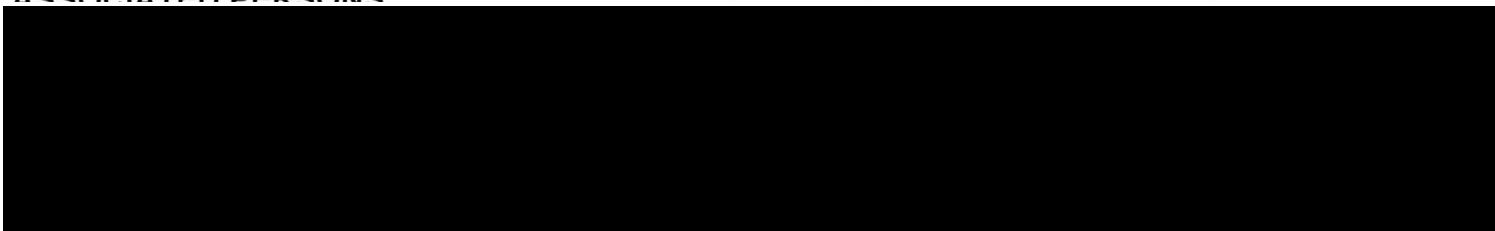

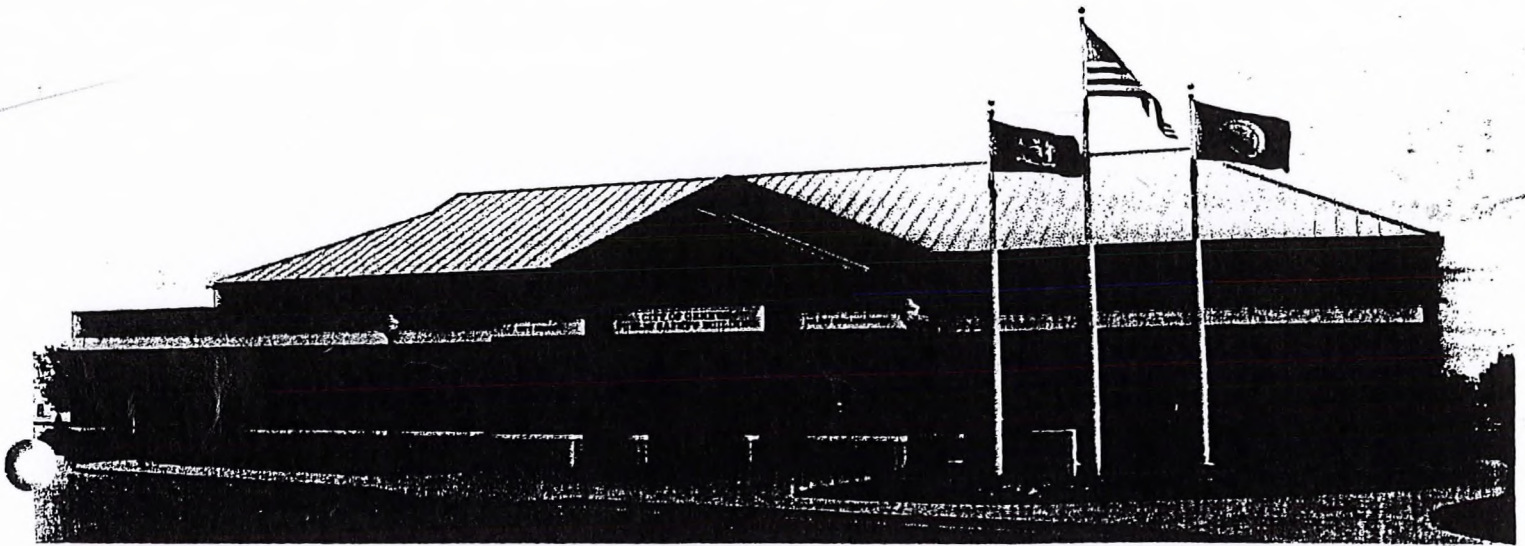

Summary of Complaint Process

- The complaint can be downloaded from the City of Geneva website: www.geneva.ny.us or picked up at Geneva Police Department, 255 Exchange Street, Geneva, New York.
- After completion of the form it should be notarized by a Notary of your choice or signed in front of Sergeant or Lieutenant of the Geneva Police Department.
- After your complaint has been filed, it is assigned and investigated and given a Case Number. All available witnesses will be contacted, and any physical or other relevant evidence including records, reports, recordings and computer data will be collected and reviewed. You will be personally contacted by a Lieutenant or another person designated by the Chief of Police.
- Once the investigation is completed, the investigation and its report will be forwarded to the Chief of Police for final disposition of the case. When a complaint is sustained, the Chief shall determine and administer appropriate corrective and/or disciplinary action.
- Department policy requires that the complaint investigation to be completed within 45-60 days; however, the Chief of Police can waive the time frame depending on the complexity and sensitivity of the investigation.
- After the investigation has been completed and the Chief of Police has made a final decision on the case, you will be notified of the results by mail.

Most Often Asked Questions

- **HOW DO I FILE A COMPLAINT?** We would prefer to talk with you about your complaint in person; however complaints will be accepted by mail or in person. If they are submitted by mail, please ensure they have been notarized.
- **WHAT IS A COMPLAINT?** A complaint is a belief that a member of the Geneva Police Department has violated a Department Rule or Procedure, a federal or state law, an ordinance of the City of Geneva, or dissatisfaction with a policy or procedure of the Geneva Police Department.
- **WHAT DOES THIS PROCESS NOT HANDLE?** This process does not litigate or decide the outcome of any parking, traffic, criminal or non-criminal offense. These questions should be directed to the court of jurisdiction or your own legal counsel.
- **WHO CAN MAKE A COMPLAINT?** Anyone can file a complaint if they truly and honestly believe a police employee has acted improperly.
- **WHO INVESTIGATES A CITIZEN COMPLAINT?** Complaints of alleged misconduct are investigated by the Internal Affairs Lieutenant and his staff as needed. The investigation is then reviewed by the Chief of Police and Personnel Office if needed.
- **WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO THE EMPLOYEE?** That will depend on the results of the investigation. If the employee is found to be at fault the complaint will be SUSTAINED and the appropriate corrective

and/or disciplinary action will be taken. If they acted properly, they will be EXONERATED. If the facts show that the complaint is false, the complaint will be unfounded. In those cases where the department is unable to determine the validity of the complaint and cannot arrive at any other conclusion, the complaint will be NOT SUSTAINED. If the investigation concludes that the involved employee's conduct was not misconduct but rather an issue of department service or procedure, your complaint will be satisfied as such. In cases of department service or procedure, Geneva Police Department will attempt to clarify or correct the issue.

- **WHAT IF MY COMPLAINT INVOLVES CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR?** The Ontario County District Attorney's Office may be consulted on any complaint that alleges criminal investigation while the internal investigation is pending.
- **WILL I BE TOLD THE RESULTS OF THE INVESTIGATION?** YES – At the conclusion of the investigation and review by the Chief of Police, you will be notified of the results by mail. Due to contractual and legal restrictions, you will be only be given the finding of the investigation of whether your complaint was SUSTAINED, UNFOUNDED, EXONERATED, NOT SUSTAINED, OR IS ONE OF DEPARTMENT SERVICE OR PROCEDURE. The department is prohibited from revealing specific personnel actions taken against the employee.
- **CAN I GET IN TROUBLE FOR MAKING A COMPLAINT?** NO – Every citizen has the right to file a complaint, if it is done in good faith, with an honest belief that an employee of the acted improperly. If a false statement is made you may be charged under the NYS Penal Law Section 210.45.
- **ABOUT THE COMPLAINT FORM.** The attached form should be used to file your complaint. You can attach as many additional pages as necessary, along with any supporting evidence you may have. After you complete the form have it notarized or sworn to by a Sergeant or Lieutenant of the Geneva Police Department. After it being notarized you may also mail it to the following address:

On [REDACTED] at approximately 1:15 pm my wife was driving her [REDACTED] Officer Vansavage, badge 818, pulled over and stated he pulled her over because her windows were too tinted. He then asked for everyone's I.D., license and registration. My wife complied and Officer Vansavage checked everything. He then came back and told me I was getting arrested for driving. When I said my wife is the one driving and the one you pulled over he replied "I saw you driving earlier." He then arrested me and went back to the car. ~~He then opened the car door and yanked her~~ He then opened the car door and yanked her [REDACTED] out of the car and replied to her, "I don't give a fuck about your [REDACTED] hair." He then proceeded to arrest her [REDACTED]

and put her in the police car. At no point in time were my and my sister's rights read to us. He then went to my wife's car asked her to step out and threatened to arrest her for letting me drive earlier. Without my wife's permission and without a warrant he began to search her car. He said a sergeant was to come and test the tinted windows but never tested them.

On 9.27.2017 I was given a signed Geneva Police Department Complaint Form from Chief Trickler. The complaint was submitted and signed by [REDACTED] alleging that Officer John VanSavage

Identification & Explanation of Allegations and Recommended Findings

Officer John VanSavage made a traffic stop on a vehicle being operated by [REDACTED] Passengers in the vehicle were [REDACTED] had a Bench Warrant for Violation of Probation. [REDACTED] was also arrested on scene for AUO 3rd. Officer John VanSavage states he observed [REDACTED] operating the vehicle earlier in the day. [REDACTED] was also issued a UTT for the tint on her vehicle.

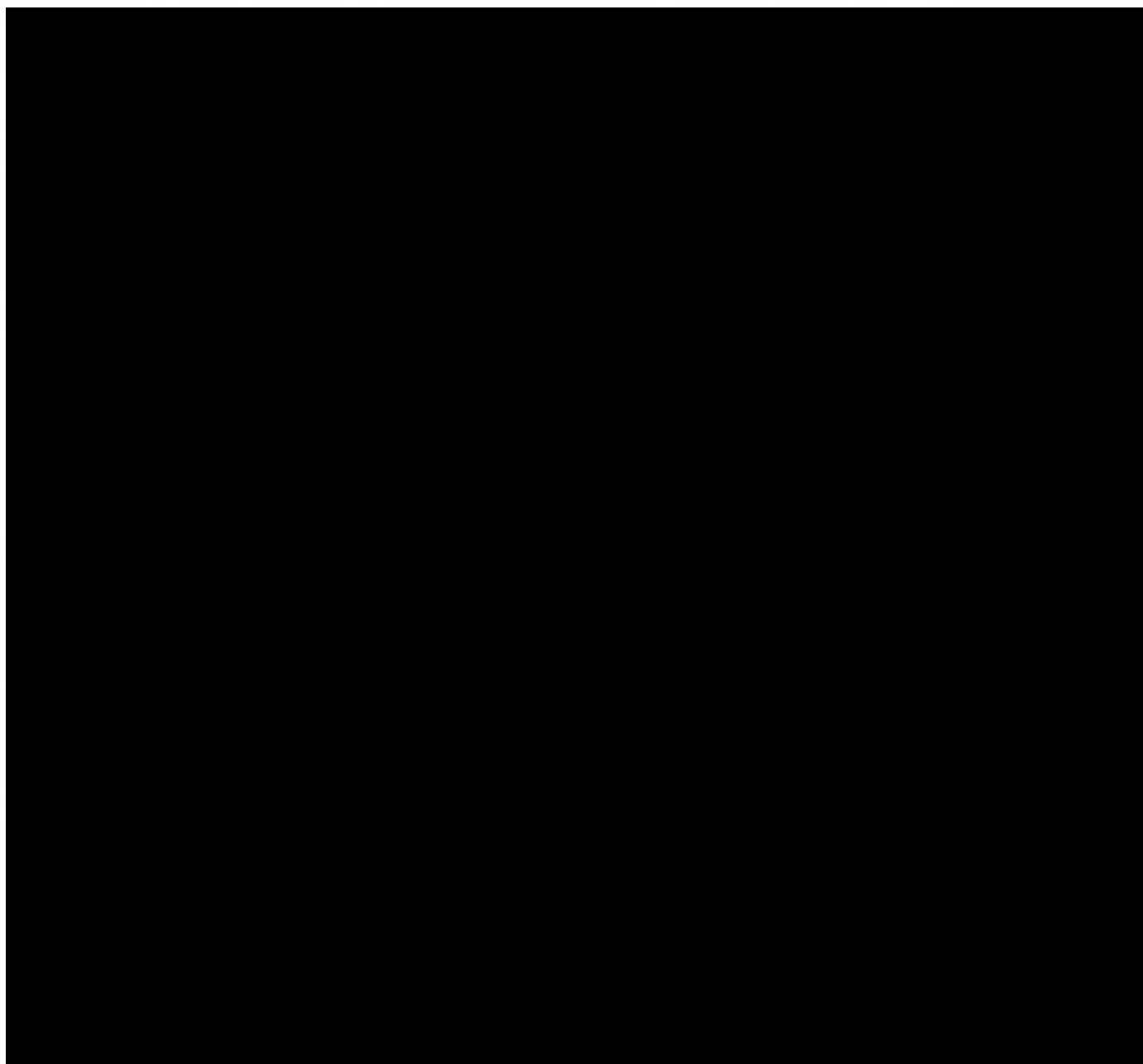
G.O. 305 Section III sub 25 of the General Orders of the Geneva Police Department which states:

██████████ stated that she felt she was forcibly pulled from the vehicle when she was trying to put her hair up and "give up". ██████████ stated that she wasn't injured at all but just felt Officer VanSavage was too aggressive. ██████████ stated that she does not remember if Officer VanSavage cursed at her but she doesn't think he did or she would have remembered it. ██████████

██████████ stated that if she wasn't in jail she would have filed a complaint on Officer VanSavage for how he forcibly removed her from the vehicle.

Lt. Valenti,

In receipt of the letter you have issued to me on 10/16/2017, I am respectfully submitting this letter of explanation. I would like to make mention that [REDACTED] is making accusations on behalf of [REDACTED] which has a pending criminal case in Ontario County. I do understand the General Orders under GO 300 section VI (6), that the complainant need not be the person who was actually involved in the incident. I would offer that since the arrest of [REDACTED] is still pending in court, that all information regarding [REDACTED] be kept from [REDACTED] to insure that the Geneva Police Department does not violate the right to privacy of [REDACTED]. In regards to the arrest of both [REDACTED] Officer Jeffrey Potter was on scene and witness to the entire arrest. The following questions will be restated from your letter and answered accordingly:

1. How did you remove [REDACTED] from the vehicle? This officer gave [REDACTED] the verbal command that she was under arrest and to exit the vehicle. [REDACTED] began to argue with this officer. This officer grab the right upper arm of [REDACTED] and pulled her out of the car after giving her a second order to exit the vehicle.
2. Did you make the comment to [REDACTED] "I don't give a Fuck about your hair"? During [REDACTED] arguing with this officer she stated that she needed to put her hair up and began to reach under her body. Not knowing what [REDACTED] was looking to retrieve under her body this officer grabbed the upper right arm of [REDACTED] and said, "I don't care about your hair". I am denying using any curse words during this incident.

6. Did you threaten to arrest [REDACTED] for allowing [REDACTED] to drive? No. I did inform [REDACTED] that to knowingly allowing someone who is suspended to drive her vehicle is a violation and that she could be issued a UTT. However, this officer used discretion and did not issue this UTT as [REDACTED] admitted that [REDACTED] was driving her vehicle.

3. A person is guilty of facilitating aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle in the second degree when such person:

(a) commits the offense of facilitating aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle in the third degree as defined in subdivision one of this section after having been convicted of such offense within the preceding eighteen months; or

(b) Consents to the operation upon a public highway of a motor vehicle registered in such person's name knowing or having reason to know that the operator of such vehicle is a person who has in effect three or more suspensions, imposed on at least three separate dates, for failure to answer, appear or pay a fine, pursuant to subdivision three of section Two hundred twenty-six or subdivision four-a of section five hundred ten of this chapter.


Facilitating aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle in the Second degree is a misdemeanor.

I response to your letter dated October 31st, 2017 regarding a Complaint Action Form from [REDACTED] I offer the following answers to the questions you have posed to me:

1. I did respond to [REDACTED] and test the window tint on the vehicle that PO VanSavage had stopped.
2. Before tinting the front driver's side window of the vehicle, I calibrated the tint meter which did calibrate correctly showing 100.0%. To the best of my recollection the result of the window test was 23.6%.
3. When I arrived on scene, PO VanSavage was actively searching the vehicle but I did not assist in anyway with said search.
4. Upon arrival at the scene of the vehicle stop, [REDACTED] were both already in police custody and were in the rear of marked patrol vehicles. [REDACTED] was standing on the passengers side of the vehicle when I arrived with PO Potter. I did not have any conversation or direct interaction with her while I was on scene.

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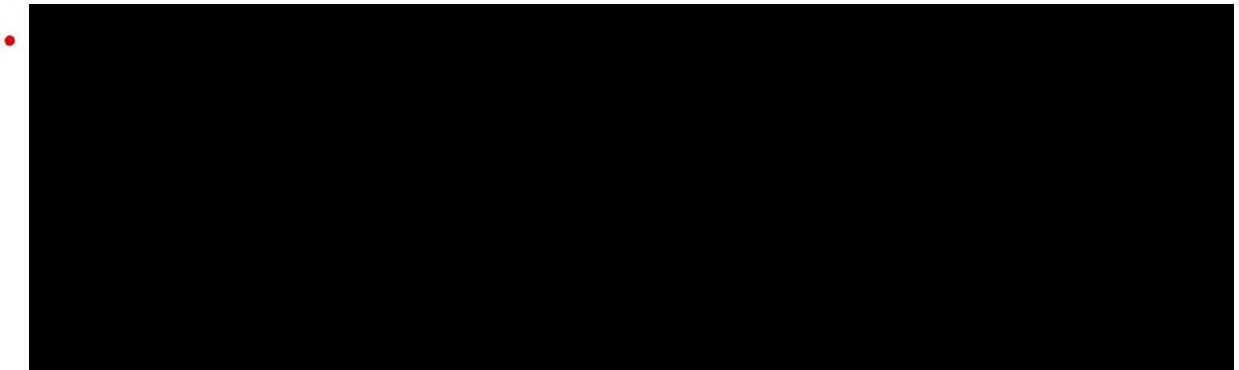

Please accept this letter as my response regarding your investigation as it relates to the [REDACTED] personnel complaint against Officer John VanSavage.

- How was [REDACTED] removed from the vehicle?
 - [REDACTED] was the back seat, passenger side passenger of the vehicle Officer VanSavage had stopped. [REDACTED] had been detained and then Officer VanSavage opened the rear passenger door, recognizing [REDACTED] and the fact she had a VOP warrant. Officer VanSavage gave clear direction to exit the vehicle, which were ignored by [REDACTED] who was tying up her hair. Officer VanSavage, after telling [REDACTED] multiple times to exit, grabbed her right arm, pulling [REDACTED] to her feet and against the vehicle. Officer VanSavage stated "I don't give a fuck about your hair [REDACTED] - get out of the car" as she was removed and cuffed.
- Did you hear Officer VanSavage make the comment to [REDACTED] "I don't give a Fuck about your hair?"
 - Explained above.

- Once the investigation is completed, the investigation and its report will be forwarded to the Chief of Police for final disposition of the case. When a complaint is sustained, the Chief shall determine and administer appropriate corrective and/or disciplinary action.
- Department policy requires that the complaint investigation to be completed within 45-60 days; however, the Chief of Police can waive the time frame depending on the complexity and sensitivity of the investigation.
- After the investigation has been completed and the Chief of Police has made a final decision on the case, you will be notified of the results by mail.

Most Often Asked Questions

- **HOW DO I FILE A COMPLAINT?** We would prefer to talk with you about your complaint in person; however complaints will be accepted by mail or in person. If they are submitted by mail, please ensure they have been notarized.
- **WHAT IS A COMPLAINT?** A complaint is a belief that a member of the Geneva Police Department has violated a Department Rule or Procedure, a federal or state law, an ordinance of the City of Geneva, or dissatisfaction with a policy or procedure of the Geneva Police Department.
- **WHAT DOES THIS PROCESS NOT HANDLE?** This process does not litigate or decide the outcome of any parking, traffic, criminal or non-criminal offense. These questions should be directed to the court of jurisdiction or your own legal counsel.
- **WHO CAN MAKE A COMPLAINT?** Anyone can file a complaint if they truly and honestly believe a police employee has acted improperly.
- **WHO INVESTIGATES A CITIZEN COMPLAINT?** Complaints of alleged misconduct are investigated by the Internal Affairs Lieutenant and his staff as needed. The investigation is then reviewed by the Chief of Police and Personnel Office if needed.
- **WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO THE EMPLOYEE?** That will depend on the results of the investigation. If the employee is found to be at fault the complaint will be SUSTAINED and the appropriate corrective

and/or disciplinary action will be taken. If they acted properly, they will be EXONERATED. If the facts show that the complaint is false, the complaint will be unfounded. In those cases where the department is unable to determine the validity of the complaint and cannot arrive at any other conclusion, the complaint will be NOT SUSTAINED. If the investigation concludes that the involved employee's conduct was not misconduct but rather an issue of department service or procedure, your complaint will be satisfied as such. In cases of department service or procedure, Geneva Police Department will attempt to clarify or correct the issue.

- **WHAT IF MY COMPLAINT INVOLVES CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR?** The Ontario County District Attorney's Office may be consulted on any complaint that alleges criminal investigation while the internal investigation is pending.
- **WILL I BE TOLD THE RESULTS OF THE INVESTIGATION?** YES – At the conclusion of the investigation and review by the Chief of Police, you will be notified of the results by mail. Due to contractual and legal restrictions, you will be only be given the finding of the investigation of whether your complaint was SUSTAINED, UNFOUNDED, EXONERATED, NOT SUSTAINED, OR IS ONE OF DEPARTMENT SERVICE OR PROCEDURE. The department is prohibited from revealing specific personnel actions taken against the employee.
- **CAN I GET IN TROUBLE FOR MAKING A COMPLAINT?** NO – Every citizen has the right to file a complaint, if it is done in good faith, with an honest belief that an employee of the acted improperly. If a false statement is made you may be charged under the NYS Penal Law Section 210.45.
- **ABOUT THE COMPLAINT FORM.** The attached form should be used to file your complaint. You can attach as many additional pages as necessary, along with any supporting evidence you may have. 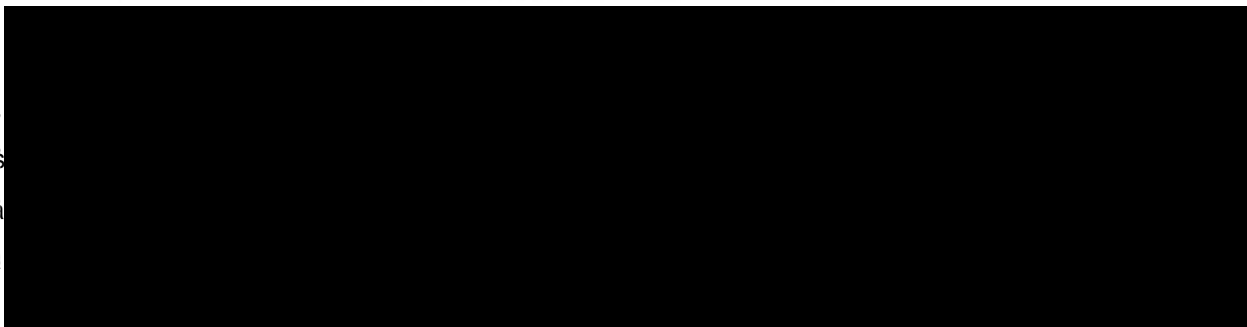

Introductory Paragraph

On 7.11.2014, I received a copy of Citizen Complaint Form from a [REDACTED] who resides at [REDACTED] alleges that Officers arrived at her home from a request by her to report her juvenile son missing. [REDACTED] was directed to contact police should her son go missing again to ensure documentation. [REDACTED] indicated in her signed internal affairs complaint the following:

1. Upon Officers arrival PO John VanSavage started being "hostile."
2. PO VanSavage was abrupt in his phrasing of terms like "you still don't know where your son is?" "Did you go looking for him?" "Do you want us to raise your child?" & "Being a responsible parent is knowing who your children hangout with?"
3. After hearing these terms come from a Police Officers, [REDACTED] admits to becoming angry and telling the police to leave.
4. Recruit Officer Richard Baskin was on-scene with Officer John VanSavage, but no specific complaint against him is apparent at this time.



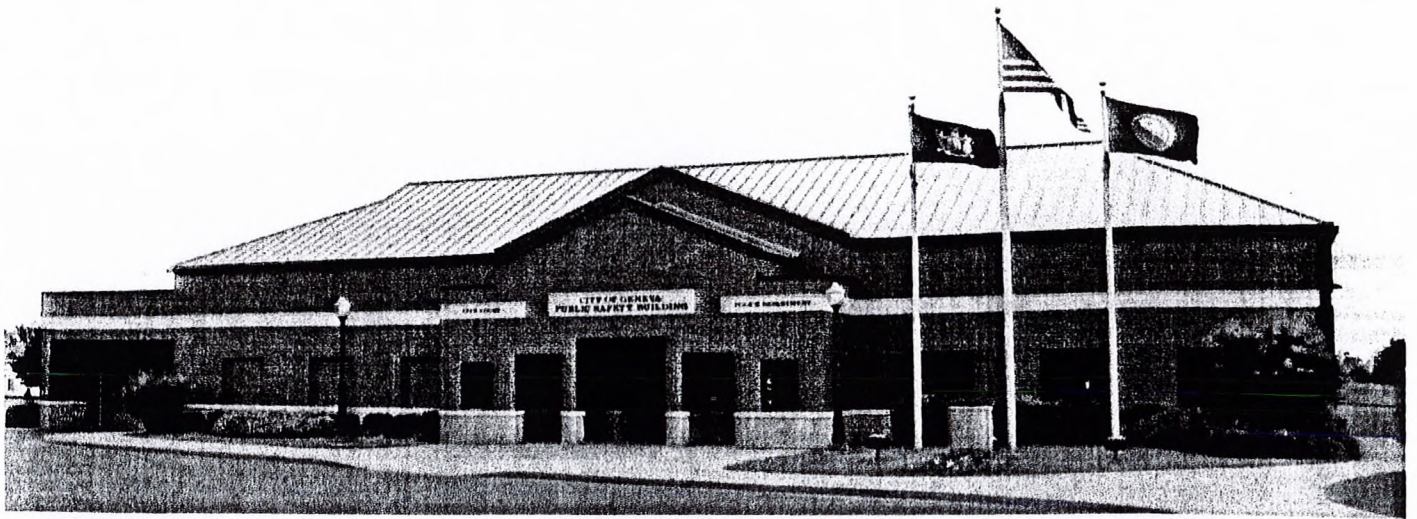

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

I respectfully submit to you the following response to the letter I received regarding a personnel complaint filed against me by [REDACTED]

1. Did you at any time state: "Do you want us/me or the Police to raise your child?" Response – No, This officer said "Do you want to raise him anymore, because you have to take certain responsibilities as a parent for your child." 6. Please further detail any other conversation you had with the complainant or her husband on this call for Police Service. Response- This officer spoke with the complainant and began a line of questioning common with a missing person, such as: when was the last time (M) was seen by anyone in the house hold, where did (M) go today, what was (M) wearing, was (M) upset about anything, has (M) done this in the past, who does (M) associate with, when (M) last ran away did where did he stay and who did he stay with, where did you look for (M) prior to calling the police, is (M) on any medication. 

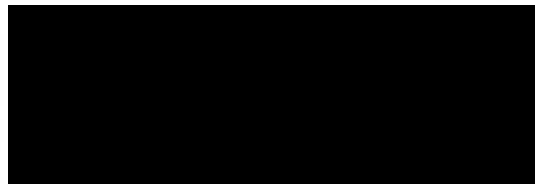

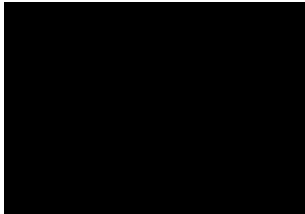
