National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center (NCCIC)

Anonymous to target Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS)

- **Saudi Arabia, Turkey and Qatar:** NCCIC learned through open source reporting about the hacktivist group Anonymous' intent to launch a series of cyber-attacks against nations supporting the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS), an extreme faction of al-Qaeda. Anonymous stated they will launch their campaign against three target states; Saudi Arabia, Turkey and Qatar. Their plan is to attack the aforementioned government websites with denial of service attacks. Since Anonymous can't directly target ISIS, they intend to go after the people who fund ISIS efforts. NCCIC shared this information with all cyber centers and partners for further information/actionable intelligence to prevent any residual impacts.
