Thank you again to Jessica for arranging, and to all for attending, last Friday's meeting. Attached is a recent article from the Cedar Rapids Gazette about an Assistant Linn County Attorney who is extremely passionate and protective when it comes to newborns and young children who are exposed to dangerous substances by their parents/caretakers, and is one who constantly challenges his supervisor, co-workers, DHS workers and DHS supervisors, law enforcement, GAL's, Assistant AG's, and even judges, to be more proactive in protecting the most vulnerable and helpless from the harmful effects from parental use of meth, cocaine, heroin, and opiates.

I was quite surprised by the "Attack Matt" strategy taken by DHS/AG on Friday. My friend and co-worker who again, by pursing a CINA adjudication in a PIDs-Meth case involving a newborn, is simply following a policy/protocol | established for our office, deserved a better defense than what I provided. Today I again reviewed Matt's email exchanges with the DHS abuse investigator and his supervisor, discussing the issues of emergency removal and filing of a CINA in the case at issue. Nothing in Matt's emails struck me as being unprofessional, threatening, or the least bit "vitriolic." (How many times did Ellen Ramsey-Kacena and others use the word "vitriol" to describe Matt's communications with them?) His emails are pure "Matt being Matt," as he confidently, excitedly, and passionately tries to convince others that his course of action is the correct and best one. Matt did not tell DHS that he was going to seek removal at the PTC. He merely gave the DHS investigator a "head's up," to be prepared to answer questions from Judge Bryner about why DHS did not seek removal or request a CINA. (Judge Bryner has been known to order removal at a PTC, even when neither DHS nor the State is requesting removal.) And when Matt suggested in an email that the supervisor (Kim Hahn) should attend the PTC to explain the department's position, she responded that she had full confidence in the worker's ability to testify as to why DHS did not believe a removal or CINA were necessary. Matt is beloved by most if not all DHS workers here in Linn...not feared. They know he will respond to any request for help anytime, any day of the week...he makes himself that accessible to DHS workers/investigators. He is a favorite of judges and attorneys as well. So I do not see this case and AG intervention as a Linn County Attorney's Office "personnel" issue.

Nonetheless, as a result of Friday's meeting, I will instruct Matt to be sure he does not include any "vitriol" in his email exchanges with DHS and Ellen, and to be a bit more open minded and less critical/judgmental/dramatic about the Department's position when it differs from the State's. I will also remind my juvenile attorneys to follow our office protocol when it comes to disagreements with DHS, i.e. "communicate, communicate, and communicate, always do so in a professional, respectful, non-threatening manner, and contain your disbelief." I do not plan any action beyond that. Ellen Ramsey-Kacena represented parents in juvenile court in Linn County for several years before joining the AG's office. She and Matt did not get along then, and do not get along now. There are many attorneys and judges here in Linn who would very likely admit that they too did not get along with Ellen. The reports of Ellen speaking to the represented mother in Matt's case just prior to entering court last week, outside the presence and knowledge of the mother's attorney, did not surprise me.

Final note: It is apparent after Friday's meeting that the AG now plans to step in to replace the county attorney in any CINA/TPR case where DHS alleges "disagreement," and asks the AG to do so. I do not

understand the AG's offense at the county attorney's request that the AG contact the county attorney prior to filing an appearance, to advise of the disagreement and AG's planned appearance. Not only is the request a matter of professional courtesy, but we make it in order to give the AG the opportunity to hear the county attorney's side in the matter, obtain assurances that DHS's position will be adequately presented to the court by the county attorney, and to receive information that DHS may have omitted/withheld in its request. That way the AG can make a better informed decision as to whether or not a "disagreement" exists, or if it does, whether the disagreement warrants AG intervention and replacement of the county attorney as attorney for the State. In no way are we county attorney's suggesting that we are the ones to decide if there is a "disagreement" or whether AG intervention is necessary.
