Dear Anonymous,

I am responding to your request on behalf of the Omaha Police Department. Your request is made pursuant to the provisions of the Nebraska Public Records Act.

In your request dated, August 2, 2020, you sought a copy of records related to:

All data found in overtime slips between May 1st and August 2nd. On August 4th, I requested some clarification. On August 4th you responded documentation of police overtime paid from May 1st to the August 2nd.

This is the response required by NEB. REV. STAT. § 84-712(4).

I have consulted with the supervisor in the Police Personnel Unit. They are able to run a report of all overtime worked for that time period.

Overtime is when the officer elects to have their time paid as money for that pay period. Comp is when the employee selects the option to take their time as time off or elects to have the time paid at a later date, call in is when the employee is called to duty and it does not attach to a duty shift, court time is the pay an employee receives when they attend court during their off duty hours.

In order to provide any more detail or documentation, it would require personnel to scan all overtime slips. This would take several days and would be beyond the four hours that the State Statute allows for. If you would like more documentation, we would either need to narrow the scope of your request or it would require a deposit

I have uploaded the spreadsheet into the Muckrock portal.

Section 84-712.03 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes may grant you the right to administrative or judicial review of this response. Please consult the statute for further information. Chief of Police Todd Schmaderer is the public employee responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your request.
