This case came before the Court for sentencing of the Defendant, who was present and came to the bar of this Court in the custody of the Deputy Sheriff via closed circuit television from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center. Also came his attorney, **Bruce McLaughlin**. The Commonwealth was represented by **Alexis Downing**, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney.

On **August 13, 2020** the Defendant was found guilty of the following offenses:

Pursuant to the provisions of Code §19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the Defendant desired to make a statement and if the Defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the Defendant to:

Incarceration with the **Virginia Department of Corrections** for the term of: **Five (5) Years with TWO (2) YEARS SUSPENDED**, two years of which is the mandatory minimum, for the *felony* conviction of **Possession of a Firearm After Being Adjudicated Delinquent of a Felony**, as contained in case 35622.

Incarceration with the **Loudoun County Adult Detention Center** for the term of: **Thirty (30) Days with ALL THIRTY (30) DAYS SUSPENDED** for the *misdemeanor* conviction of **Possession of Marijuana**, as contained in case 35623.

The **SUSPENSION** of the sentences above is on the following terms and conditions:

Good Behavior. The Defendant shall keep the peace and be of general good behavior and violate no laws of this or any other jurisdiction from this date and throughout the period of any probation.

Supervised Probation. The Defendant is placed on supervised probation from his release from incarceration, under the supervision of the Adult Probation and Parole Office of this Court for the term of **four (4) years**. The Defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation and Parole Officer.

Substance Abuse. The Defendant shall submit to a substance abuse evaluation and follow any and all recommendations therefrom.

Illegal Substances. The Defendant shall refrain from the use of illegal drugs/controlled substances not prescribed by a health care provider.

Employment. The Defendant shall maintain or seek employment.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Defendant is to pay the costs in this case, plus Court Appointed Attorney fees that may be assessed, to the Clerk of the Court within ninety (90) days of his release.

The Court authorized the Defendant for participation in the Work Force/ Work Release Programs if approved by the administrator of said programs.

And the Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Deputy Sheriff.

The Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Order, forthwith, to the Commonwealth Attorney's Office, to counsel for the Defendant, to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center, and to the Office of Adult Probation and Parole.

On the above date came **Eric Shamis** for the Commonwealth, and **Bruce McLaughlin**, counsel for the Defendant. The Defendant, **Bryce Terrell Thomas**, who stands charged with the felony and misdemeanor as described above, was present and appeared before the Court via closed circuit television from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center.

These cases came on this day for entry of a plea by previous Order of the Court. The Defendant and all counsel then endorsed and submitted to the Court a Waiver of Indictment in the above cases.

The Commonwealth informed the Court that these cases had been the subject of a Plea Agreement. The Commonwealth did file a written copy of said Plea Agreement with the Court, the terms of which agreement are agreed to by the Defendant and all legal counsel.

Subject to the approval of the Court, the Defendant was arraigned on the Felony charge of **Possession of a Firearm after being Adjudicated Delinquent of a Felony within 10 Years**, as contained in the Warrant in case 35622, on the Felony charge of **Possession of Marijuana**, as contained in case 35623.

After private consultation with, and being advised by legal counsel, the Defendant entered a plea of *nolo contendere* to each charge, which pleas were orally tendered by the Defendant in person.

The Court, after inquiring and being of the opinion that the Defendant fully understood the nature and effect of said pleas entered and of the penalties that may be imposed upon conviction, does accept said pleas as being freely, voluntarily, and intelligently made.

The Commonwealth then presented evidence in support of her prima facie case in the form of a written proffer of the facts herein.

The Court based on the plea of *nolo contendere* entered to the charge contained in the Warrant in case 35622 and the written proffer of evidence presented, finds the Defendant, **Bryce Terrell Thomas**, *guilty*, of the Felony of **Possession of a Firearm after being**

Adjudicated Delinquent of a Felony within 10 Years, in violation of §18.2-308.2 of the Code of Virginia.

The Court based on the plea of *nolo contendere* entered to the charge contained in the Warrant in case 35623 and the written proffer of evidence presented, finds *facts sufficient* to find the Defendant guilty of a Misdemeanor charge of **Possession of Marijuana**, in violation of §18.2-250.1 of the Code of Virginia, however the Court *defers a finding of guilt at this time*. It is;

ORDERED that the Defendant cooperate fully with the request for information made by the Adult Probation and Parole Officer, who is directed to file a *Pre-Sentence Report* and *Virginia Sentencing Guidelines* with the Court, **five (5) days prior to sentencing**, as required by law. The Court and the Defendant did endorse a separate Order directing the preparation of the Pre-Sentence Report and the Virginia Sentencing Guidelines, and the Clerk shall provide a copy of this Order to the Office of Adult Probation and Parole.

It is further **ORDERED** that these cases be set to **December 17, 2020 at 2:00 P.M.** for a sentencing hearing. The Defendant and all counsel shall be present, with the Defendant being present via closed circuit television from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center.

And the Defendant is remanded.





PLEA OF NOLO CONTENDERE TO A FELONY AND A MISDEMEANOR

(1) My name is Bryce Terrell Thomas and my date of birth is August 3, 2001.

(2) I am represented by counsel whose name is Bruce W. McLaughlin.

(3) I have received a copy of the warrants before being called upon to plead. I have read them and discussed them with my attorney, and I understand the charges against me. I am the person named in the warrants. I have told my attorney all the facts and circumstances, as known to me, concerning the case against me. My attorney has explained to me the elements of

POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER BEING ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT OF A FELONY WITHIN TEN YEARS, a violation of §18.2-308.2 of the Code of Virginia;

POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, a violation of §18.2-250.1 of the Code of Virginia;

(4) My attorney has explained what the Commonwealth must prove to convict me and has advised me as to any possible defenses I might have in this case. I understand that by pleading *nolo contendere* I admit that the Commonwealth's evidence is sufficient to sustain a finding of guilty, and the only issue to be decided by the Court is punishment. I understand that by pleading *nolo contendere* I waive my right to an appeal.

(5) I understand that by pleading *nolo contendere* I waive all objections to the admissibility of evidence, the legality of my arrest, and any search and seizure of property.

(6) I understand that I may, if I so choose, plead "Not Guilty" to any charge against me, and if I do plead "Not Guilty" the Constitution guarantees that I would have:

- (a) the right to a speedy and public trial by jury, with a lawyer to help me at all

- stages of the proceedings, and the jury must unanimously agree that I am guilty beyond a reasonable doubt before I can be convicted; and
- (b) the right to confront all witnesses against me and the right to cross-examine those witnesses; and
 - (c) the right to require the Commonwealth to prove every element of the crime against me beyond a reasonable doubt; and
 - (d) the right to appellate review of the decision of this Court in the event I am convicted; and
 - (e) the right to remain silent and not take the stand or give testimony against myself, and I understand that no inference could be drawn from my failure to testify.

I understand that I am waiving these rights by pleading *nolo contendere*.

(7) I understand that by pleading *nolo contendere* I subject myself to the same possible penalties as if I had been convicted of the same offenses after a trial by jury or the Court sitting without a jury. I understand that the following are possible penalties for each offense:

POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER BEING ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT OF A FELONY WITHIN TEN YEARS: a term of imprisonment of not less than two (2) years nor more than five (5) years, and a fine of not more than \$2,500.00.

Two years of this sentence is a mandatory minimum and may not be suspended in any manner by this Court.

POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA: confinement in jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, either or both.

My privilege to drive or operate a motor vehicle, engine or train will be suspended for a period of six (6) months.

I understand that probation may or may not be granted, and that sentences for more than one offense are served consecutively (one after another) unless otherwise ordered by the Court. I understand that if I have been previously sentenced to confinement in a penitentiary additional punishment can be imposed under the multiple offender statutes.

(8) No officer or employee of the State or County or Commonwealth's Attorney's Office, nor anyone else, has in any manner threatened me or forced me to enter this plea of *nolo contendere*.

(9) All agreements, if any, in connection with this case are described in this document.

(10) I understand the judge may reject any agreement I have reached with the Commonwealth. If the agreement is rejected, I understand that I have the right to withdraw my plea of *nolo contendere* and enter a different plea if I so choose.

I understand that any sentence recommendation made by the Commonwealth is not binding upon the Court which may impose any sentence permitted under the laws of Virginia for the offense.

I have considered any offers made by the Commonwealth to resolve this case by agreement or recommendation after consultation with my attorney.

(11) My attorney and I have reached the following resolution of my case with the Attorney for the Commonwealth pursuant to Rule 3A:8(c) of the Supreme Court of Virginia:

- a. **I will waive indictment and plead *nolo contendere* to and be found guilty of the felony of POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER BEING ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT OF A FELONY WITHIN TEN YEARS, a violation of §18.2-308.2 of the Code of Virginia, as charged in the warrant.**
- b. **I will waive indictment and plead *nolo contendere* to and be found guilty of the misdemeanor of POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, a violation of §18.2-250.1 of the Code of Virginia, as charged in the warrant.**
- c. **I agree that as a condition of this plea, in any future probation violation or rule to show cause hearing in this case, if my probation is transferred out of District 25, I hereby waive any due process, confrontation, and hearsay objections, as to the admission as evidence of any probation violation report or letter.**
- d. **The Commonwealth will not object to the defendant's request for an evaluation under Section 18.2-254.**
- e. **There is no agreement about what sentence I will receive, and I understand that both parties are free to argue the appropriate punishment at the time of my sentencing and to make recommendations to the judge. I understand that the judge may suspend any portion of the sentence imposed except for any term defined as "mandatory minimum." This is the entire agreement, and no one has made me any other commitments or promises of leniency.**

(12) I understand that a Presentence Investigation Report may be ordered. If ordered, a probation officer will prepare the report for consideration by the Court. I may also waive my right to a Presentence Investigation Report. I understand that Virginia Sentencing Guidelines will be prepared, but the Court will ultimately decide the appropriate guidelines. I further understand that the calculation of the Sentencing

Guidelines and the final determination of any correction to the Guidelines made by the Court may not be the same calculation that I expect based on consultation with my attorney. I understand that an unexpected, unfavorable calculation of the Virginia Sentencing Guidelines will not be a basis for me to withdraw my plea pursuant to this plea agreement.

(13) I understand that in the event my pleading *nolo contendere* affects any probation, parole, or suspended sentence I am currently serving, or any other charges I have currently pending, this is not a basis for me to withdraw my plea of *nolo contendere*.

(14) I am entirely satisfied with the services of the attorney who has represented me in this matter.

(15) I acknowledge that I have been informed of the provisions of Section 19.2-310.2, Code of Virginia, which requires every person convicted of a felony to have a blood, saliva, or tissue sample taken for DNA analysis and inclusion in the DNA data bank.

(16) I acknowledge that I have been informed of the provisions of Section 18.2-251.01 of the Code of Virginia, which requires every person convicted of a felony to undergo a substance abuse screening and assessment. If the person is determined to have a substance abuse problem, such person shall be required to enter a treatment and/or education program. I also understand that as a condition of any suspended sentence and probation, I may be required to undergo periodic testing and treatment for substance abuse if the court deems such conditions appropriate based upon consideration of the substance abuse assessment.

(17) I understand that, in the event I am not a citizen of the United States, my pleading *nolo contendere* to these charges, as well as any subsequent disposition, conviction, or sentence I receive, may adversely affect my ability to legally remain in the United States, or bar me from becoming a United States citizen. I further understand that, should I suffer any adverse consequences to my ability remain in the United States legally, such will not be a basis for me to withdraw my plea of *nolo contendere*.

I further understand that entry of a *nolo contendere* plea may carry a wide variety of collateral consequences, including but not limited to: civil commitment, civil forfeiture, the loss of the right to vote, loss of security clearances, disqualification from public benefits, employability, ineligibility to possess firearms, dishonorable discharge from the Armed Services, loss of driving privileges, and loss of business licenses. I understand these, and other collateral consequences, not specifically stated herein, will not be a basis to withdraw my plea of *nolo contendere*.

My attorney has discussed these, and other collateral consequences with me.

(18) I agree to pay the costs of this prosecution pursuant to the terms contained within Section 19.2-340 of the Code of Virginia, and I understand that court costs shall bear interest at the legal rate of interest applicable to judgments.

(19) I therefore freely and voluntarily make no claim of innocence and plead *nolo contendere* to one felony count of POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER BEING ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT OF A FELONY WITHIN TEN YEARS, a violation of §18.2-308.2 of the Code of Virginia, and one misdemeanor count of POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, a violation of §18.2-250.1 of the Code of Virginia as charged in the warrant in Criminal No. 35622 and 35623



COMMONWEALTH'S PROFFER OF FACTS

The undersigned parties agree that if the Commonwealth were to proceed with a trial in this matter, the evidence presented by the Commonwealth would consist of the following:

On the night of March 8, 2020, multiple residents in the townhouse neighborhood in the area of Rusty Blackhaw Square in Sterling called 911 for gunshots being fired outside in the street. The Sheriff's Office arrived and found a male (later identified as Jeremiah Gray) dying in the street from two gunshot wounds. Mr. Gray eventually succumbed to his injuries. A short distance up the street, deputies located the defendant, Bryce Terrell Thomas, laying in the foyer of his home. The defendant had an active arterial bleed coming from his neck, and had several lacerations to his face, including one which had nearly completely severed his right ear.

Further investigation indicated that Mr. Gray and his girlfriend Trinity Solis had met with the defendant that night for the stated purchase of a marijuana sale. Trinity Solis told the Sheriff's Office that during the deal she saw Mr. Gray take a swing at the defendant, and that a physical altercation ensued, followed by gun shots. A knife sheath was later found on Mr. Gray's person, and a knife was found on the scene as well. The knife, along with some other items that were found in proximity to the scene were stolen during a burglary the night before

for which Jeremiah Gray and Trinity Solis later became suspects in. Video surveillance from one of the nearby homes showed what appeared to be a physical struggle by the two males. The recording contains two gunshots, followed by a pause, and followed by five gunshots.

A Glock 9mm handgun was located laying against a garage door close to where Mr. Gray was located. A total of eight 9mm shell casings were collected from the area where the incident took place. The casings were a combination of Winchester, Hornady, and Blazer. A search warrant was obtained for the home that the defendant was found in the foyer of. In an upstairs bedroom, detectives located multiple documents with the defendant's name on them. In the same bedroom, detectives discovered two scales and a jar containing four suspected bags of marijuana. The bags were sent to the Virginia Department of Forensic Science (DFS) for analysis. DFS concluded in a certificate of analysis that three of the bags contained approximately one ounce of "Cannabis" each, and the remaining bag contained approximately one ounce of "Marijuana".

Also in the bedroom, detectives located a plastic bag containing thirteen 9mm rounds. The 13 rounds were a combination of Winchester, Hornady and Blazer (the same combination of shells found at the shooting scene). Alongside the bag of rounds was a handgun magazine which was not compatible with the Glock handgun located against the garage door. While the defendant was at the hospital, a swab from his hand was taken for a primer residue analysis. The swab was sent to DFS. DFS concluded in a certificate of analysis that the sample submitted contained characteristics of primer residue, which can be deposited on a person's hand by discharging a firearm.

As a result of this investigation, the Commonwealth believed that the defendant had brought the Glock handgun to the marijuana deal, had been attacked by Mr. Gray with a knife,


had shot Mr. Gray in response, and at some point Mr. Gray had wrestled the gun from the defendant, resulting in it being fired several more times, and ultimately being dropped against the garage door by Mr. Gray after the defendant fled back to his home.

The defendant was previously adjudicated delinquent of a robbery in the Loudoun County Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court on August 9, 2017.

All of the above events took place in Loudoun County, Virginia.


The undersigned parties agree that if the Commonwealth were to proceed with a trial in this matter, the evidence presented by the Defendant, in addition to the Commonwealth Attorney's Proffer of Facts, would consist, in part, of the following:

- 1) Bryce Thomas (hereinafter "Bryce") was 18 years old and gainfully employed as a management-trainee for his parent's cleaning company, Jani-King LLC at Fort Belvoir, Virginia at the time of the subject offenses;
- 2) Bryce asserts that he used the firearm in self-defense to protect himself from death at the hands of the aggressor, Jeremiah Gray, in this case (hereinafter "Mr. Gray");
- 3) A third-party witness, a girlfriend of Mr. Gray, Trinity Solis, (hereinafter "Ms. Solis,") acknowledged to the police that Mr. Gray used a knife he had stolen the night before in a robbery at a local residence to initiate violent behavior against Bryce;
- 4) Because no money was found on Mr. Gray at the scene, he had no intention to purchase marijuana at the scene, only to rob Bryce;
- 5) The initial violent assault by Gray caused Bryce to suffer a massive head wound and a virtual death struggle ensued between the two parties;
- 6) Bryce suffered several almost fatal gunshot wounds himself, inflicted on him by Mr. Gray, in addition to the knife wound;
- 7) Unlike Gray, who was a resident of Maryland, Bryce lived in the local neighborhood where the incident took place;
- 8) Ms. Solis has pending ~~charges~~ ^{burglary} charges in the Loudoun County courts that occurred the day before this incident, based upon the stolen knife (and other items taken from the house of a local resident) used against Bryce at the scene by Mr. Gray;


9) Bryce's juvenile sentencing order is silent as to any prohibition against the future use of a firearm by Bryce, who was convicted of a "delinquent act deemed felonious,"

10) Bryce was convicted of this juvenile offense using a b-b gun at that time.

NOTICE AND MOTION TO COMPEL MEDICAL SERVICES


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on **Friday, April 24, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, Defendant, by counsel, will move this Court to compel defendant's transport to receive necessary medical services. As grounds for this motion, defendant avers the following:

1. On March 8, 2020 Mr. Thomas suffered two gunshot wounds and several severe knife wounds.
2. One of the gunshot wounds caused a fracture of his radial bone and required a cast to repair the damage.
3. The doctor ordered that he return to the hospital on April 7, 2020 so that the cast could be removed, the wound could be examined, and the damage reassessed for another cast or other treatment.
4. On April 22, 2020 counsel for the defendant spoke with a member of the medical staff at the Loudoun County ADC who confirmed knowledge of this requirement but could not state when they would provide transportation for that purpose.

RESULTS:

Item 17ADM was examined using Scanning Electron Microscopy-Energy Dispersive X-Ray Spectrometry (SEM-EDS).

Particles characteristic of primer residue are those that have a spherical or molten appearance (noncrystalline) and contain the elements lead, barium and antimony. Although rare, there are sources other than the discharge of a firearm that are capable of forming particles of this type.

Particles consistent with primer residue have the same appearance and typically include two of the three elements listed above. This type of particle is commonly associated with the discharge of a firearm but could also originate from numerous non-firearm sources.

Particles characteristic of primer residue were found in the area examined on the sample in Item 17ADM marked right hand. The left hand sample in Item 17ADM was marked "not used" and therefore, not analyzed.

Primer residue can be deposited on the hands by circumstances such as: firing a weapon, handling a weapon, being in the proximity to the discharge of a weapon or coming into contact with an object that has primer residue on it. The examination itself cannot determine the relative likelihood of these listed circumstances.

Item 17ADM was examined using Scanning Electron Microscopy-Energy Dispersive X-Ray Spectrometry (SEM-EDS).

Particles characteristic of primer residue are those that have a spherical or molten appearance (noncrystalline) and contain the elements lead, barium and antimony. Although rare, there are sources other than the discharge of a firearm that are capable of forming particles of this type.

Particles consistent with primer residue have the same appearance and typically include two of the three elements listed above. This type of particle is commonly associated with the discharge of a firearm but could also originate from numerous non-firearm sources.

Particles characteristic of primer residue were found in the area examined on the sample in Item 17ADM marked right hand. The left hand sample in Item 17ADM was marked "not used" and therefore, not analyzed.

Primer residue can be deposited on the hands by circumstances such as: firing a weapon, handling a weapon, being in the proximity to the discharge of a weapon or coming into contact with an object that has primer residue on it. The examination itself cannot determine the relative likelihood of these listed circumstances.

Date(s) of testing: 4/9/2020 - 4/14/2020. Supporting examination documentation is maintained in the case file. The above listed methods are those approved for use at the time of analysis. 
