THE CITY WILL REMOVE ALL ITEMS ENCUMBERING OR OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC AREAS DURING A COORDINATED MULTI-AGENCY CLEANUP OF THE AREA GENERALLY ENCOMPASSED BY:

27th STREET TO THE NORTHEAST,

ARAPAHOE STREET TO THE SOUTHEAST,

25TH STREET TO THE SOUTHWEST, and

WALNUT STREET TO THE NORTHWEST.

The cleanup area encompasses all public rights-of-way, including both sides of streets, all four corners of street intersections, sidewalks, tree-lawns, adjoining greenways, and any unpaved road shoulders within the described boundaries.

Any property removed will be temporarily stored at 1449 Galapago Street for 30 days. You may claim any property at this location at no charge, and without fear of arrest, between the hours of 6:00am to 8:30am on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and between 12:00pm and 6:00pm on Thursdays. After 30 days, property will be moved offsite and stored at a different location for an additional 30 days. ALL PROPERTY NOT CLAIMED WITHIN 60 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF REMOVAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF.
