## Hello,

I hope this finds you well! In an effort to provide more timely information about the performance of our local homeless system of care, thanks to the input of the County of Marin, Marin Housing Authority, and our local nonprofit partners, every month Opening Doors will be sending out regular updates on our push to end chronic, veteran, and family homelessness. Without further ado, this is the latest as of March 31, 2021:

# **Chronic Homelessness**

- Since October 1, 2017, we have housed 322 people who were experiencing chronic homelessness
- Approximately 94% are still housed
- In March of 2021, we housed 3 more people

#### Veteran Homelessness

- Since October 1, 2017, we have housed 43 homeless veterans
- In March of 2021, 2 more veterans moved into housing
- We now estimate there are approximately 36 homeless veterans remaining in Marin

# **Family Homelessness**

- Since June of 2020, we have housed 48 homeless families
- In March of 2021, we were not able to house any additional families
- We now estimate that there are currently approximately 43 unsheltered and 18 sheltered homeless families in Marin

In addition to all of these efforts, in March the County of Marin's Community Development Agency officially launched a new State-funded rent relief program, an extension of the County's existing Rental Assistance program, to hopefully prevent any new households from becoming homeless. The program just received an additional \$16 million in State and Federal funding, adding to the existing \$6 million in funding from the Marin Community Foundation and Community Development Block Grant program. To-date, 1,916 households have received \$4.3 million in assistance.
