Dear Jonathan Rudenberg:

New Castle County ("the County") has carefully reviewed your recent request for information made pursuant to the State of Delaware's Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 29 Del. C. § 10001, et seq. You requested the following information:

- (1) the total number of "use of force" incidents, separated by year, from 2016-2021 (for example, 302 use of force incidents in 2016, 287 use of force incidents in 2017, etc.)
- (2) the total number of "use of force" incidents, separated by type of force and year used for 2021 (for example, information that specifies the number of taser incidents in 2021, baton incidents in 2021, etc.)
- (3) the total number of civilian complaints alleging any form of law enforcement misconduct that were reported and the total number sustained for 2021.
- (4) the total number of civilian complaints alleging law enforcement use of excessive force that were reported and the total number sustained for 2021.
- (5) the total number of civilian complaints alleging biased policing or racial profiling that were reported and the total number sustained for 2021.
