lelping Hands Await for Rental Assistance

<u>op-up events</u> on Wednesday, May 19, and Sunday, May 23, will allow local residents experiencing financial hardship ecause of the pandemic to get in-person help with federal <u>rental assistance</u>.

both events will take place at Exhibit Hall, in the back of the Marin County Fairgrounds at 20 Avenue of the Flags, can Rafael. The May 19 event will be from 4-8 p.m., and the May 23 event will be from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. No ppointments will be necessary to receive assistance, and language translation services will be provided. Visitors nly need to bring required documents. Assistance will be available for both landlords and tenants. Free tacos will be rovided for those receiving services.

n this session of federal economic hardship relief, there is \$16 million to distribute as part of the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, intended to prevent evictions and homelessness. 
