] and he told me the following: [REDACTED] and his girlfriend, [REDACTED] were putting air in her [REDACTED] passenger's side tire. As he was helping his girlfriend, he saw the officers approach with their gun's out. [REDACTED] first thought that the officers were approaching them and then saw the female officer motion for them to move away. [REDACTED] then told his girlfriend to get up and get out of the area. [REDACTED] then went to the corner of Am/Pm and he heard the male officer repeatedly telling the person in the [REDACTED] to get his hands up. [REDACTED] said that the male officer continued telling the suspect to keep his hands up for approximately one minute. [REDACTED] only saw the suspect put his right [REDACTED] and in the air.

As [REDACTED] and his girlfriend were walking back, he heard a noise and saw the [REDACTED] reverse lights were on and speeding in reverse towards them and towards the officers. [REDACTED] saw the [REDACTED] crash into the patrol car. He saw the vehicle make contact with the female [REDACTED]

officer and she stumbled back. [REDACTED] then saw the vehicle move forward and then heard shots being fired. I asked [REDACTED] how long it took for the paramedics to arrive after he heard the shots being fired. He said that it was relatively quick and estimated five or seven minutes. [REDACTED] stated that the response time for the paramedics was quick. It was [REDACTED] opinion that the suspect was either trying to run the officers over, and/or escape.

[REDACTED] then spoke with [REDACTED] and told us the following: [REDACTED] stated that she was putting air into her tire when her boyfriend [REDACTED] told her to get out of there. [REDACTED] looked up and saw the officers pointing their guns at the [REDACTED] next to them. [REDACTED] heard the male officer yelling commands at the driver of the [REDACTED] however, she did not hear what he was saying. [REDACTED] could see that the driver only had his right hand up and she could not see the suspect's other hand. [REDACTED] and her boyfriend started to move from the area and saw the [REDACTED]'s reverse lights come on and back into the female officer. [REDACTED] said that the female officer was standing to the rear passenger's side of the [REDACTED] and she had to brace herself against the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that the [REDACTED] started reversing slowly and then accelerated at a high rate of speed. [REDACTED] said that the male officer was up towards the driver's side door of the [REDACTED]. The female officer was pushed back by the vehicle and the [REDACTED] then struck the police unit. She then heard shots being fired and saw the driver's side rear passenger window shatter. [REDACTED] said that the suspect was trying to get out of the parking lot, but there was no way he could get out of there due to the positioning of the three vehicle involved. It was [REDACTED] opinion that the suspect would have done anything to get away from the police officers. [REDACTED] and her boyfriend then went to a further place of safety. I asked [REDACTED] how long it took for the paramedics to arrive after the shots were fired and she estimated five to ten minutes.

The surveillance tape from Am/Pm and the Fox Hills mall were retrieved and booked into evidence. Photographs of Officer's Palacio's injuries were also taken and booked into evidence. I later viewed the tape and found that it did not capture the incident. There are no cameras located on the North side of the business.

I contacted LA County Coroner's Office and advised them of the incident. Investigator [REDACTED] assigned Coroner's case [REDACTED] to this incident. The scene was processed by [REDACTED]. For further, refer to her report for evidence recovered and photographs. The vehicle was towed to CCPD.

On October 13th, 2003, at 1000 hours, Lieutenants Tankenson, Iizuka, Sergeant Azran and I monitored the Autopsy performed by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] removed four .45 caliber projectiles from various locations on [REDACTED] body. [REDACTED] determined that the cause of death was the result of multiple gun shot wounds. [REDACTED] kept the projectiles at this time and advised me that they will turn them over to CCPD at a later date.

I recovered the bullet fragments from the vehicle and booked them into the Culver City Police Property Room (See Evidence Report).

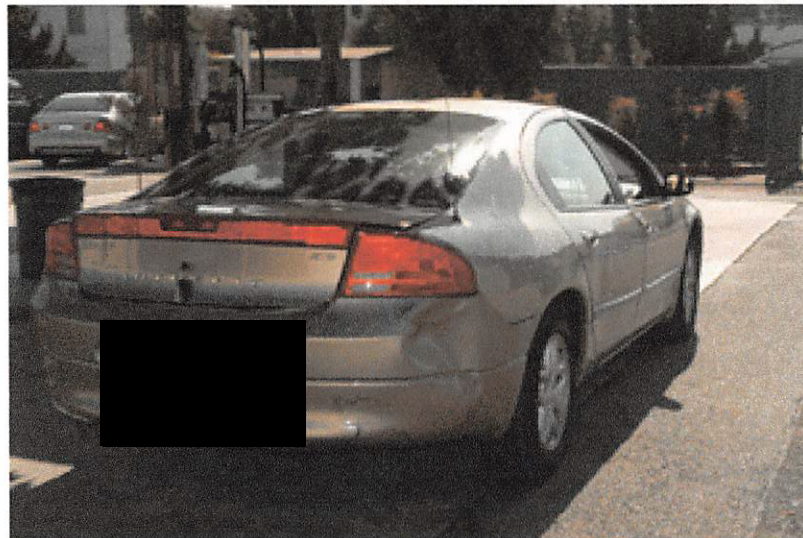

Bullet hole #13 - One bullet hole into the right front door. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right to the left.

Bullet hole #14 - One bullet hole into the right front door. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right to the left.

Bullet hole #15 - One bullet hole into the right front door. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right rear toward the left front.

Bullet Hole #19 - One bullet hole through the left front door. The trajectory of this bullet is from left front toward the right rear and slightly downward.

Bullet holes #20 and 21 - Two bullet holes through the driver's headrest. The trajectories of these bullets is from the left rear toward the right front.

Bullet Hole #26 - One bullet hole to the right side of the windshield. This bullet impacted the dashboard and was not located. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right front toward the left rear and slightly downward.

Bullet hole #24 - One bullet hole to the center console. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right front toward the left rear.

Bullet Hole #26 - One bullet hole to the right side of the windshield. This bullet impacted the dashboard and was not located. The trajectory of this bullet is from the right front toward the left rear and slightly downward.

Bullet hole #29 - One bullet hole to the center console. The trajectory of this bullet is from the left front toward the right rear.

The expended bullet fragments recovered from the right front door panel, right front seat cushion, right front floorboard, left rear floorboard and the left front seat cushion were all retained by Culver City P.D. personnel.

Officer Involved Shooting:

At approximately 1730 hours, Officers Kyle Houck and Eden Palacio were on routine patrol, in the area of Sepulveda Blvd and Slauson Ave, when they observed a [REDACTED] parked in the AM-PM Mini Market parking lot.

A DMV check revealed that the [REDACTED] was stolen.

At that point, the officers pulled into the parking lot, and approached the vehicle, from the rear. As they made their approach, Officer Houck observed a male subject sitting in the driver's seat.

The subject, who was later identified as [REDACTED] was ordered to raise his hands. [REDACTED] initially complied, but then lowered his hands. He was then ordered to raise his hands a second time. At that point, [REDACTED] began raising his hands, and then without warning, lowered them, started the [REDACTED] placed it in reverse and began backing toward the officers, causing them to retreat. As Officer Palacio attempted to move to cover, she was struck on the leg by [REDACTED] vehicle. [REDACTED] continued backing subsequently striking the officer's unit.

At this point, Officer Palacio moved toward the front of [REDACTED] vehicle, with Officer Houck standing toward the driver's side rear.

[REDACTED] then began to pull forward toward Officer Palacio. At this time, both officers fired their duty weapons at [REDACTED] stopping his forward progress. The officers ceased fire and requested paramedics. [REDACTED] was treated at the scene and transported to the UCLA medical center by CCFD.

Witnesses were identified and interviewed, and the scene was secured and preserved for Forensics.

Further Info:

Crime Scene and Incident logs were completed, and Lt. Reynosa made all notifications.

Officer Palacio sustained a contusion to her leg (left) as a result of being struck by [REDACTED] vehicle. She was transported to the L.A. Airport Urgent Care facility for treatment, and photos of her injuries were taken and booked into evidence.
