Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I hereby request the following records:

The current version of the "Air Force Law of War Advanced Computer-Based Training" program, as of 21 July 2020.

A copy of any other computer based training programs for Air Force personnel on the law of war current as of 21 July 2020.

According to the office of personal responsibility, the actual computer based training (CBT) is non-extractable, therefore cannot be provided. However, we did review 62 pages of The Law of War Basic/Advanced Talking Points, of which are fully releaseable. Responsive documents are attached.

Include in the appeal your reasons for reconsideration, and attach a copy of this letter.
