ERIE COUNTY SHERIFF'S INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES ARRESTED A TOWN OF TONAWANDA MAN TODAY, CHARGING HIM WITH ARSON IN THE SECOND DEGREE, STEMMING FROM A FIRE AT THE ERIE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AT 478 MAIN STREET, BUFFALO.

SENIOR INVESTIGATOR VINCENT PUPO, JR., OF THE SHERIFF'S FIRE INVESTIGATIVE UNIT STATES THAT JOSEPH J. MILOSICH, AGE 42, WAS ARRESTED AT THE RATH BUILDING AND TAKEN TO THE ERIE COUNTY HOLDING CENTER. MILOSICH, WHO IS ALSO A COUNTY EMPLOYEE, WILL BE HELD WITHOUT BAIL AND WILL BE ARRAIGNED IN BUFFALO CITY COURT ON DECEMBER 28, 1990. DEPUTY WILLIAM JULICHER ASSISTED IN THE ARREST.

THE FIRE WAS INTENTIONALLY SET AT APPROXIMATELY 11:30 A.M., DECEMBER 27, 1990, AND CAUSED DEPUTIES TO EVACUATE OVER 500 CITIZENS AND EMPLOYEES FROM THE BUILDING. THE CITY OF BUFFALO FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS SUMMONED TO THE SCENE. DAMAGE IS CONSIDERED TO BE MINOR AND THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF INJURY.

Tonawanda, NY discovered the fire moments after it was started. [REDACTED] is a caseworker. She tried to put it out with a cardboard poster to no avail. She called out for help at which time David Cook came out of his office (Room 403) and put out the fire.

Patrol arrived to find the fire out and the hallway full of smoke. Patrol assisted employees to evacuate the fourth floor. After observing the employees leave the floor, I conducted an office to office search to check on any employees unable to exit. I found Joseph Milosich and an unidentified female employee in room 409 and ordered them to leave.

Patrol assisted Buffalo Fire Department with checking to make sure the was completely out. The hallway immediately in the vicinity of the fire was sealed off. Patrol and Sgt. Ryan secured the scene until Sr. Investigator Vincent Pupo arrived at 12:40 pm.

Sr. Caseworker Samuel Insalaco, Child Protection Services, came forward and stated he saw Joseph Milosich light one of the papers. Mr Insalaco thought he had put out the fire by patting it with his hand. Apparently the fire re-kindled. *Col. P. N.*

This writer was dispatched from patrol headquarters to a fire at the Department of Social Services located at 478 Main Street Buffalo there is also an address of 291 Pearl Street both being for the same building. Sgt. Ryan and Deputy Leone met with this writer and provided a preliminary briefing as to conditions, evacuation and procedures followed.

The area of fire origin will be listed as the fourth floor hallway, with the point of fire origin listed as a bulletin board secured to the south wall in that hallway.

Pictures of the scene were taken by this writer. There were no signs of any flammable accelerate present, O-Factory testing also proved negative concerning this point.

Fire damage was confined to the bulletin board and the various papers attached thereto, the wall above the bulletin board and the ceiling tiles. It is this writers opinion that the damaged caused approximately 5-600 dollars.

Interviews were sarterd with the various people in that area. Ms. [REDACTED] a caseworker discovered the fire an attempted to extinguish same without being able to do so. She called for help and another employee Mr. David Cook came to her aid with a fire extinguisher and was able to extinguish the fire. However there was large volumg of smoke in the hallways and the smoke detectors activated and some 500 citizens and employees had to be evacuated from the building. City of Buffalo Fire Department also responded and checked for fire extension, they then rendered the building safe to reenter.

[REDACTED] another employee came forward and stated that she had observed two other county employees at the board, Samuel Insalaco and Joseph Milosich.

Sgt. Ryan had his Deputies go to the locations were these two county employees worked in the building and instructed them to bring them back for questioning.

Samuel Insalaco was interviewed by this writer and asked what he knew about the fire. He stated that Joseph Milossich came up along side him while he was reading one of the bulletin board and ignited a cigarette lighter and placed it under the various papers on the one bulletin board and left. He continued that a fire did start but he (Insalaco) used his hand to extinguish it. thinking that the fire was out he went back to his job. A short time later the fire alarm sounded, he though that it might be connected with the fire he had extinguished but was not sure. Mr. Insalaco provided a signed statement.

It was learned that Joseph Milossich had signed out for the day. Deputy Leone varified that while he was helping to evacuate the floor that he personally observed Joseph Milosich on that floor, a supporting deposition concerning this point is part of this filer

All necessary paerwork was completed and this writer proceeded to Buffalo warrant bureau requesting a felony warrant of arson in the second degree against Joseph Milosich. Judge Sadita was not available at that time and i was advised that when he returned that the request would be placed before him.

Later during the shift Sgt. Ryan contacted this writer to advise me that Joseph Milosich was in the ~~Rahh~~ Building under surveillance by Deputies. This writer contacted the Buffalo Warrant Clerks office and asked if the Warrant had been signed by Judge Sadita.
