Re: Public Records Act Requests Received on May 18, 2021

Dear Mr. Powelson:

The City of Mill Valley ("City") received your Public Records Act request on May 18, 2021. Your request seeks:

Request No. 1: "All emails within possession of email accounts of any City Manager of the City dated between January 1st 2020 to May 17th 2021 that contain the following keywords: 'Homeless' 'Unhoused' 'Shelterless' 'Anchor out' 'Recreational Vehicle' 'RV' 'Encampment Cleanup' 'Tent' 'transient.'"

Request No. 2: "...emails that..." "requested an eviction moratorium, attempted to stop an encampment cleanup, or destruction of boats in Richardson Bay, or intervened in any way with any law enforcement actions against low income or unhoused communities."

On June 1, 2021, the City sent you a letter pursuant to Government Code Section 6253(c)(2) extending its determination by fourteen (14) days from the tenth day following the City's receipt of your request due to the need to search for, collect, and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records that are demanded in the request.

In accordance with section 6253 of the Act, this letter serves as the City's written response to your request. The City responds as follows:
