- 1.) On 09/07/09 at approximately 1740 Hrs, I was on duty in uniform as a supervisor at COJ # 1. I was supervising the safety cell placement of inmate [REDACTED] DOB: [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was housed at Post 11 in the [REDACTED] area, Tank 13. He became disruptive in the tank and it was determined that he be placed in Administrative Segregation housing. Deputies J. Guitron # 1894 and E. Gutierrez # 1928 removed [REDACTED] from Tank 13 and we proceeded to 1MK02 at Post 10.

When we arrived at K-Tank, [REDACTED] refused to enter the cell. He became combative with us. I radioed for backup. Deputies K. Lomba # 2074 and D. White # 2115 arrived as we placed [REDACTED] in a prone position outside of K-Tank. A pair of leg shackles were placed on [REDACTED] because he was attempting to kick us. After placing the leg shackles on [REDACTED] we proceeded to Safety Cell # 2 at Post 9. [REDACTED] remained uncooperative during the procession to the safety cell and stopped walking at one point and sat suddenly on the floor. We assisted him to a standing position again and entered the safety cell.

Deputies Gutierrez, Guitron, White, Lomba and K. Macksoud # 1698 assisted in [REDACTED] safety cell placement. Following procedure, [REDACTED] was placed in a prone position inside the safety cell. The two pair of handcuffs and leg shackles were removed, followed by his shoes, socks and sweatshirt.

While the deputies were removing the last of his sweatshirt, it was noticed by one of the deputies that [REDACTED] fell into a state of unconsciousness. We attempted to awake [REDACTED] and after about 10-15 seconds, he was placed in a "position of recovery" on his right side, and his pulse and breathing were checked. [REDACTED] was still breathing and had a pulse. I immediately went to the Jail Medical Services Office and called for a nurse. Medical Staff members, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] entered safety cell # 2 and began to administer aid. They attached an AED unit, and administered CPR. [REDACTED] ordered one of the other nurses to call 911. At this point in time I noted that [REDACTED] was still taking deep breaths. The

- 1.) On Monday, 09/07/09 I was assigned to Post 10 County Jail #1. Deputy Smith-Al-Ghani #1056 called me via the radio and asked me to assist in taking an inmate to K-tank which is located at Post #10. When I arrived to Post #11, Senior Deputy Wong #1360 and Deputy Smith-Al-Ghani were standing in the Post #11 Office. I asked them who was the inmate that needed to be moved? Deputy Smith-Al-Ghani showed me a housing card that belonged to inmate [REDACTED]. I told Senior Deputy Wong that I had a pretty good relationship with this inmate and I could get him to cuff up.

Deputy J. Guitron #1894, Senior Deputy Wong, and I walked over to Dorm #13. I asked inmate [REDACTED] "you wanna go to mainline?" Inmate [REDACTED] jumped out of his bed and said "yes." I told him "ok roll your property up and we can go." I handcuffed inmate [REDACTED] once he was finished packing. [REDACTED] walked out the cell dragging his property without incident. Once we got to K-tank, [REDACTED] said he was not going in there. He did not want to be ad-seged. Senior Deputy Wong gave [REDACTED] an option of K-tank or safety cell. [REDACTED] picked the safety cell. Once we got on the mainline, [REDACTED] started to resist, cuss, and was not following orders to go with the program.

Deputy Guitron and I took [REDACTED] to the ground on the mainline in front of K-tank. Deputy K. Lomba #2074, and Deputy D. White #2115 quickly responded and applied leg shackles on [REDACTED]. Once we got [REDACTED] up, we started walking him backwards to the safety cell. Right in front of the Post #9 metal detector, [REDACTED] took a knee and said, "I ain't fucking walking no mo." Senior Deputy Wong told him to get up and walk. [REDACTED] got back up and continued to walk to the safety cell. Once in front of Safety Cell #2, [REDACTED] started to cuss and struggle with us. When we got into the safety cell, we pruned [REDACTED] on the floor.

Senior Deputy Wong gave us orders to take [REDACTED] shoes, socks, and sweater. When the leg shackles were taken off [REDACTED] he began to buck his legs. Deputy K. Macksoud #1698 assisted in the safety cell placement. Deputy Guitron cut [REDACTED] sweater off. I then removed

No respose was given by [redacted] Deputy Macksoud told Senior Deputy Wong to get medical. At this time we put [redacted] in a position of recovery and Deputy Lomba quickly checked for a pulse and found one. JMS then entered the safety cell and I was told by Lt. Casey #339 to go get ready for a hospital run. That was the last time I was inside the safety cell.

- 1.) On Monday, 9/6/09 at approximately 1735 hrs, I responded to a call for backup at K-Tank at Post 10. Deputy Lomba and I were working at Post 9 when we received the call and immediately ran to assist Senior Deputy Wong, Deputy Guitron and Deputy Gutierrez.

When I arrived at K-Tank, inmate [REDACTED] was handcuffed and in the prone position, physically resisting and verbally cursing at us. I assisted with controlling [REDACTED]' left arm, while Deputy Lomba placed leg shackles on him to control his legs from kicking. We then helped [REDACTED] to his feet and began walking him to Safety Cell #2. Deputy Gutierrez had control of his right arm, Deputy Guitron had control of his left arm, and I had control of his head to ensure [REDACTED] could not spit, head butt, etc. As we walked [REDACTED] to Safety Cell #2, he was cursing at us and resisting us. [REDACTED] went down to one knee and said, "I don't want to go there." Senior Deputy Wong told [REDACTED] to get up and keep walking.

We placed [REDACTED] into Safety Cell #2 in the prone position and were told by Senior Deputy Wong to remove his shoes, socks and sweatshirt. At this time I had control of [REDACTED] legs and began to remove his leg shackles followed by his shoes and socks. With the help of Deputy Macksoud, I then quickly put [REDACTED] legs into a figure four leg lock to control him from kicking and bucking. Meanwhile, deputies Guitron and Gutierrez removed [REDACTED] sweatshirt and handcuffs. Deputy Macksoud noticed that the inmate was not responding to verbal commands and told Senior Deputy Wong to get medical help. Senior Deputy Wong got medical nurses to help, and we immediately put [REDACTED] into the recovery position. The medical staff then took over, placing [REDACTED] on his back and began CPR. The medical staff asked me to assist them with chest compression's until the Paramedics arrived to take over. I was then told by Lt. Casey to get ready for a possible hospital run.
