On 2/22/2017, I OFC Ben Newman # 1746 of Beulah PD was working in a capacity as a Special Deputy for MCSO south of Mandan on Hwy 1806. I was in uniform, driving a marked patrol vehicle. I was stationed at the south serpentine for the entirety of my shift. A woman walking north on Hwy 1806 approached the barricades and was advised to leave by multiple officers. The female began walking south again, but after approximately 15 yards turned around and proceeded to walk north again. Once she reached the barricades she was placed under arrest by a BPD officer. The female refused to give her name and was searched by a female officer. I placed the "Jane Doe" in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle and was going to transport her to a location north where she would be transferred to a Dunn County Deputy.

I met the Dunn County Deputy approx. 1.5 miles north and gave him custody of the female who had finally identified herself as CHARLOTTE BADBOB D.O.B. 5/3/1967. Dunn County Deputy took BADCOB to the passenger side of his vehicle and prior to placing her in his vehicle searched her person. BADCOB was advised that if she had anything on her person to let Law Enforcement know prior to reaching the jail or she would be charged with additional charges. BADCOB advised the Dunn County Deputy that she had to "joints" in her coat pocket. These were retrieved and I placed them in an evidence bag. The "joints" based on my training and experience were marijuana cigarettes. The evidence was left with Dunn County. Dunn County transported BADCOB farther north and transferred BADCOB to a MCSO Deputy for transport to Morton County Jail.

### SUMMARY:

On 02/22/2017 at approximately 0230 hours Reporting Deputy (R/D), Matthew Rodke was stationed at TCP 11 checkpoint assisting Morton county with traffic control when the R/D was dispatched to assist with a prisoner transport for an unidentified female who would not identify herself or give her name. The R/D responded and made contact with a Beulah PD officer and took custody of the prisoner, before placing the prisoner into the R/D patrol vehicle the R/D asked if she had any narcotics on her and she indicated she had several joints in her pocket. The R/D and the Beulah PD officer placed the joints into an evidence bag. The R/D transported the female a few miles north back to TCP 11 to make contact with a Morton County Deputy so she may be transported to the Morton County Jail.

Dunn County eventually met with Morton County Deputy Lloyd to complete the transport.</p> <p>Marijuana was found on BadCob and was turned over to Lloyd who put the marijuana in his evidence locker. I took the marijuana from the evidence locker on 3-6-17 and took it to the state lab on the same day.</p> <p>On 3-15-17 I received a report from Beulah PD. On 3-23-17 I received a report from Dunn County. I will add Dunn County Video to the case file when I receive it.</p> <p>It should be noted Deputy Lloyd completed a case folder, MT-17-000310 which is the same incident as this folder. We were not made aware of the arrest and case folder until we received the report from Bismarck PD officer Paulson. That is why the second case folder was created.</p>

5. Circumstances and/or other facts:

BAD COB APPROACHED THE SOUTH ENTRY CONTROL POINT (ECP), ON FOOT, IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD. OFFICERS MADE CONTACT WITH BAD COB. BAD COB DID NOT WEE POLICE OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE, SHE HAD RELIGIOUS MESSAGES FOR OFFICERS. BAD COB LEFT AND RETURNED TO CAMP AFTER BEING TOLD TO LEAVE. BAD COB RETURNED APPROXIMATELY TEN MINUTES LATER WITH MORE RELIGIOUS MESSAGES FOR OFFICERS. I TOLD BAD COB TO LEAVE OR SHE'D BE ARRESTED FOR OBSTRUCTION OF A GOVERNMENT FUNCTION. I TOLD BAD COB TO LEAVE AGAIN OR BE ARRESTED AND SHE STARTED WALKING SOUTHBOUND. BAD COB WALKED ABOUT TWENTY FEET AND TURNED AROUND AND RETURNED TO THE ECP. BAD COB WAS INFORMED SHE WAS TOLD TO LEAVE OR BE ARRESTED AT LEAST THREE TIMES AND FAILED TO COMPLY. BAD COB WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR OBSTRUCTION OF A GOVERNMENT FUNCTION. BAD COB WAS BEING TRANSPORTED TO THE MORTON COUNTY DETENTION CENTER BY A DORN COUNTY DEPUTY. THE DEPUTY LOCATED TWO MARIJUANA JOINTS IN BAD COB'S COAT POCKET.

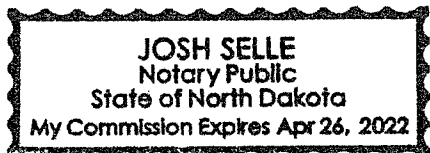

Topic REPORT SUMMARY

Bad Cob approached the entry control point (ECP) north of the camp, on foot and in the middle of the road. Officers made contact with Bad Cob at the ECP and asked if she needed police or medical assistance which she did not. Bad Cob had religious messages for officers. Bad Cob was told to leave the ECP and return to the camp, which she did.

Bad Cob returned to the ECP roughly ten minutes later with more religious messages for officers. I told Bad Cob to leave and return to the camp or she would be arrested for obstruction of a government function. The ECP's purpose is to provide security for the surrounding property and monitor north and south traffic on Highway 1806. Bad Cob's actions and refusal to leave, prevented officers from properly performing their tasks and assignments. I told Bad Cob a second time to leave or she would be arrested. Bad Cob didn't move and continued to stare at me. I told her to walk back to camp or she would go to jail. Bad Cob began walking southbound towards the camp. Bad Cob walked roughly twenty feet before she turned around and returned to the ECP. Bad Cob was informed she was being placed under arrest for obstruction of a government function as she had been told at least three times by officers to leave the ECP.

Bad Cob was handcuffed (with flex cuffs), searched, and transported to the Morton County Jail by a Dunn County Deputy. Bad Cob refused to provide her name and date-of-birth to officers, claiming we should already know who she is. Another search was performed by the Dunn County Deputy prior to transport and he located two marijuana joints in Bad Cob's coat pocket. The marijuana was seized and placed into evidence.
