Please provide all correspondence including memos, emails, and contracts between private companies/individuals/government departments/agencies, air traffic control via FAA FSDO in Bellevue, Nebraska, and state and local Omaha, Nebraska government and law enforcement relating to the permitted frequent and continuous daily and nightly flights of small and large civil, private, or military aircraft including drones over particular houses and neighborhoods in the Bellevue, Nebraska 37th St. location of the Sarpy area of Bellevue and Papillion Nebraska particularly over (therefore, referencing) the house and yard around 7813 S

, 37th Street, from the time period 1 August 2022 up to the present date.”

Clarification of your request would be helpful in beginning our research. Please be aware that you have submitted your request to the State of Washington. Although there is a City of Bellevue in Washington State, I read your request to be specifically focused towards the state of Nebraska.

Please clarify if your request is intended for the State of Washington under RCW 42.56, and under FOIA, as you have stated.
