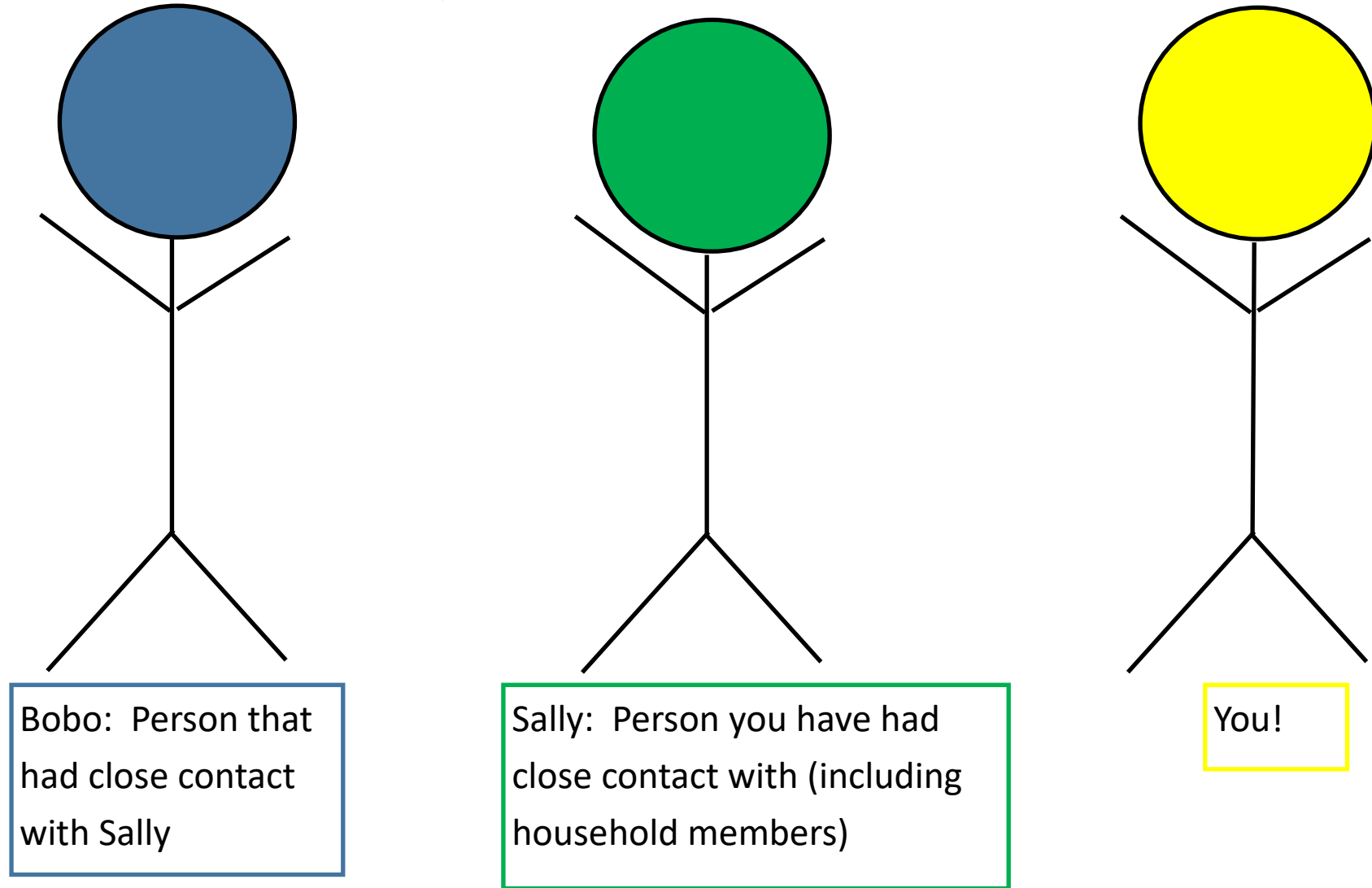


Covid Quarantine Guidelines



Close contact is defined as within 6 feet of a person for 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period. Per Lake County Health Department close contact is only applicable starting at 48 hours preceding the start of Sally's symptoms or 48 hours before her positive test result if Sally has no symptoms.

**If Sally has symptoms
and is waiting on a
COVID test result**

Then

You should quarantine until Sally gets her test results back negative. If Sally comes back positive follow below instructions.

**If Sally has tested posi-
tive for COVID**

Then

You should quarantine for 14 days from date of last contact. Getting yourself tested for COVID is recommended but a negative result will not end your quarantine sooner

**If Sally has tested
positive for COVID and
you cannot avoid
continued close contact**

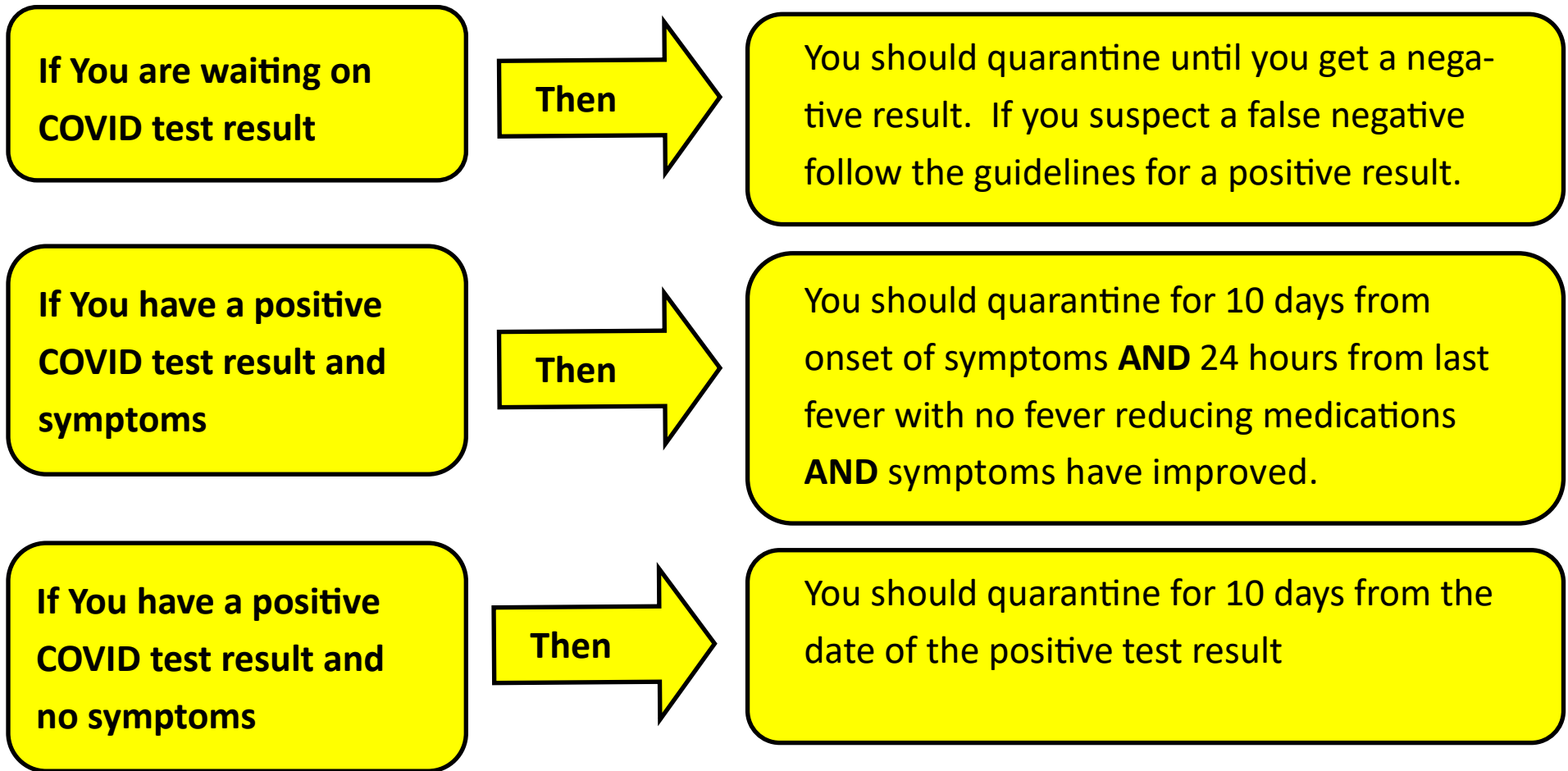
Then

You should quarantine until 14 days after Sally can end her quarantine. Getting yourself tested for COVID is recommended but a negative result will not end your quarantine sooner.

**If Bobo has tested posi-
tive for COVID**

Then

Sally needs to quarantine and get tested but you only need to quarantine if Sally tests positive or exhibits symptoms. Contact with Sally should be as limited as possible.



Additional notes:

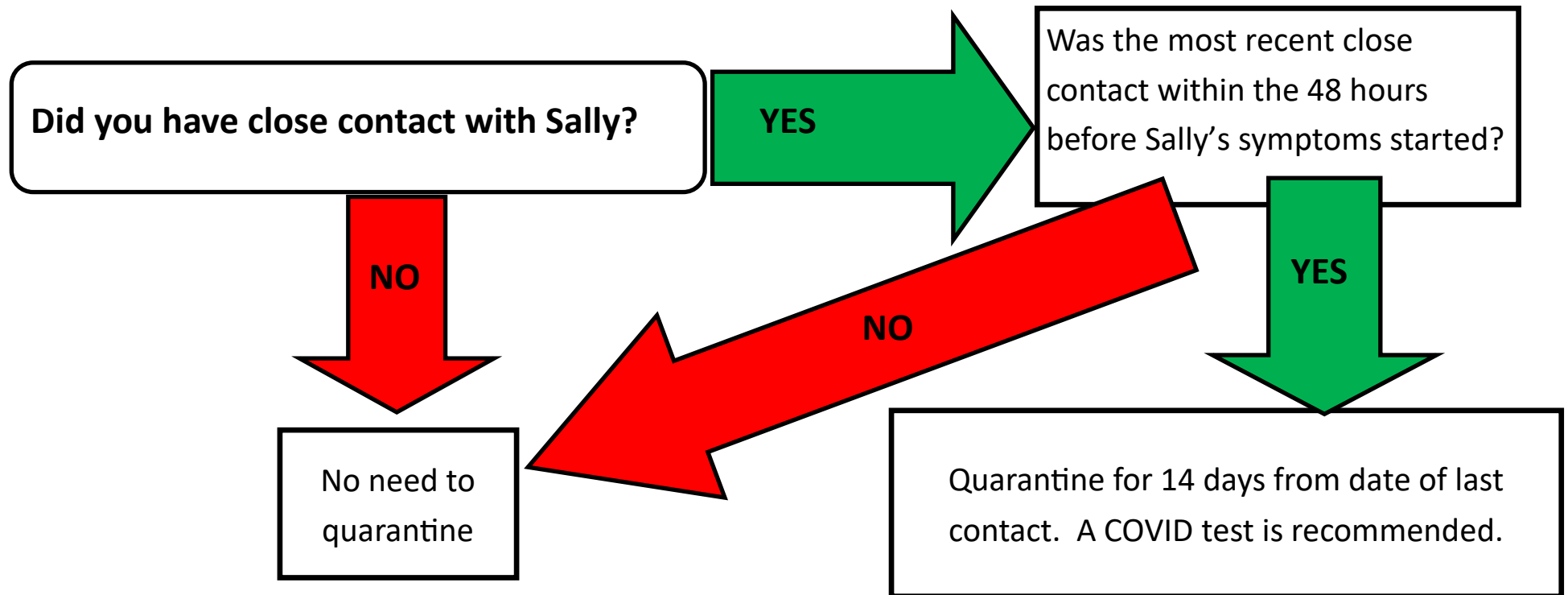
Please keep your supervisor and HR updated if any of the issues on these charts apply to you and whether or not you wish your name to be shared when notifying staff of any issues.

Advice from a medical professional or governmental health department should supersede this information if it requires more cautious actions or quarantining but any shortening of above quarantine times needs to be approved by library administration.
