As you may have heard Gov. Pritzker announced new restrictions going into effect for Kane County beginning Friday. Below is information related to stricter mitigation efforts for our area. As you will note, these measures do not impact libraries and at this time, we intend to remain at our current service level. The Pritzker administration on Tuesday announced some south and west suburban areas will be under tighter coronavirus-related restrictions because they continue to exceed acceptable COVID-19 metrics.

Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker said the stricter measures — effective Friday — will be imposed in areas known as regions 7 and 8, which include all or parts of the collar counties of Will, DuPage and Kane as well as Kankakee County.

Indoor service at bars and restaurants are suspended, and indoor public gatherings will be limited to 25 people.
