On or about November 1, 1982, the respondent found the petitioner guilty of unbecoming conduct and imposed a penalty of a letter of reprimand to be placed in petitioner's personnel file and, despite the recommendations of the Hearing Officer, additionally suspended petitioner's pay for a period of thirty (30) days. A copy of the Resolution of the Village Board of Trustees and the said letter of reprimand marked Exhibits "D" and "E" are annexed hereto and made a part hereof.
9. The action of the respondent in adopting the said resolution was arbitrary and capricious; and the respondent abused its discretion in the measure of penalty or discipline imposed.
10. The determination, on the entire record, is not supported by substantial evidence.
11. By reason of the foregoing petitioner's reprimand and suspension of pay were illegal and contrary to law.
12. That no previous application has been made for the relief herein sought.
