Please be advised that we recently join on to the growing list of police departments participating in the Neighbor app by Ring. This app allows anyone to upload crime related videos in real time and share them with the community. You will each receive an email, which will provide you with detailed instructions on how to register your account. Each member of the department will have access to the Neighbor portal. The Neighbor Portal is a desktop based program, so you do not need to download anything on to your phones. Admin, Supervisors, DB, and OIC's have the ability to post alerts in the event of an emergency. All other officers will have viewing privileges only.
