ON 02/16/12 I RESPONDED TO 370 PULASKI ST. IN REFERENCE TO A FORCED BURGLARY. UPON ARRIVAL, I MET WITH FRAN COLLINS WHO STATED SOME TIME YESTERDAY IT APPEARED HER HOUSE WAS BURGLARIZED. COLLINS STATED SHE LEFT FOR WORK @ 07:30 HRS, 02/15/2012, AND RETURNED HOME @ 14:30 HRS AND NOTICED SMALL THINGS MOVED AROUND INSIDE. THIS MORNING, 01/16/12, @ 07:00 HRS COLLINS STATED SHE HEARD RAIN FALLING AND WENT TO HER SON'S ROOM AND NOTICED THE REAR WINDOW BROKEN, AND A LADDER BESIDE THE WINDOW. COLLINS SAID SHE WENT TO HER ROOM TO GET A HANDGUN FROM THE CLOSET BUT IT WAS MISSING. COLLINS THEN BEGAN TO NOTICE OTHER SMALL THINGS THAT WERE MOVED. SHE DID STATE AT THIS TIME, SHE THOUGHT THE ONLY THING STOLEN WAS THE .22 CALIBER SIX SHOT REVOLVER. COLLINS STATED SHE DID NOT KNOW THE MAKE, MODEL TO SERIAL NUMBER OF THE WEAPON. I COULD NOT LOCATE ANY PRINTS AND THE SCENE WAS LEFT AS IS AND I NOTIFIED INVESTIGATOR KENNY ALLEN TO ASSIST.
