RESTRICTED USE LICENSE/PRIVILEGE INFORMATION

- ◆ Eligibility for a restricted use license/privilege is made in accordance with Article 21A of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- ◆ When validated, this will be your restricted use license/privilege attachment and **MUST** be carried with, and presented with, the restricted license or out-of-state license.
- ◆ Complete the applicable items at the top of page 1; read the Agreement; then sign and date the form.
- ◆ Motor Vehicles staff will fill in the boxes under the signature line and process the completed form.

REQUIRED FEES

The fee is \$85 if applying for a New York State restricted use license before September 1, 2009 and is \$87.50 if applying on or after September 1, 2009; the fee for the restricted use privilege for someone who does not have a New York State license, is \$75. This fee may be paid by cash, check or money order. If your license is suspended, before we can restore your full license/privilege, you must pay an additional \$25 suspension termination fee if the effective date of the suspension is before July 6, 2009. The additional suspension termination fee is \$50 if the effective date of the suspension is on or after July 6, 2009.

If your license was revoked for uninsured operation of a motor vehicle, you must pay an additional \$750 civil penalty before we can restore your full license/privilege (*the penalty is \$300 if the violation occurred before May 1, 1989, and it is \$500 if the violation occurred between May 1, 1989 and May 14, 2003*). This fee **must** be paid by cash, a certified check or money order, payable to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles; **personal checks cannot be accepted for this fee.**

None of the above fees are refundable.

CONDITIONS OF LICENSE/PRIVILEGE

A restricted use license/privilege is not valid to operate a vehicle for which a commercial driver license is required.

A restricted use license/privilege is not valid to operate a taxicab, livery, coach, limousine, van, wheelchair-accessible van, or tow truck. However, you may operate one of these vehicles with a restricted use license/privilege if your license has been suspended or revoked because of an uninsured accident, an insurance lapse, for uninsured operation of a motor vehicle, or for delinquent child support payments.

If you receive a restricted use license/privilege, you may drive **ONLY** under the following conditions:

1. to and from your place of employment.
2. during the hours of your employment, if your occupation requires the operation of a motor vehicle.
3. to and from the Motor Vehicles office to transact business with regard to the restricted use license/privilege.
4. to and from a class or course at an accredited school, college or university, or a state-approved institution of vocational or technical training, in which you are enrolled. A restricted use license/privilege CANNOT be used to drive to and from a high school.
5. to and from a medical appointment which is a part of a necessary medical treatment for you or a member of your household. **You may be required to provide a written statement from your licensed medical practitioner that verifies such travel.**
6. to and from a child's school/day-care if the child's attendance at the school/day-care is necessary for you to maintain employment or to maintain enrollment at an accredited school, college or university or a state-approved institution of vocational or technical training.

REASONS FOR REVOCATION OF RESTRICTED USE LICENSE/PRIVILEGE:

1. You receive a conviction certificate requiring mandatory suspension or revocation.
2. You are convicted of **ANY** traffic violation (including seat belt, cell phone and violations attributable to the operator) other than parking, stopping, standing, equipment, inspection, or other non-moving violations, where such violations occurred during the period of validity of the restricted use license/privilege.
3. You receive a conviction certificate which states that you have driven in violation of the restricted use license/privilege.
4. A finding after a Department of Motor Vehicles hearing that you are operating (or have operated) a motor vehicle in violation of the restricted use license/privilege.
5. The Department of Motor Vehicles receives any other information which would make you ineligible.
