Choose Appropriate Regime

MSU-Bozeman employs three awarding regimes, based upon the students' residence status.

- · Residents will be awarded based on criteria to be determined by the Office of Admissions.
- Admits from WUE states are eligible to be chosen for the WUE award. WUE state residents not
 eligible/awarded for the WUE award are awarded under the Non-Residents regime. Students
 receiving WUE awards may be eligible for a Blue & Gold award.
