Dear Mr. Laidlaw:

This letter is to acknowledge your written request containing five items related to documents regarding "... (NIH) project no. 1R01HD082554-01A1 –'The Impact of Early Medical Treatment in Transgender Youth' (Olson, Rosenthal, et al.)..." made pursuant to the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code §6250 et seq., and dated March 4, 2019. The university has determined that it has disclosable public records. The appropriate campus offices are compiling the responsive documents. All information identified as responsive to your request will be reviewed for potential exemptions pursuant to the CPRA and then made available for your access, in accordance with relevant law and University policy.

The estimated date of production is six weeks. I will provide you with a status update after the requested records have been thoroughly reviewed.

For your information, the California Public Records Act allows agencies to make records available "upon payment of fees covering direct costs of duplication." (Government Code §6253(b)). The charge is \$0.20 per page for copies. Advance payment is required before production.
