

I don't specifically recall if I used the term scum-bag when speaking with [REDACTED]. He was very agitated at the time of his arrested and went so far as to call, on more than one instance, PO Barrett a "bull dyke". He was disrespectful to both PO Barrett and PO Winter.

3. Did you ever indicate that the arrested party never worked a day in his life?
Yes I did say that to [REDACTED]. When I informed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] responded, [REDACTED] I then pointed out that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and as far as I knew he'd never worked a day in his life.

Dear Chief,

On October 20, 2016 at or about 8:47am I spoke with Officer JD Winter in my office regarding the Personnel Complaint from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] [REDACTED] claimed Officer Winter called him a "Scumbag". Lt. Heieck conducted an internal investigation and determined that the alleged complaint against Officer Winter was substantial.

During my conversation, Officer Winter did stated that he did lose his temper on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] due to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] continuous disrespect to Officer Barrett where [REDACTED] [REDACTED] called Officer Barrett a "Bull Dike" numerous times. I advised Officer Winter of General Orders Section 305 III (25) – Rules of Conduct (Courtesy) where officers "shall control their tempers and exercise the utmost patience and discretion, and shall not engage in argumentative discussions even in the face of extreme provocation." & "officers shall not use insolent language".

Officer Winter agreed that his actions went too far and that his temper "got the best of him". Officer Winter apologized and stated that actions like this would not happen again.

Chief Trickler,

On March 31, 2016 at or about 9:00am I gave PO Cole a City Court Order for [REDACTED] to appear in City Court on [REDACTED]. There was no address on the Certificate of Service for [REDACTED]. On the Certificate of Service was a note indicating that [REDACTED] may be at the lunch program at the Methodist Church at Main St and Seneca St.


When I gave PO Cole the paperwork I advised him of the lunch program. PO Cole stated that he was not familiar with who [REDACTED] was. I gave PO Cole a brief description of [REDACTED] and the description of his [REDACTED]. I advised PO Cole that if he sees a truck matching that description in the area of the church then [REDACTED] is most likely there.

On March 31, 2016 at or about 1:45pm [REDACTED] came to the PSB and requested to make a personnel complaint on Officer Cole. Prior to speaking with [REDACTED] I contacted PO Cole regarding what occurred with [REDACTED]. PO Cole stated that when he walked into the church he looked around and didn't recognize [REDACTED] so he asked a worker if [REDACTED] was around. The employee directed PO Cole to [REDACTED]. PO Cole stated that after confirming that the individual was [REDACTED], PO Cole gave him the City Court Order and gave [REDACTED] a brief description as to what it was. PO Cole stated that he asked [REDACTED] his address so this type of incident wouldn't happen again and we could go to his house or call him in the future. PO Cole stated that [REDACTED] was apprehensive about giving his address and just argued with PO Cole regarding coming to the church and embarrassing him. PO Cole stated that he then left.

When I spoke with [REDACTED] in the hallway of the PSB. He was expressing his concern for the way that the paperwork was served. I explained to [REDACTED] that PO Cole was directed by me to go to the church due to not having his address nor knowing how to get ahold of him or finding him. I explained to [REDACTED] that we and as department do not like going to public places to serve paperwork however sometimes it is the only way to. I asked [REDACTED] what his address was so we wouldn't have to serve him that way again if we are required to. [REDACTED] was apprehensive to give me his address. He kept stating that we have his information and that the Court has his information and he is easy to get a hold of. I explained to him that we do not share information with the Court and we do not have his address. I asked him again for his address for any future paperwork that may come up and he changed the subject again this time was explaining to me about his health. His son however stated [REDACTED] before [REDACTED] gestured him to stop.

[REDACTED] stated that his attorney was upset that [REDACTED] received the paperwork prior to his attorney. I advised [REDACTED] that is something his attorney needs to bring up with the City Attorney as we received the paperwork and were instructed to serve [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also stated that his attorney advised him to come to the PSB and fill out a personnel complaint. I gave [REDACTED] a Personnel Complaint Form and he left.


