Just to be clear for the curbside service question: the library is not considered an essential service (restaurants are essential for food because some people don't cook). We may only have personnel working in-person for essential functions like payroll and keeping the building safe and secure. Additionally, holds have been suspended in SWAN because nearly all libraries are not accepting returns and system delivery that moves the books from library to library is also suspended.

So unfortunately we cannot offer curbside service until the stay-at-home order is lifted.
