I have received 4 phone calls from a resident asking if the City can take any action regarding a person experiencing homelessness that she encountered near the CitiBank and Throckmorton Theater. I have attached the voicemails.

I checked in with Wendy at PD and she advised that there is not much the City can do if the individual is just hanging out. If he is on private property, the owners of the property may ask him to leave, but if he is in the public right of way, he is allowed to be there as long as he is not blocking the sidewalk.

The caller, Dr. Dickson, said that the individual was aggressive towards her. Wendy said if that is the case, she should call the police to report the behavior, but otherwise, there is not a lot that the Police or City may do.
