Co-pay policy/charges for UDC offenders

All offenders will be assessed the statutory co-pay for outside healthcare regardless of the cause for the healthcare need. The Department in its sole discretion may waive this co-pay in appropriate circumstances. These charges apply to all offenders regardless of Interstate Compact/Federal status.

In accordance with Utah State Law, charges are as follows:

Doctor, Physician Assistant, Optometrist, and Dental visits: You will be charged a \$5.00 co-pay for each visit. This charge is assessed regardless of whether you are being seen for on-going health care problems and for a new problem. If Medical staff refers you to another USP provider, that next appointment will be scheduled for you and will be free of charge. Dental staff schedules all necessary follow up visits for you and you will be charged for each visit.

Medication Dispensing fee: You will be charged a \$2.00 co-pay dispensing fee per medication each month. ALL MEDICATIONS are assessed the dispensing fee regardless if it's for medical, mental health, dental, etc.

Mental Health Staff including Mental Health Therapist, Psychiatrist, or Psychologist: There is no co-pay to see mental health staff.

Outside Care: You will be charged 10% of the bill for all outside care provided. The maximum co-pay for outside care is \$2,000.00 per fiscal year (July - June). Outside care is anything done by non-UDC staff, which may be done on-site or off-site. This includes all appointments, surgeries, tests, x-rays, oral surgeon, etc., done at University Medical Center, Gunnison Valley, any other outside facility and/or on-site by any non-UDC staff. **Please note: you may receive more than one bill for a single appointment as hospital departments bill us separately (doctor's fees, lab fees, x-ray fees, etc.).
