

At approximately 0525 hours On August 29,2022. I received a phone call from Lincoln County Deputy Justin Allen on a person of interest that will be passing through Limon who will be transporting drugs. The subject is identified as Alvarez, Javier DOB 12/24/92, it was also reported that he will be driving a white Chrysler Sebring with chrome wheels bearing Colorado license plate HCQ982. It was also reported Mr. Alvarez was known to possess firearms and switchblade and fixed blade knives. Mr. Alvarez should be passing through Limon at approximately 0545 hours. Deputy Allen received this information from Kit Carson Undersheriff Mike Jones.

Deputy Allen spotted the vehicle at the McDonald's drive thru, located at 837 US Highway 24, in the Town of Limon, at approximately 0538 hours. Deputy Allen drove through the parking lot of McDonald's and confirmed the license plate. The license plate on the vehicle is HCQ982 out of Colorado. The plate shows a clear listing on a 2007 white Chrysler Sebring. We staged on sixth street in Limon waiting for Mr. Alvarez to exit the McDonald's parking lot. The vehicle exited McDonald's parking lot driving west on Highway 24. Mr. Alvarez then turned left on Main Street. Deputy Allen observed dark tinted windows which exceeded Colorado law. Deputy Allen fell in behind Mr. Alvarez's vehicle and activated his emergency overhead lights, I fell in behind Deputy Allen and activated my emergency overhead lights as well. Mr. Alvarez turned left on "R" Avenue from Main Street and came to a stop just south of 6th Street. As Deputy Allen exited his marked patrol vehicle, the suspect fled the traffic stop in his vehicle. Deputy Allen called on his patrol vehicle radio that the Mr. Alvarez was "running." The suspect then turned right on sixth street. The suspect then turned left on "P" Avenue, which is a dead end. The suspect stopped his vehicle and Deputy Allen, and I attempted a felony stop with the Mr. Alvarez. Mr. Alvarez turned his vehicle around and drove past the driver's door of Deputy Allen's vehicle. Mr. Alvarez turned right on 6th Street and then right on Highway 24 and right onto east bound Interstate 70. Deputy Hutton and Sergeant Erwin joined the pursuit at this point.

All units had their emergency lights and sirens activated. Deputy Hutton took the lead. Mr. Alvarez was reaching speeds of 115 mph while driving eastbound on Interstate 70. Mr. Alvarez was continuously failing to yield to any of the vehicles behind him. Mr. Alvarez was traveling in both lanes of travel and straddled the center for several miles. Near mile post 367 eastbound interstate 70, Mr. Alvarez started throwing objects from his passenger window. Deputy Allen was able to locate two empty baggies that had a white substance on the shoulder of interstate 70. There was not enough evidence that was able to be collected. Kit Carson County staged at eastbound I-70 approximate mile post 419 with "stop sticks". The "stop stick" deployment was successful in deflating the front driver side tire.

Mr. Alvarez continued to drive west on Interstate 70 reaching speeds of 100 mph with the tire and vehicle disintegrating. Mr. Alvarez exited Interstate 70 at mile post 438, Burlington Colorado. Mr. Alvarez continued to travel north on Lincoln Street and eventually crashed on the northeast corner of Lincoln Street and Senter Avenue in Burlington. Mr. Alvarez exited the vehicle on foot and proceeded south in the alley between Lincoln Street and Lowell Avenues.

Deputy Hutton located Mr. Alvarez hiding in bushes near the intersection of Lowell Avenue and Lincoln Street. Colorado State Patrol and Burlington Police Department assisted Deputy Hutton taking the party into custody. Mr. Alvarez had a clear one-inch plastic baggie with a white rock substance located in his front pocket. Mr. Alvarez was placed into custody at 0647 hours.

Kit Carson County Ambulance was paged for preliminay medical care. I requested he be transported to Kit Carson Memorial Hospital for medical clearance. I followed the ambulance to the hospital and Officer Chris Graham rode in the ambulace with Mr. Alvarez.

Mr. Alvarez admitted to the Kit Carson County Ambulance crew that he had ingested methamphetamine, cocaine, Xanax, and alcohol approximately an hour prior to the incident. Mr. Alvarez relayed the same information to the nursing staff at the hospital.

In talking with Kit Carson County Undersheriff Jones. Mr. Alvarez is well known to Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office. He advised that Mr. Alvarez is out on four felony bonds and a misdemeanor bond in numerous cases in their jurisdiction. These bonds were out of the Kit Carson Combined Courts and read as follows:

Case 22CR9, dated February 7, 2022, for Possession Illegal Weapon, Possession of Controlled Substance DM1 x2, Possession of paraphernalia, Dist/man/sale/poss w intent >225 G DF1, Controlled Substance Special Offender. The first condition of this bond state, "Party shall not commit a felony while at liberty on bail"

Case 22CR22, dated March 4, 2022, for Bail Bond Conditions X2, RO Violation X2/Unlawful Dist with Intent/ Possession of a Controlled Substance. The first condition of bond states, "Party shall not commit a felony while at liberty on bond."

Case 22CR5000, dated May 18, 2022, for Possession of Drug paraphernalia, Violation of RO, Possession of a controlled substance, unlawful distribution, controlled substance special offender. The first condition of bond states, "Party shall not commit a felony while at liberty on bail. Party shall immediately notify the court of any change of a mailing address or residence."

Case 22CR64, dated 08/12/22, for Possession of Schedule I/II, Possession of drug paraphernalia, Poss/Dist/Manu/Sale/Dis. The first condition of bond states, "Party shall not commit a felony while at liberty on bail.'

Case 22M47, dated 05/11/22, for Obstructing a Peace Officer, Violation of RO previous offender. The first condition of bond is, "Party shall not commit a felony while at liberty on bail."

During inventory of the vehicle, Deputy Allen discovered a check in the front driver's seat that was visibly altered. The check was made to appear to be made out to Mr. Alvarez for the amount of \$1,375.42. The check shows issued from Grey Star Management services. The check has been placed into evidence. Also discovered during inventory was a fake A&W root beer can. These cans are utilized to transport or hide illicit contraband. The can contained a yellow cloth as well as two marijuana cigarettes, one and a half Xanax bars, seven yellow tablets identified as 1 MG extended-release Alprazolam. A clear crystal rock like substance was inside of the can. Total weight of the crystal rock was .9 grams. Also found in the can were two small baggies of marijuana, a folded dollar bill with a half-eaten edible and a small glass vial.

While being processed into the Lincoln County Jail, Corporals Dale Rostron and Jesus Ortiz strip searched Mr. Alvarez. During the inspection of Mr. Alvarez gray pants Corporal Rostron located a five -dollar bill folded in the change pocket of his pants. Corporal Ortiz unfolded the five-dollar bill and found a clear/white rock like substance. Also located in that same change pocket were five blue pills, later identified as synthetic fentanyl. The white rock-like substance tested a presumptive positive for cocaine.

Deputy Allen used a Narcotics Identification Kit (NIK) to test the unknown crystal rock substance.

The NIK test came back as a presumptive positive for Methamphetamine. Two tests were conducted for the crystal rock taken from Mr. Alvarez's person and the crystal rock taken from Mr. Alvarez's vehicle. Photographs were taken and the kits were placed into evidence. Total weight of the cocaine and methamphetamine are 2.6 grams.

At approximately 1155 hours, Deputy Allen contacted Judge Fisher and requested an increase in the bond. Deputy Allen was requesting the bond increase due to the circumstances and continued criminal activity from Mr. Alvarez. Judge Fisher increased the bond amount to \$50,000 dollars cash.

At approximately 1214 hours, Mr. Alvarez was medically cleared from Kit Carson Memorial Hospital. I wanted to protect Mr. Alvarez rights. On the date of 08-29-2022 at approximately 0526 hours I, Deputy Sheriff Michael Hutton, along with Sergeant C. Britton and Deputy J. Allen attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The suspect vehicle was a white in color Chrysler Sebring with Colorado license plate: HCQ982. Sergeant Britton and Deputy Allen activated lights and sirens near Main Street and R Avenue in Limon. The vehicle failed to yield and proceeded to P Avenue where the road reached a dead end. I arrived on scene to observe the suspect pulling off of P Avenue onto 6th Street west bound failing to yield to all Law Enforcement lights and sirens. The suspect vehicle pulled onto U.S. Highway 24 North and ultimately East on Interstate 70 from mile post 359.

I pursued the vehicle East on Interstate 70 at speeds ranging 95mph to 115mph. Near mile post 367 on Interstate 70 I observed the suspect driver throw multiple large bags containing white in color substance that completely dispersed onto the Interstate. I observed it to be a very large amount due to the mass amount observable in the air toward my patrol unit.

The pursuit continued East on Interstate 70 with speeds topping 115mph on average. Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office advised that they had "Stop Sticks" near mile post 419. Ultimately the deployment was successful and I observed the front driver side tire to be damaged. As we progressed, I observed the front driver side tire completely fall apart leaving the suspect with only his rim remaining. Despite this, the suspect continued to fail to yield to Law Enforcement and continued at speeds ranging from 75mph to 95mph. I observed the suspect vehicle to be emitting sparks and large chunks of debris.

While pursuing the fleeing suspect, I observed him pass through a stop sign at a high rate of speed with oncoming traffic approaching while the suspect turned into the oncoming lane. The location was the Interstate 70 Exit 437. I observed the leading patrol unit, Captain M. Yowell crash his vehicle into a semi-truck trailer that was forced to stop due to the situation. The suspect did not stop and continued North on Lincoln Street in the town of Burlington. I observed the driver at speeds of 70mph and completely disregard at red-light intersection. The suspect ultimately crashed his vehicle blocking traffic in the intersection of Lincoln Street and Senter Avenue. The driver fled on foot away from the crash heading South across property and alley ways. I ultimately located the suspect, later identified to me via Colorado issued driver's license as Mr. Javier Alvarez DOB: 12-24-1992, hiding in a large set of bushes. Mr. Alvarez was apprehended and taken into custody. Mr. Alvarez was supplied medical attention and was transported to the Burlington Hospital for further detailed evaluation. Prior to being placed in the ambulance, Mr. Alvarez was found to be in possession of controlled substances. These controlled substances would later be determined to be Methamphetamine and Cocaine.

Mr. Alvarez will be taken to the Lincoln County Jail for holding. Captain M. Yowell did sustain minor injury during the crash caused by Mr. Alvarez as well as severe damage to his patrol vehicle. Captain Yowell was treated on scene by medical staff.

I have nothing further to report at this time.

On August 29, 2022, at approximately 0510 hours, I was contacted by Lincoln County Communications (LCC) and advised to call Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office (KCC). I was informed by LCC that Under Sheriff Michael Jones had information that needed to be passed on to me. I contacted Undersheriff Jones and was informed that a male identified as Alvarez, Javier DOB 12/24/1992 would possibly be passing through Lincoln County. Mr. Alvarez was reported to be driving a white Chrysler Sebring displaying Colorado license plates HCQ982. Mr. Alvarez was reported as possibly transporting a large amount of narcotics. Mr. Alvarez was also reported as possibly being in possession of a handgun and several knives. Undersheriff Jones also said that Mr. Alvarez has been known to fight law enforcement while being taken into custody.

I contacted my shift partners Deputy M. Hutton and Sergeant C. Britton and advised them of the situation. At approximately 0538 hours, while patrolling Limon, Colorado, I observed a white Chrysler Sebring sitting at the McDonalds drive through window. I drove through the parking lot of McDonalds and confirmed that the license plates on the vehicle were HCQ982. While driving past the vehicle, I observed that the vehicle had extremely dark window tint, which is illegal in Colorado. I left the area and waited at the corner of 6th Street and Highway 24. I observed the vehicle leave the parking lot of McDonalds. The vehicle turned left onto Highway 24 and drove past my location. I fell in behind the vehicle and requested LCC run the license plate through NCIC/CCIC. The license plate came back clear and registered to Alvarez, Javier out of Stratton, Colorado.

The vehicle then turned left onto Main Street. The vehicle then turned onto "R" Avenue, due to the illegal window tinting, I activated my emergency overhead lights. The vehicle came to a stop on "R" Avenue in between Main Street and 6th Street. As I was preparing to exit my patrol vehicle the driver activated his left turn signal. As I stepped out of my patrol vehicle the driver immediately accelerated from the scene of the traffic stop. I called out on my radio that the party was "running". I activated my siren and gave chase to the vehicle. The vehicle drove to 6th Street and then turned right. The vehicle then turned left onto "P" Street which is a dead-end. As the vehicle came to a stop in the dead-end, the driver attempted to turn around. I stopped my patrol facing the suspect vehicle. I stepped out of my patrol vehicle and drew my issued duty pistol from my holster and attempted a Felony Stop.

The driver of the vehicle then back up and I jumped back into my patrol vehicle and drove towards the front of the suspect vehicle. As I was exiting my patrol vehicle, the driver, later identified by Colorado Driver's license as Alvarez, Javier DOB 12/24/1992, looked me in the eyes. Mr. Alvarez had his hands up inside of the vehicle. Mr. Alvarez then started shaking his head "NO" and put his hands down and rapidly accelerated past my patrol vehicle. Mr. Alvarez then proceed to turn right on 6th Street and then right onto Highway 24. Mr. Alvarez then entered onto Eastbound I-70 at mile post 359.

Deputies Britton, Hutton, Sergeant Erwin and I pursued Mr. Alvarez eastbound I-70 with speeds reaching as high as 118 miles per hour. Mr. Alvarez drove at a high rate of speed with no regards to any other vehicles driving on I-70. At approximate mile post 366, Mr. Alvarez was seen by Deputy Hutton throwing several bags of an unknown white powdery substance out of the passenger side window of his vehicle. The bags were thrown towards the south ditch between the frontage road and the lanes of travel.. The bags broke apart upon impact with the ground. One bag was observed as a tan bag.

I stopped briefly to try and recover what was thrown from the vehicle. Due to the wind and darkness from early morning hours, I was not able to find anything. I resumed the pursuit heading eastbound on I-70. By this time, several other law enforcement vehicles had joined the pursuit. I overheard Kit Carson County Officers had set "stop sticks" at approximately mile post 419 on I-70. At approximately 0615 hours, stop sticks were successfully deployed causing Mr. Alvarez's front drivers tire to deflate. Mr. Alvarez continued to drive at speeds over 100 MPH. Mr. Alvarez's tire started to fail and fly apart and at approximately 0618 hours, Lincoln County Sheriff T. Nestor gave verbal authorization for a Tactical Vehicle Intercept (TVI).

At approximately 0626 hours, Mr. Alvarez exited I-70 at mile post 437. As Captain M. Yowell was attempting to set up for TVI, he struck a semi with his patrol car. Due to the crash, Capt. Yowell's patrol car was disabled with extenstive damage. Capt. Yowell sustained minor injuries due to the crash. I continued the chase and observed Mr. Alvarez continue straight on Senter Avenue in the Town of Burlington. Mr. Alvarez attempted to turn right on Lincoln Street and crashed on the northeast corner of Center Avenue and Lincoln Street. As I arrived on scene, I observed the vehicles front and rear driver's side doors open. I exited my patrol vehicle with my shotgun and approached the suspect vehicle. The vehicle was clear of the suspect and empty. I ran southbound across the street and was contacted by a lady yelling at me from the front door of her house. The unidentified lady was yelling that "he's not here".

Unsure of what she meant, I was advised by several KCC deputies that arrived on scene that the lady was Mr. Alvarez's mother. I continued to the east of the mother's residence down an alley that ran south of the my current location. I searched the area with two deputies from KCC.

At approximately 0646 hours, I overheard Deputy Hutton giving loud verbal commands to someone to show their hands. I ran towards Deputy Hutton's location and observed him holding a male suspect at gunpoint. I called on my radio that we "had him". The male being held at gunpoint was Mr. Alvarez. I confirmed that he was the person that was driving the car and ran from me during the traffic stop. Mr. Alvarez was placed into custody at approximately 0647 hours. After Mr. Alvarez was placed into wrist restraints and searched he was sat on the ground. Mr. Alvarez began gagging and "dry-heaving" and then layed down on the ground. I asked Mr. Alvarez if he had ingested any drugs. I explained that we needed to know so we could get him medical aid. Mr. Alvarez refused any medical at this time.

I left the area and returned to the scene of the crash. I assisted KCC deputies with an inventory of the vehicle. During the inventory, I observed a check in the drivers seat that showed clear signs of tampering and being altered. The check was from Greystar Management Services and had the amount 1375.42 on it. Check number 655919 was listed on the front of the check. The name on the check is JAVIER ALVAREZ, but was clearly and visibly altered from the original issuance. Also taken during inventory by KCC deputies was a "stash can" that was found to contain a yellow wadded up cloth, two marijuana cigarettes, one and a half Xanax bars, seven yellow sqare pills identified as 1 MG extended release Alprazolam. Two clear crystal like rocks were recovered from inside of the can as well as two baggies of marijuana. There was a folded dollar bill with a half eaten marijuana edible and another small baggie of marijuana.

I left the scene and drove back to eastbound I-70 mile post 366. While walking the shoulder of the

Britton had taken from Mr. Alvarez during his arrest. These items also tested a presumptive positive for methamphetamine. Total weight on the suspected cocaine and methamphetamine is 2.6 grams.

At approximately 1155 hours, I called Lincoln County Judge T. Fisher and advised him of the incident. I respectfully requested an increase in the bond amount due to the circumstances and continuous criminal activity of Mr. Alvarez. Judge Fisher increased the bond amount to \$50,000.00 cash only.

On August 29, 2022 at approximately 0525 hours, I received a call from Deputy Allen of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Allen advised he had received some information from Undersheriff Mike Jones of the Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Allen further advised that he was told by Undersheriff Jones that a white, Chrsyler Sebring with Colorado plates HCQ982, was in the Limon, Colorado area. The white Sebring was owned and being driven by a party named Alvarez, Javier (DOB 12/24/1992). Undersheriff Jones advised Deputy Allen that Mr. Alvarez was transporting illegal narcotics and Mr. Alvarez was known to be armed and dangerous.

At approximately 0541 Hours Deputy Allen attempted to stop the white Chrysler Sebring near Main Street and R Avenue in the Town of Limon. Deputy Allen advised the white Sebring fled from him and was now heading north on P Avenue, which was a dead end. Myself and Deputy Hutton of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office were just approaching the intersection of 6th Street and P Avenue when I observed the white Sebring turning West onto 6th Street from P Avenue at a high rate of speed. Deputy Allen and Sergeant Britton of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office were in pursuit of the white Sebring. Deputy Hutton and I joined the pursuit. The white Sebring turned North on Highway 24 and then East on eastbound Interstate 70. While traveling East on Interstate 70, speeds reached 118 MPH and the white Sebring kept crossing the center lane and straddling the center lane.

Near milepost 366 Deputy Hutton advised Mr. Alvarez had thrown three bags out the window. I observed one bag that was thrown from the car. The bag was clear and when it hit the ground, it exploded into a white dust. It is believed these bags contained illicit drugs.

The pursuit continued East on Interstate 70. Members of the Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office advised they had Stopsticks set up near milepost 418. At approximately 0615 hours, the white Sebring struck the Stopsticks and the driver's front tire began to deflate. The white Sebring continued East at speeds in excess of 100 MPH as the driver's side front tire disintegrated. The white Sebring then exited Interstate 70 at Exit 437. As the white Sebring turned North onto South Lincoln Street from Interstate 70, Captain Yowell of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office attempted to get into position to do a TVI (Tactical Vehicle Intervention). Captain Yowell was unable to get into position to perform the maneuver and struck a semi truck. Captain Yowell's marked patrol vehicle sustained heavy damage to the front end. Captain Yowell sustained minor injuries.

The white Sebring continued North on S Lincoln Street in the Town of Burlington, Colorado and then turned east onto Senter Avenue where it came to a stop. Deputy Allen advised Mr. Alvarez ran on foot South of the where the car came to a stop toward a trailer home on the South side of the street. The trailer home was later identified to be the home of Mr. Alvarez's parents. My. Alvarez's parents let myself and Burlington Police Chief Nate Hill search the residence, and we did not locate Mr. Alvarez.

At approximately 0647 Hours, Deputy Hutton advised he had located Mr. Alvarez hiding in the bushes South of Mr. Alvarez's parents house. Mr. Alvarez was taken into custody without issue. Deputies with Kit Carson County and Deputy Allen began doing an inventory of Mr. Alvarez's vehicle. One of the items recovered in the inventory of the vehicle was a check from Greystar Management Services that appeared to be altered and written with a new name of "Javier Alvarez" on the check. The check number was 655919.

On August 29, 2022, at approximately 0536 hours, I was notified by the Lincoln County Communications Center, that multiple Lincoln County Sheriff's Office Deputies were attempting to locate an armed suspect in the Town of Limon. I advised Lincoln County Communications that I was monitoring the situation via radio, and within minutes, members of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office were engaged in a high speed pursuit of a white Chrysler Sebring.

The pursuit originated on the west side of the Town of Limon, and then onto Interstate 70, eastbound at speeds over 115 mph at times. It was made clear to all law enforcement officers, that the suspect was considered armed and dangerous. Deputy Sheriff Justin Allen indicated that he observed the suspect clutching something in his right hand as he drove past him.

I joined the pursuit around the Town of Arriba, near milepost 386, and maintained communication with Lincoln County Communications as we entered into Kit Carson County, Colorado. At approximately milepost 418, near the Town of Stratton, the suspect's front driver's side tire was deflated by the Kit Carson County Sheriff's Office. As we continued east, the vehicle began to spark and loose metal pieces for nearly twenty miles.

At approximately 0626 hours, near milepost 437, the suspect exited Interstate 70 and was driving at speeds in excess of 95 mph, furthermore, the vehicle was nearly uncontrollable due the frame being dragged upon the ground and the dangerous speeds. I advised all law enforcement officers that I was going to attempt to end the pursuit at the exit ramp to prevent the pursuit from entering the morning traffic in the City of Burlington.

I then accelerated quickly to attempt a Tactical Vehicle Intervention at the top of the off ramp, my speeds were near 80 mph while catching up to the suspect, who was in the mid 50s mph at the time. However, a semi-tractor trailer stopped on the top of the off ramp suddenly, I realized a TVI was not conducive at that moment, however, my patrol vehicle was unable to stop in time before impacting the rear of the semi-trailer. The 2015 Dodge Charger was rendered unusable immediately. I sustained minor injuries and was cleared by members of Burlington Fire Rescue.

Due to the impact of the crash and the subsequent air bag deployment, my patrol radios were terminated upon impact. I was unable to continue to monitor the situation after the crash.

My involvement was concluded at 06:26:22 A,M,, at the top of the Exit 437 off-ramp. Due to the emergent call out, I did not procure my body worn camera as I exited my residence that morning.

On the above date and approximate time, Inmate Mendez, Mark DOB/ 10/20/1968 asked Corporal Dale Rostron to come to the kitchen. Corporal Rostron and I walked to the kitchen to meet Inmate Mendez. Inmate Mendez had a glove tucked within the glove that he was wearing. Inmate Mendez pulled the glove out and poured a blue round shaped pill onto the counter area.

Inmate Mendez stated that he found the pill outside the door to T-3. The blue pill matched the description from the pills that were found on Inmate Alvarez, Javier the day prior, which was introduced as dangerous contraband. I collected the pill and took it to Sgt. Dustin Cunningham. The pill was placed in an evidence bag and locked up the evidence locker. I then went to my office to start writing my report on the additional contraband that was found.

Minutes from starting my report, I was called by Cpl. Rostron to the booking area. I responded to the booking area and Cpl. Rostron advised me that there was another blue pill by the door and one more in the cell that Inmate Alvarez. I went to the lab processing room and retrieved an evidence bag. Upon my return to the booking area, I took custody of two more blue pills. I sealed and tagged the evidence bag and returned to the lab room where the pills were secured in evidence.

On the above date and time, I Corporal Rostron of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, assisted with the arrival of Inmate Alvarez into the Lincoln County Jail. Sergeant Britton arrived in the Sally Port where Corporal Ortiz and I took custody of Inmate Alvarez, we escorted him directly to Holding cell T -3, where we were going to conduct a strip search, because of the safety and security reasons listed below.

- " severity of his arrest.
- " allegations made of metal health/suicidal statements made in the hospital.
- " possible drug related charges.
- " Previous incarceration behavior forwarded to us by kit Carson County.
- " Possible weapon activity.

Once in the holding cell we removed the hand cuffs from Inmate Alvarez and placed his hands above his head on the wall in front of him. I began a pat search of Inmate Alvarez and felt a bulge at the right watch pocket area of his jeans, I lifted his shirt and removed a folded five-dollar bill with a hard/crumbling substance inside it. I passed the object to Corporal Ortiz and continued my pat search. Once the pat search was complete, I moved onto doing a strip search, I gave my still recording body camera to Corporal Ortiz and conducted a completed strip search of Inmate Alvarez, where nothing else was found. All items of clothing were removed and placed outside of the cell and Inmate Alvarez was given a safety suit and safety blanket. Deputy Justin Allen was called to the booking area to assist with the suspected contraband found on Inmate Alvarez, we opened the five-dollar bill and it appeared to have a white rock that was partly crumbled and recognized to be methamphetamine. We then took it to the lab where it was tested and released to Deputies Allen and Hutton for criminal charges against Inmate Alvarez.

I returned to the booking area and began a more in-depth search of Inmate Alvarez clothing that was removed. In the same pocket I had found the methamphetamine, I found approximately 5 blue pills wrapped in plastic. The pills were taken to lab and turned over to Deputies Allen and Hutton, they determined it to be synthetic fentanyl and it was going to be added to the criminal case on Inmate Alvarez.

On the above date and time, I, Corporal Rostron of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, was flagged down by Inmate Mark Mendez in the booking area, to come talk with him, while he pointed to a black glove that was hanging out of a glove he was currently wearing.

Corporal Ortiz and I when went to the Kitchen area to meet with Inmate Mendez. He removed the used glove and poured the contents onto the stainless-steel countertop, I saw a small blue pill fall out of the glove with some blue and white powder, all of which coincides with the "synthetic fentanyl" found when Inmate Alvarez arrived at the Lincoln County Jail, 24 hours prior to this being found.

Inmate Mendez advised us that he found the pill on the floor outside holding cell T-3, that was occupied by Inmate Alvarez. We decided to conduct another strip search of Inmate Alvarez and a search of his assigned cell. As I approached T-3, I saw another blue pill, that appeared to be fractured. I opened the door to T-3 and removed Inmate Alvarez then placed him in to holding cell T-4, where Deputy Divis conducted a strip search, and nothing additional was found. I started the search on cell T-3, I lifted a pair of socks that was next to the mattress on the floor and found another blue pill matching the others that had been found.

I concluded the search of the cell where nothing else was found. All contraband was documented, photographed, and turned over as evidence by Corporal Ortiz and I, to Sergeant Cunningham, for further investigation of Inmate Alvarez' criminal case.
