COMMUNITY INFORMATION

The Culver City Police Department believes in building and maintaining trust and legitimacy with our community through collaboration, transparency, information sharing, and accountability. In this spirit, we are currently working with the California Department of Justice (DOJ) to begin collecting data related to the Racial and Identity Profiling Act (RIPA), California Assembly Bill 953.

Although the reporting of this data is not legally required for a police department of our size until April 1, 2023, the Culver City Police Department has made the collection of this data a priority and is taking proactive measures to begin collecting the data within the next few months. We will begin reporting this data to the Department of Justice no later than January 1st, 2021.

The Culver City Police Department will be reporting the below listed information related to our traffic and other stops/detentions to the Department of Justice, as required by law:

- 1) ORI number.
- 2) Date, time, and duration of the stop.
- 3) Location of stop.
- 4) Perceived race or ethnicity of person stopped.
- 5) Perceived gender of person stopped.
- 6) Person stopped perceived to be LGBT.
- 7) Perceived age of person stopped.
- 8) Person stopped has limited or no English fluency.
- 9) Perceived or known disability or person stopped.
- 10) Reason for stop.
- 11) Stop made in response to a call for service.
- 12) Actions taken by officer during stop.
- 13) Results of stop.
- 14) Officer's Identification (ID) Number.
