False statements. Section 73(6)(c) of the Public Officers Law provides that: "Any...legislative employee who knowingly and willfully with intent to deceive makes a false statement or gives information which he knows to be false in any written statement required to be filed pursuant to this subdivision, shall be assessed a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars. Assessment of a civil penalty shall be made by the Legislative Ethics Commission in accordance with the provisions of subdivision twelve of section eighty of the legislative law. For a violation of this subdivision, the commission may, in lieu of a civil penalty, refer a violation to the appropriate prosecutor and upon conviction, but only after such referral, such violation shall be punishable as

a class A misdemeanor."
