Hi, Everyone,

We have been monitoring very closely the community transmission level for COVID in our area: https://www.dupagehealth.org/610/DuPage-County-COVID-19-Dashboard. As our level has increased to **high**; once again we will be requiring masks for all patrons and staff throughout the entire building (not just the Kids Room).

Signage has been placed at both entrances, on our website, and throughout the building.

We have decided on a slightly different enforcement tactic this time around: Any patrons who refuse to wear masks in the building will be refused service. Period. This means, no one-on-one help, no assistance with checking out, no escorting patrons to the stacks, etc. If patrons want our assistance, they will need to wear a mask. Masks are required for in-person service. If patrons forget a mask, offer one. Masks are available at all service desks. We are going to try this and see how well it works as policing patrons and the watchdog tactic is simply untenable.
