This letter serves as a final determination concerning your Freedom of Information Law ("FOIL") request #125128-36288159, dated February 19, 2022 and received by the District on March 1, 2022, which requested:

- *Any documents and communications regarding any steps the district took to verify the FDA Approved vaccine Comirnaty, was being administered, as advertised, at district funded and/or promoted events.*
- *Any documents and communications regarding any steps the district took to verify the available EUA Vaccine was interchangeable with the unavailable FDA Approved vaccine Comirnaty.*
- *Any documents and communications regarding any steps the district took to verify the legality of mandating the EUA vaccine for 5-11 year olds.*

Please be advised that your request is denied, as there are no records responsive to your request.

Pursuant to FOIL, you have a right to appeal a denial of your request within thirty (30) days. Please state a specific ground for appeal and include copies of the initial request and the denial.
