On 10/21/2003, at approximately 2238 hrs, CCPD Communications Center received a 911 call from inside apt [REDACTED]. Witnesses [REDACTED] were hiding in a rear bedroom in fear of being harmed by suspect [REDACTED]. The caller stated that [REDACTED] wearing a white nightgown was throwing things inside the residence. 1A71 Officers Jeffery Davila/Leon Lopez, were dispatched the call at 2243 hrs, and arrived on scene at 2249 hrs.

As the officers entered apartment [REDACTED] they encountered the suspect [REDACTED] in the front room area. As the officers entered witnesses [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] exited their hiding place in the rear bedroom and met the officers in the front room. Suspect [REDACTED] armed herself with a kitchen knife from inside the residence and began yelling at the officers that they had no right to be inside her home and that she could not be arrested. The officers ordered the suspect to drop the knife and she continued to wave the knife back and forth in front of her, within six feet of the officers.

The officers had the witnesses stand behind them next to the front door and they continued to order the suspect to drop the knife. The suspect refused to drop the knife and continued to yell at the officers. The officers told the witnesses to exit the apartment and the officers continued to order the suspect to drop the knife. The suspect started to advance on Officer Davila inside the apartment, and he began backing away. When Officer Davila could not back away any further and the women kept coming at him with the knife. Officer Davila fired his service pistol and the suspect fell to the ground.

Officers reported shots fired at approximately 2257 hrs, and requested paramedics.

CCFD Paramedics transported the suspect to UCLA Hospital, where she was pronounced dead at 0000 hrs, 10/22/03. (For further see death report same DR#)

I.D. Tech's [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] processed the crime scene. (For further see I.D. Services report same DR#)

Patrol Officers conducted an area check for additional witnesses or victims. (See officers supplemental reports same DR#'s)

Los Angeles County Coroner [REDACTED] was notified and he assigned Coroners Case #2003-07954.

On October 21, 2003 I was directed by Sergeant Shank to conduct a neighborhood check at [REDACTED] I conducted the following interviews, starting with the unit closest to the incident to the unit furthest away:

Unit [REDACTED] no one living at residence per McLinn.

Unit [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said he called security of the complex at around 2230 hours regarding loud music coming from the units behind his unit. [REDACTED] said he heard what he described as "African babbling" in a woman's voice. He heard a male subject yell about 15 times, "Calm down!" He heard a male voice then yell about 15 times, "Put the knife down!" Shortly thereafter, he heard two gunshots.

[REDACTED] said his wife, 10-year-old daughter and four year old son did not hear anything.

Unit [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said she heard one shot and nothing else.

On 21 October 2003 at approximately 2305 hours, [REDACTED] was in her apartment and heard a female yelling, then heard approximately three shots. Nothing related was seen or heard prior to hearing the yelling that immediately preceded the shots. [REDACTED] was asleep in the bedroom and did not hear anything.

On 21 October 2003 at approximately 2230 hours, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in their family room watching television. They heard a female voice yelling at someone. The female subject was saying, "I want you out of my house!" "I want you to leave!" The [REDACTED] said the arguing (with another party-NFD) continued for approximately 10 to 15 minutes. At approximately 2250-2255 hours, the [REDACTED] heard two rapid shots. Nothing related was seen or heard prior to the initial yelling that began at approximately 2230 hours.

On 10-21-03 at about 2255 hours, I (Officer Garacochea) received a radio call to assist Officer Davila and Officer Lopez at [REDACTED]

Upon my arrival, I met with [REDACTED] (Grandmother) and [REDACTED] (Sister) who were standing in front of the residence at the bottom of the stairs. I asked if they were inside of the residence when the officers arrived and they said that they were. I then separated them and asked them what had occurred.

I asked [REDACTED] if she would speak to me and she agreed. I asked her what she saw and she told me the following: She was inside the residence along with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was very depressed after the loss of her mother and had been prescribed anti-depressants to help her deal with the loss. During the course of the evening, [REDACTED] became angry and was becoming destructive inside of the residence. She was throwing things and was verbally abusive towards them. [REDACTED] said that she was going to kill her and [REDACTED] became scared and was in fear of being harmed and called CCPD.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were still in the residence when the police arrived. As the police entered the residence [REDACTED] confronted them. [REDACTED] picked up a kitchen knife and held it in her right hand. She began to yell at the police telling them that they did not have a right to be inside of the home and that she could not be arrested. As [REDACTED] was yelling, she was waving the knife in front of her. The knife was at her waist level and she was waving it from side to side. [REDACTED] was within six feet of the officers and her. The officers had [REDACTED] and her stand behind them next to the front door and began to tell [REDACTED] to drop the knife. [REDACTED] refused and continued to yell at the officers. The officers then had [REDACTED] and her step outside and she continued to hear them tell [REDACTED] to drop the knife. No more than five minutes passed and she heard two gunshots. In fear of her safety, [REDACTED] and her went down stairs and waited for the police.

During my conversation with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (Uncle) arrived at our location. I asked [REDACTED] why he arrived at the location and he told me the following: He was called by [REDACTED] and was told that [REDACTED] was not taking her medication. [REDACTED] was becoming verbally abusive and violent. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he was going to come to the house and take [REDACTED] to Brotman for a 72-hour hold. I asked if she had ever been admitted for a psychiatric evaluation and he told me that a couple of weeks prior he had taken [REDACTED] to UCLA Harbor for a 72-hour hold. [REDACTED] told me that he was not surprised that something like this happened.

I then spoke to [REDACTED] and asked her if she would tell me what happened. [REDACTED] said that she would speak to me and told me the following: [REDACTED] refused to take her medication and became verbally abusive toward her and [REDACTED] was angry and began to throw items inside of the residence. In fear for her safety, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] locked themselves in the bedroom and called CCPD. When the police

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arrived she came out of the bedroom and went into the living room. The police entered the residence and were standing by the front door. She saw [REDACTED] pick up a kitchen knife and begin to wave it from side to side. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was holding the knife at about waist level and was yelling at the police. She could not remember what [REDACTED] was yelling but she did say that the police were telling [REDACTED] to drop the knife. The police then had [REDACTED] and her stand behind them near the front door. The police then told them to exit the house and stand outside.

At this time [REDACTED] became emotionally distraught and could not continue with our conversation. I ended my interview with [REDACTED] and waited with her, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] for detectives to arrive.

Prior to detectives arriving, [REDACTED] became ill and requested paramedics. Upon the arrival of the paramedics, Sgt. West and Lt. Tankenson also arrived. They spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and I followed CCFD Rescue Three to Brotman Hospital as they transported [REDACTED]. I waited with [REDACTED] at Brotman Hospital until Sgt. West and Lt. Tankenson arrived.

OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING:

At about 2238 hours, Officers Davila and Lopez were dispatched to [REDACTED] in response to a disturbance call. At the scene, the officers contacted the subject of the call, [REDACTED] year-old resident, along with her sister and grandmother. While the officers were on scene [REDACTED] became angry and stepped into the kitchen. She returned, armed with a knife and advance on the officers. Officer Davila backed away but [REDACTED] continued to advance toward him. When Officer Davila could not back any further he fired two rounds from his service pistol. [REDACTED] was struck and fell to the floor.

CCFD paramedics responded to the scene and transported [REDACTED] to UCLA Medical Center where she was pronounced dead.

Officer Davila and Lopez were transported to the station.

Bomb Threat/Strike Related

About 1925 hrs, Officer Twiss and Officer Backer responded to the Ralph's Market in Culver Center. A bomb threat had been called in from the pay telephone across the parking lot from a group of about 20 picketers.

The Officers advised the Manager of the store, who elected not to evacuate and to conduct a cursory check of the public areas. The Officers stood by while he and other Ralph's employees checked with no results.

I met with the Strike Captain, Andre Webb. He said his people knew nothing of the threat, and saw no one on the pay phone.

I met with Officer Twiss and Officer Backer after this call. We discussed different ways to handle strike related problems, and also talked about ways to impact repressible crime in the city.

Officer Involved Shooting

I initially responded to the OIS, meeting Sergeant Shank as he arrived on scene. I received the Public Safety Statement, and drove Officer Davila back to the Station.

At the station I conducted a weapons inspection on Officer Davila's service pistol. I completed a report and submitted it to Lt. Ariza. I also completed a Public Safety Supplemental Report.

Complaint Form Mailed

Dalton Meena was stopped by two officers tonight for a defective brake light. Mr. Meena called to complain his driver's license was not returned, and that an officer shoved him from behind during the stop. Mr. Meena thought this was an attempt to provoke him into a fight.

I was unable to appease Mr. Meena and told him that Officer Twiss insisted his license had been returned. Mr. Meena said he was an AJ major, and he knew that our entire department is corrupt, but knew that talking to me would be the first step in his lawsuit. He demanded a complaint form be mailed to him. I did this.

Mr. Meena added that he has a radio talk show, and on Thursday morning from 0800-1000 on Station 87.7 he will be broadcasting about this incident to the public.
