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

On 10/21/2003, at approximately 2238 hrs, CCPD Communications Center received a 911 call from inside apt Witnesses were hiding in a rear bedroom in fear of being harmed by suspect The caller stated that wearing a white nightgown was throwing things inside the residence. 1A71 Officers Jeffery Davila/Leon Lopez, were dispatched the call at 2243 hrs, and arrived on scene at 2249 hrs.											
As the officers entered apartment they encountered the suspect exited their hiding place in the front room area. As the officers entered witnesses and exited their hiding place in the rear bedroom and met the officers in the front room. Suspect armed herself with a kitchen knife from inside the residence and began yelling at the officers that they had no right to be inside her home and that she could not be arrested. The officers ordered the suspect to drop the knife and she continued to wave the knife back and forth in front of her, within six feet of the officers.

On 10-21-03 at about 2255 hours, I (Officer Garacochea) received a radio call to assist Officer Davila and Officer Lopez at Upon my arrival, I met with (Grandmother) and (Sister) who were standing in front of the residence at the bottom of the stairs. I asked if they were inside of the residence when the officers arrived and they said that they were. I then separated them and asked them what had occurred. if she would speak to me and she agreed. I asked her what she saw I asked and she told me the following: She was inside the residence along with was very depressed after the loss of her mother and had been prescribed anti-depressants to help her deal with the loss. During the course of the evening. became angry and was becoming destructive inside of the residence. She was throwing said that she was going to kill her things and was verbally abusive towards them. and became scared and was in fear of being harmed and called CCPD. were still in the residence when the police arrived. As the police entered the residence confronted them. picked up a kitchen knife and held it in her right hand. She began to yell at the police telling them that they did not have a right to be inside of the home and that she could not be arrested. As yelling, she was waving the knife in front of her. The knife was at her waist level and she was waving it from side to side. was within six feet of the officers and her. The and her stand behind them next to the front door and began to tell refused and continued to yell at the officers.
