NARRATIVE

Mrs. Collins stated that her pet goat was killed several days ago by a dog that lived at 142 Hawkins St. The dog was picked up by Animal Control and Deputy Harley Davis warned Cheryl Dupree to keep her other dogs put up and not roam the neighborhood.

Last night Mrs. Collins drove by Dupree's house at 22:00 p.m. on her way home and saw the front gates to Dupree's yard standing wide open. She drove by there this morning on her way to work and the gates were still open. On her way from work at 16:00 the gates were shut. At 1930 p.m. the gates were open again.

After talking to Mrs. Collins myself and Animal Control Officer went to 142 Hawkins St, to talk to Dupree about her dogs running loose after having been told by Deputy Davis to keep them put up. She said yes her gates were open but her German Shepherd had been inside the house all day. The other two dogs belonging to her daughter, Stacey Johnson, had been penned up in a fence all day and none of the dogs had been off her property. Dupree also stated she bought extra fence to make a large pen to keep the dogs in and has made every attempt to fix the fence around her property and keep her and her daughters dogs from getting off her property.
