I reviewed an internal investigation conducted by Lt. Erick Heieck regarding a Burglary at After a review of your statement, witness testimony and video our findings are as follows:

- 1. You conducted personal business for a period of time within the building
- 2. You failed to notify dispatch of your location
- 3. Failed to be attentive to your duties
- 4. Failed to carry out the functions and objectives of the department

It is clear from the investigation that you entered the building for the purpose of checking the building as part of your patrol duties. However, you spent approximately one hour and twenty eight minutes in the building engaging, in part, in personal business by utilizing your IPhone to watch Netflix. During this period you failed to notify dispatch of your location and were not carrying out your assigned detail as expected. Unbeknownst to you a Burglary had occurred in the building a couple days prior to you entering. A video review was conducted by personnel who contacted my office after seeing you in the building for a lengthy period of time. Due to your actions and neglect of duty it put yourself and the department under suspicion by the public. This prevents the department from carrying out our responsibilities to the community taxpayers.

Disciplinary action was based on and in accordance with contract language Article 19.

Conclusion of disciplinary action: Two (2) full days without pay and continued or future behavior of this type will however, if necessary, result in termination. Please respond by July 26th, 2013 no later than noon to the office of the Chief of Police regarding your decision consistent with contract language Article 19.2.

On at or about 9:59 AM, you attempted to catch up to a vehicle with a Suspended Registration. While doing so you were involved in a Property Damage MVA with marked patrol unit GV12 involving a parked vehicle. You were driving in an Emergency Response Mode without your Emergency Lights activated as well as driving over the posted speed limit. This type of MVA WAS preventable on your part. You did not show due care to yourself, others, nor City property.

You must understand that this counseling memo is being completed so that you may take immediate corrective measures so it does not happen again. You must take precautions as stated in GO 410, EMERGENCY RESPONSE DRIVING, SECTION IV, so that this type of situation does not occur again.

As you may or may not be aware, further violation of this General Order may result in disciplinary action taken against you.
