Current Sony Hacking Tally Noted. To [CNET News](#) (5/25, Mills) notes the current tally of Sony breaches: “In addition to a distributed denial-of-service attack the group Anonymous launched on Sony in early April and the unconfirmed Sony Music Japan and Sony Ericsson hacks, there have been attacks on Play Station Network, Sony Online Entertainment, Sony Music Greece, Sony Music Indonesia, Sony’s Japanese ISP subsidiary So-net Entertainment, and Sony Thailand’s site.”

On its “Firewall” blog, [Forbes](#) (5/25, 924K) reports that, according to security experts, “the sheer number of those breaches” is “quite unique.”
