




State Residency








Yield by Academic Rank




Average Net Tuition Revenue of Enrolled by Academic Rank




Total Net Tuition Revenue by Academic Rank









































Yield by Ability to Pay






Admits By Distance Between Home and Campus






Enrolled By Distance Between Home and Campus







Yield By Distance Between Home and Campus










Yield by Gap







Average Institutional Grant by Cell for Enrolled






Average Net Cost by Cell for Admits






Average Net Cost by Cell for Enrolled






Total Net Tuition Revenue by Cell: Need and Academic Ranks





Average Net Tuition Revenue by Cell: Need and Academic Ranks





Admits by Academic Rank: Admits by Each Rank with Test Score on File








Enrolled by Academic Rank: Enrolled by Each Rank with Test Score on File



Yield by Academic Rank: Yield by Each Rank with Test Score on File









Admits by Ability to Pay: Admits by Each Rank with Test Score on File








Yield by Ability to Pay: Yield by Each Rank with Test Score on File






Admits by Academic Rank: Admits by Each Rank with No Test Score on File














Admits by Ability to Pay: Admits by Each Rank with No Test Score on File




