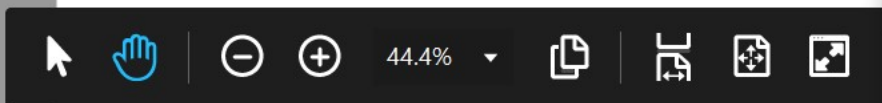
This letter is in response to your December 21, 2017, protest of our issuance of Purchase Order SPE7M3-18-P-1633 (Order P-1633) to World Wide Fitting, Inc. on December 21, 2017. Order P-1633 resulted from Request for Quotations SPE7M3-18-T-1480 (RFQ T-1480), which sought offers to supply 212 straight tube to boss adapters identified by National Stock Number 4730-01-117-0758. As the basis for your protest, you assert that the solicitation contained a combined Historically Underutilized Business Zone (HUBZone)/Small Business set-aside and question whether award was made in accordance with the set-aside because the awardee is not a HUBZone certified concern.

As corrective action, we re-evaluated the quotes received under RFQ T-1480 and made an award decision to award to JEQ & Co Logistics Solutions.
